

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot prices noticed range –bound to firm tone on Monday.

In The News: India's cotton yarn exports declined 4.4 percent in terms of volume and 11.58 per cent in value terms during April –June 2016. This is mainly due to decline in exports to China. China imported 149.66 mkg of cotton yarn during the first three months of last financial year (2015-2016) and it dropped to 99.09 mkg during the same period this year. Total cotton yarn exports from India used to be 140 mkg a month and it has dropped to about 100 mkg now.

The ongoing rivalry between India and Pakistan is likely to affect exports to Pakistan. Pakistan is the largest buyer of Indian cotton and the world's third largest consumer. At the moment there is no cotton trade. According to sources, there has been no inquiry during the last few days. Indian exporters are also not willing to export to Pakistan and looking for different markets. According to trade sources, India could export around 5 million bales in the 2016/17 crop year, but exports could decline to 3 million bales without Pakistani imports.

The Indian government has restricted the sale of cotton stocks held by the Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) to micro, small and medium –sized mills following the recent increase in prices. This will help in offsetting higher input cost and applies to existing cotton stocks purchased under the Minimum Support Price. The CCI began an e-auction sale last month to those spinners registered with the Office of the Textile Commissioner and Government co-operative mills. At any point of time, the mills registered with CCI are allowed to purchase a maximum of 500 bales.

India exported 0.054 lakh bales of cotton last week (03 -08 October 2016), which was 0.074 lakh bales previous to last week (26 September -02 October 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week (03 -08 October, 2016) was Bangladesh. According to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch, Bangladesh imported 0.046 lakh bales of cotton from India in the past week (03 -08 October, 2016). Other major importers were Pakistan and Japan and their imported volumes were 0.006 lakh bales and 0.002 lakh bales respectively.

India the largest producer of cotton is likely to buy up to 2 million bales of cotton this year. Till date India has imported around 1.5 million bales of cotton and has already signed contracts to purchase an additional 400,00 bales according to government sources. Imports have increased amid lower domestic production and lower prices in the global markets.

Department of Agriculture, Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in its second advance estimates, has revised the cotton production estimates downwardly for the season 2015-16 at 306.92 lakh bales (of 170 kg each). For the season 2014-15, the estimate was 346.23 lakh bales according to the first advance estimates for the season.

The Foreign Agriculture Services (FAS), division of USDA has lowered the production forecast for India in its latest report to 356 lakh bales. The reason for the downfall in the revision is lower yield expectation in Punjab and Haryana due to the attack of white fly and impact of pink bollworm in Gujarat.



International Fundamentals:

Bangladesh imported 6.2 million bales of cotton in 2015 -16. According to the USDA, Bangladesh imports are likely to increase to 6.3 million bales in 2016 -17. This will increase Bangladesh's share of global imports to 18 per cent which is more than double its share seen five years ago. Other major importers in 2015-16 were Vietnam, China and Turkey.

Georgia is the second largest producer of cotton in the US. However drought condition prevailing during the last few days is likely to affect the crop. Around one –third of the land is dry in Georgia. According to trade sources, rainfall is around 10 inches behind this year.

According to USDA latest report, global 2016/17 cotton ending stocks are revised down this month. World 2016-17 cotton production is projected at 102.69 million bales, around 6.6 per cent above last season. World ending stocks are now projected lower at 87.35 million bales. For India, production is forecast at 26.50 million bales, same as previous month's estimates and India's crop is estimated 0.38 per cent above 2015/16.

Outlook

We expect domestic prices to remain range bound to weak in the near -term.
