

**Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Market Outlook:** Cotton spot markets reported steady to firm.

**In The News:** On the spot markets in Rajkot, each bale (of 170 kg) of 29-mm cotton was quoted at Rs 19,459 as on December 22 from Rs 18,098 quoted a month ago.

Maharashtra government will provide compensation of Rs. 30,800 and Rs. 37,500 per hectare for cotton growers whose crop was damaged by the attack of pest Pink Bollworm, Minister for Agriculture Pandurang Fundkar announced on Friday. The compensation for farmers on irrigated land would be more than the same for non-irrigated land.

Cotton prices at Karachi market have stabilised at Rs7,500 per maund on sustained demand from spinners on Saturday. Buyers continue to chase quality lint in the background of diminishing prospects of imports owing to prevailing higher rates in world market. Ginners readily disposed their stocks at current high rates.

With Bollgard-II technology failing to control pink bollworms and illegal Bt3 technology seeds flooding the market, farmers in Telangana have demanded State and Central governments to ensure payment of compensation for crop losses they suffered this kharif.

Cotton yarn exports declined 10 %, mainly due to policy lapses, exports between April and September in 2016 was 517 million kg and it was 464 million kg during the same period this year

Chief Minister of Maharashtra, Mr Fadnavis said the government would ensure that all the cotton farmers, affected from Pink ballworm would get compensation from crop insurance, compensation from seed companies concerned and moreover from the state government.

Ginners across the country have decided to observe a day's strike on Friday, with the threat of more action later, in protest at the five per cent goods and services tax (GST) on cotton.

Election fever in India's largest cotton producing state Gujarat has hit arrivals this month. According to traders and brokers, arrival of new crop has declined 35 per cent compared to last year.

Experts of Punjab Agricultural University said that Picking should be completed as early as possible and trashes of cotton and unopened bolls should be removed from field, after last picking allow goats, sheep and other animals to graze on unopened bolls and plant debris in the cotton fields.

Cotton Advisory Board (CAB) has estimated that cotton production in 2017-18 is likely to rise 9.3 per cent to 37.7 million bales.

The Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has procured 1.29 lakh tonnes of cotton in Telangana so far this season. The CCI made these purchases from 243 centres that it set up for the season. And also opened its collection centres in 202 ginning mills and 41 public market yards.

India's current cotton crop for the season ending this September is expected to be about 34.1 million bales.

**International Fundamentals:**

December crop report, USDA estimated a 2017-18 U.S. crop of 21.44 million bales. Upland production was estimated at 20.71 million bales and extra-long staple (ELS) production at 727,000 bales. Harvested area was an estimated 11.41 million acres, implying a non-harvested area of about 1.21 million acres.

Global cotton area for 2017-18 is projected to increase by 11 per cent to 32.5 million hectares. As a result, global cotton production is forecast to grow by 12 per cent during 2017-18, compared to 7 per cent growth in 2016-17, the International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC).

Pakistan government has allowed cotton imports from India, though with a set of rules which are being seen as “tough” by local importers there. A permit from the Department of Plant Protection of Pakistan’s food ministry would be mandatory for any trader to import unprocessed cotton, including raw or seed cotton, cotton lint, linters, cotton waste and cotton stuffing from India.

The International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC) had upraised its world’s cotton output projection to 25.57 million tonnes in 2017-18 (01st October, 2017 -30th September, 2018).

According to fortnightly report issued by the Pakistan Cotton Ginners Association (PCGA) on Saturday, a total of 0.20 million bales were sold to exporters, which was 33.10 percent higher than 0.15 million bales last year.

According to China’s General Administration of Customs, China imported 441,571 metric tonnes of cotton from U.S. during the period January –September 2017, an increase of 140.48% compared to the same period previous year. In the month of September 2017, China’s imports of cotton from U.S. increased by 89.62% to 33,594 metric tonnes.

World cotton consumption is expected to increase by 2.7% from 24.56 MMT in 2016-17 to 25.22 MMT in 2017-18. Wherein, China, the world’s largest cotton consumer, is expected to consume 8.1 MMT of cotton during 2017-18 which is 1.5% higher than its cotton consumption last year.
