

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Market Outlook**: Cotton spot market prices were noticed mixed tone on Saturday. Expected to trade in the range of 5800 to 6400 for next few weeks. With limited arrivals most of the markets about to close by July and Few markets are already closed.

In the News: North India cotton season starting early one month than all other region in India. In Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan harvesting will begin in end of August or September month and other cotton growing states like Gujarat, Maharastra, MP, Telanagana, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh will start in October month. Till now there is no pest attack on cotton crop and crop is at healthy stage.

In forward trade the multinational companies and leading cotton traders offering new cotton crop at 48300-48500 Rs/Candy in November, 47800-48000 Rs/Candy in December and 47300-47500 Rs/ candy in January 2019.Indian Cotton S6 29 mm Offering at 95.5 - 96 USC/LBS to Chittagong, Bangladesh Market while for China Market 92.50 -93 USC / LBS in direct export.

**The Cotton Advisory Board (CAB) has estimated** that during the current cotton season of October, 2017 to September, 2018, the export of cotton from India is likely to increase by 20% over last year and is expected to touch 70 lakh bales by September, 2018, a release from the Press Information Bureau said.

**Gujarat Cotton Sowing Reached 21,84,172 Hectares till 23rd July** 2018 vs 25,84,600 Hectares Last year, as per Government of Gujarat Data.

The area under cotton cultivation has shrunk by 20% as compared to last year in western Vidarbha with the possibility of soybean and tur being preferred as a cash crop this kharif season. With good rains all over the region, sowing operations are nearing completion according to top agriculture officials of Amravati and Nagpur divisions. However, in eastern Vidarbha's Nagpur division the picture is a contrast with cotton area going up to 137% of the normal estimate and soybean as well as tur showing a dip.

**At the National Commodity and Derivatives Exchange counter, cottonseed oil cake delivery** for August gained by Rs 4.50 or 0.25 per cent to Rs 1,778 per quintal, in an open interest of 82,660 lots.

All India cotton sowing reached 92.712 Lakh hectares against 104.266 Lakh hectares last year as on 20 July 2018

The average rainfall received in Andhra Pradesh from 1-6-2018 to 18-7-.2018 is recorded as 190.2 mm as against the Normal as on date of 179.5mm showing deviation from Normal 6 percent. Sowings of rain fed crops are under progress in all the districts of Andhra Pradesh early sown crops like Cotton sugarcane and Pulses at vegetative stage. The sucking pests were noticed in the cotton in the districts of Kurnool Ananthpuram and Krishna.

**Revival of rains after a two-week lull has not rekindled any hopes for cotton farmers in Telangana**. Though cotton sowing has been carried on about 12.1 lakh hectares (lh), the farmers are not much elated as they fear the rains are not enough for the crop to grow. The as-on-date numbers for sowing surpassed that of average as-on-date figure of 11.70 lh. This, however, was way lower than last year's as-on-date sown area of 14 lh.

According to the data shared by the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT), in 2017-18, India exported 3.92 lakh tonnes (It) of cotton (with length of 28.5 mm and above but not exceeding 34.5 mm) worth \$715 million to Bangladesh, up 12 per cent from 3.50 lt worth \$600 million in 2016-17. Exports to China, however, fell by 55 per cent between 2016-17 and 2017-18 from 1.54 lt to 69,219 tonnes. Exports to Pakistan remained almost flat at 1.46 lt in 2016-17 and 1.47 lakh tonnes in 2017-18.



#### **Monsoon Update:**

An active monsoon condition over the past 12 days has seen the country wide rain deficit reduce to 2% from a high of 9%. Rains have been also particularly poor in Uttar Pradesh, which currently has a season's shortfall of 42%. Bihar and Jharkhand, too, have deficits of 46% and 35%, respectively. The Met office expects the monsoon to remain active in the rest of the month, which means monsoon in July is likely to be normal.

### **International Fundamentals**

The trade war between China and US continues to be the main topic worries. The Chinese customs has already started to collect 25% tax on US imports under the normal trade quota. For processing quota mills still can avoid this high tax. Most mills are not ready buy imported cotton as they feel ICE is too high.

**The most active cotton contract on ICE Futures U.S.,** the second-month December contract, settled up 1.27 cent, or 1.46 percent, at 87.97 cents per lb. It traded within a range of 86.69 and 88.59 cents a lb, a peak since July 18.

China State Reserve Sold 21571.3771 Mts out of 30012.109 Mts. The average transaction price was 14,931 yuan / ton, Down 120 yuan / ton from the previous day. Discount 3128 price 16327 yuan /ton, Down 118 yuan/ton from the previous day. From March 12 to July 26, the accumulated turnover of reserve cotton was 17,23,200 tons, and the turnover rate was 59.82%. the highest traded price 17700 Yuan / ton, the lowest price 12700 Yuan / ton.

The latest U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) cotton projections for 2018/19 (August-July) indicate that world cotton mill use is forecast to reach a new record, in large part reflecting additional expected growth in the world economy. Global cotton consumption is projected at 127.0 million bales in 2018/19, 3.9 percent above 2017/18's 122.2-million-bale estimate. Mill use is forecast to rise in each of the leading raw cotton spinners in 2018/19, with China accounting for more than one-third of the world total.

**Cotton mill use growth varies by country and year of comparison**. Using 2015/16 as the base year, 2018/19 world cotton consumption is projected 12 percent higher. Likewise, relative to 3 years ago, cotton mill use in China in 2018/19 is expected 18 percent higher; in India, 2 percent higher; and in Pakistan, 4 percent higher. In addition, cotton mill use in Bangladesh and Vietnam continues to expand and the growth since 2015/16 has been remarkable. For Bangladesh, 2018/19 mill use is projected 27 percent higher than in 2015/16, while the growth for Vietnam is even more dramatic, with 2018/19 mill use expected to be nearly 67 percent above the 2015/16 level.

The All Pakistan Textile Mills Association (APTMA) has termed the re-imposition of 3 per cent customs duty and 2 per cent additional customs duty on the import of cotton 'the last nail in the coffin' for the ailing textile industry. Cotton crop has been below target for three consecutive seasons, contradicting production claims by the cotton commissioner, it said. The duties were effective starting July 15.
