

Domestic Fundamentals:**Market Outlook:**

The cotton physical market showed mixed trend today due to the commencement of CCI procurement on large scale. MCX cotton spot price was up at Rs.22,040 /bale Thursday. ICE cotton futures closed green on Wednesday.

News: Cotton Association of India has estimated cotton crop for 2020-21 season at 360 lakh bales. CAI in its March estimates for 2020-21 cotton seasons has estimated production at 360 lakh bales, higher from the previous estimates of 358.50 lakh bales. The total supply from October 2020 to March 2021 was estimated at 459.26 lakh bales, which consist arrivals of 326.76 lakh bales, whereas imports are estimated at 7.50 lakh bales and opening stock at 125 lakh bales. Further Consumption was estimated at 165 lakh bales and exports till 31st March 2021 was around 43 lakh bales, stock at the end of March 2021 was estimated at 251.26 lakh.

Cotton Corporation of India has procured around 92 lakh bales of cotton till March'2021 under Minimum Support Price program from various states like Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, and Karnataka. Cotton arrivals have slowed down in CCI purchase centers from March as currently the prices in the local market are higher than the minimum support price of cotton. Cotton arrivals were around 90,000 bales a day in February and have come down to below 30,000 bales till last week.

Telangana becomes the second biggest state under cotton area. Telangana ahead of Gujarat and becomes a second biggest state in the cotton acreages. Telangana is now looking forward to increase the cotton cultivation area by another 15-20 lakh acres in the coming kharif season. This will take the total cotton area to 75-80 lakh acres.

Cotton cultivation area is likely to increase in North India. According to the official sources sowing of cotton crop would increase in Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan by 2 percent as in the current season prices of raw cotton are much higher than the MSP. Where else in Maharashtra the area will drop by 2 percent as farmers are likely to shift to pulses in view of kapas price ruling around MSP level, while in, Madhya Pradesh demand for edible oils could see growers switching over to Soybean.

According to Shetkari Sanghatana, the apex farmer's body in Maharashtra has claimed that 50 percent of the cotton sown in the state is under HTBT Cotton. About 42.86 lakh hectares area in Maharashtra was under cotton cultivation in 2020 kharif season, that is 29 percent of the total land under Kharif Cultivation in the State, 25-35 percent of the area has been reportedly been put under HTBT (Herbicide tolerant Bt cotton). Although the Cultivation of HTBT is banned in India and only Bt cotton has been approved for commercial cultivation.

Cotton farmers from Guntur are planning to increase area under cultivation for Cotton. Cotton sowing area is expected to increase in the state in 2021-22 Kharif Season, as cotton prices in the local market are much higher around Rs. 6500 per quintal than the MSP of Rs. 5825 per quintal. At present farmers in Guntur are sowing cotton in 15 lakh acres, but it is expected that the area may expand to 18-20 lakh acres in the coming kharif season.

Cotton farmers may face seed shortage. As cotton farmers are planning to increase the area under cotton cultivation the supply of cottonseeds might become tight in the coming kharif season if farmers decide to expand the area going by the high price that prevailed during the current season to September. Cottonseed production and quality were affected last year due to excessive rains in the key producing state of Telangana and some parts of Tamil Nadu.

Genetically modified cotton seed prices have been increased by 5 percent. India has raised the prices for genetically modified cotton seed by 5 percent for the fiscal year that began in March. The prices are now at Rs 767 for a 450 gram packet and are up from 730 rupees.

Cotton farmers have gained this season as the cotton prices are above MSP. During the cotton season of 2020-21, Cotton Corporation of India has procured around 92 lakh bales under minimum support price operation. For the last six weeks, cotton prices have been ruling much above MSP, and currently they are 15-20% above MSP. As a result farmers are getting Rs 6,400 to Rs 6,500 per quintal as against the MSP of Rs 5,825 per quintal. Initially, it was expected by the

trade and market sources that CCI may be required to buy at least 1.5 crore bales but since the farmers are getting good price from the market forces itself, MSP intervention is not required now. This cotton season is almost at an end and has been a good year for CCI.

Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm with lightening , hail & gusty winds very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kahmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Punjab, West Uttar Pradesh and Sub-Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim and with lightening and gusty winds at isolated pockets over Jharkhand, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and with lightening & gusty winds at isolated places over Chattisgarh, Gangetic West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh and Kerala & Mahe and with lightening at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh, West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Bihar, Odisha, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema , Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Coastal & South Karnataka, Tamil nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep. Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Kerala & Mahe and Tamil nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.

International Fundamentals:

The ICE cotton Futures was up by 238 points at 84.2 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was down by 210 points at 87.40 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was at 64.92 cents/lb.

According to the 2020-21 U.S. cotton supply and demand forecast, higher exports and lower ending stock was observed as compared to last month. Production and domestic mill use are unchanged; where else the export forecast has been raised to 250,000 bales to 15.75 million, based on the increase in recent sales and shipments. Ending stock has now forecasted at 3.9 million bales, which is equivalent to 22 percent of total disappearance. The projected global production is around 276,000 bales lower than March month, led by decline in Australia and Turkmenistan and also the rising textile demand in china accounts for much of the 387,000 bales increase in projected 2020-21 world cotton consumption. World trade has also raised about 935,000 bales.

Pakistan is planning to import cotton from Uzbekistan. The Pakistan government is considering an option to import cotton from Uzbekistan via land route after it took back a decision of its import from India, as textile exporters want government to take decision regarding the 40 percent drop in the crop output.

China's cotton production is projected at 6.30 million tonnes in 2020-21 seasons, up by 8.7 percent from 2019-20 seasons, a new high since 2014-15. The cotton consumption along with the ending stock is also high this season, indicating the ample domestic cotton supply. If some cotton restriction is made by the government then, it is bound to increase the supply and Chinese cotton with high prices will be replaced by the imported cotton and Chinese cotton prices are supposed to come down.

The global 2020-21 cotton supply and demand estimates shows lower stocks and production. The April 2020-21 forecast shows marginal increase in consumption in Bangladesh and Mexico compared to March 2021. Global trade has boosted by greater import demand from China and Bangladesh. Also, higher exports are expected from Brazil, United States and Egypt.
