

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook: Cotton spot market prices are reported range bound on Tuesday.

In The News: The projected balance sheet drawn by the Cotton Association of India(CAI) estimated total cotton supply for the season at 425 lakh bales of 170 kgs each, including the opening stock of 30 lakh bales at the beginning of the season and the imports which the CAI estimates at 20 lakh bales for 2017-18 crop year. The domestic consumption is estimated to be 320 lakh bales while CAI estimates exports for the season to be 55 lakh bales.

In Andhra Pradesh cotton crop was damaged Up to 25 percent due to rain and Pink bollworm attack. Before this, state cotton traders were expected production for this year was 25 to 30 lakh bales.

Cotton prices have moved up in the country, the parity to import the fibre crop has increased. As a result, the trade body sees an increase in imports and has revised the import figures from 17 lakh bales to 20 lakh bales this season.

Market arrivals of cotton in the first three months of the 2017-18 marketing season starting October are higher by around 43 per cent over corresponding last year. Arrivals would have crossed 148 lakh bales by December 31 this year as against 108 lakh bales, based on the data gathered from each State.

Nearly 9 lakh cotton farmers have approached the Maharashtra government seeking compensation for failed crops after severe pest attack. After complaints of huge losses, the state government has deployed its machinery to survey the affected districts and has also invited applications from the farmers seeking compensation from seed companies.

Maharashtra government will provide compensation of Rs. 30,800 and Rs. 37,500 per hectare for cotton growers whose crop was damaged by the attack of pest Pink Bollworm, Minister for Agriculture Pandurang Fundkar announced on Friday. The compensation for farmers on irrigated land would be more than the same for non-irrigated land.

Cotton prices at Karachi market have stabilised at Rs7,500 per maund on sustained demand from spinners on Saturday Buyers continue to chase quality lint in the background of diminishing prospects of imports owing to prevailing higher rates in world market. Ginners readily disposed their stocks at current high rates.

With Bollgard-II technology failing to control pink bollworms and illegal Bt3 technology seeds flooding the market, farmers in Telangana have demanded State and Central governments to ensure payment of compensation for crop losses they suffered this kharif.

Cotton yarn exports declined 10 %, mainly due to policy lapses, exports between April and September in 2016 was 517 million kg and it was 464 million kg during the same period this year

Chief Minister of Maharashtra, Mr Fadnavis said the government would ensure that all the cotton farmers, affected from Pink ballworm would get compensation from crop insurance, compensation from seed companies concerned and moreover from the state government.

Experts of Punjab Agricultural University said that Picking should be completed as early as possible and trashes of cotton and unopened bolls should be removed from filed, after last picking allow goats, sheep and other animals to graze on unopened bolls and plant debris in the cotton fields.



International Fundamentals:

Cotton yarn export at 85.5 million kg worth US\$255 million (INR 1630 Crore) was up 12 per cent in November as 75 countries imported yarn at an average unit price realization of US \$2.98 kg, US cents 6 less than previous month and US cents 8 higher than last year.

China reduced its import of cotton yarn from India by 4 per cent in value, but still accounted for 40 per cent of total shipment during November followed by Bangladesh and Egypt. 10countries did not import cotton yarn from India as they did last year, that were replaced by 12 countries which imported yarn worth US\$ 12 million, Singapore, Honduras, Lithuania, Argentina and Jordan were among the fastest growing large markets for cotton yarn.

December crop report, USDA estimated a 2017-18 U.S. crop of 21.44 million bales. Upland production was estimated at 20.71 million bales and extra-long staple (ELS) production at 727,000 bales. Harvested area was an estimated 11.41 million acres, implying a non-harvested area of about 1.21 million acres.

Global cotton area for 2017-18 is projected to increase by 11 per cent to 32.5 million hectares. As a result, global cotton production is forecast to grow by 12 per cent during 2017-18, compared to 7 per cent growth in 2016-17, the International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC).

The International Cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC) had upraised its world's cotton output projection to 25.57 million tonnes in 2017-18 (01st October, 2017 -30th September, 2018).

According to fortnightly report issued by the Pakistan Cotton Ginners Association (PCGA) on Saturday, a total of 0.20 million bales were sold to exporters, which was 33.10 percent higher than 0.15 million bales last year.

According to China's General Administration of Customs, China imported 441,571 metric tonnes of cotton from U.S. during the period January –September 2017, an increase of 140.48% compared to the same period previous year. In the month of September 2017, China's imports of cotton from U.S. increased by 89.62% to 33,594 metric tonnes.
