

### Cotton-Daily-Fundamental-Report 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2021

### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

### Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed a firm trend today as CCI procurement has slowed down and major markets are closed due to lockdown restrictions. MCX cotton spot price was higher at Rs.25,960/bale on Tuesday.ICE cotton futures closed red on Monday.

*News:* According to CRISIL, Farmers may change their Kharif cropping pattern especially in the northwest and central *India due to rainfall deficit as high as 55 percent.* Farmers may shift from oilseed such as soybean & groundnut to crop which have lower water requirements such as cotton and maize. Kharif sowing was also lower this time as compared to last year, with a total acreage lagging behind 12 percent. Earlier, the south west monsoon arrived in the country on 3<sup>rd</sup> June this year, and had covered 93 percent of Kharif acreage by 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2021, a week before its usual onset but after that point the monsoon played truant, resulting in a 32 percent deficit compared with the long period average between 23<sup>rd</sup> june to 12<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

The All India Crop Situation Report issued by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare shows a decrease in sowing area this year. A total of 611.89 lakh hectare of the area has been sown till 16<sup>th</sup> July'2021 against 691.93 lakh hectare same period last year. Cotton cultivation till 16<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and was at 98.38 lakh hectares compared with the normal of corresponding week at 90.33 lakh hectares. Thus 8.05 lakh hectares more area has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. Higher area was reported from the states of Telangana (5.33 lakh hectares), Gujarat (0.08 lakh hectares), Karnataka (0.94 lakh hectares), Mahrashtra (0.86 lakh hectares), Haryana (0.42 lakh hectares), and Rajasthan (0.57 lakh hectares) Madhya Pradesh (0.16 lakh hectares), Odisa ( 0.13 lakh hectares), and Tamil Nadu (0.01 lakh hectare). Less area was reported from the states of Andhra Pradesh (0.98 lakh hectares) and Punjab ( 0.62 lakh hectares).

**Cotton prices fell up to Rs. 700 per maund.** Cotton prices have fell by Rs. 400 to Rs. 700 per maund in local markets with the textile and spinning mills reluctant to buy rain affected commodities. According to the traders, monsoon rains in Sindh and Punjab has affected the cotton prices. In Sindh the prices have declined Rs. 400 to Rs. 600 per maund at Rs. 12600 to Rs. 12800 per maund. Seed cotton prices have also dropped by Rs. 300 to Rs. 400 per 40 kg to Rs. 5,200 to Rs. 5,700 per 40 kg. Cotton seed was sold for Rs. 1,700 to Rs. 1,800 per maund in Sindh.

**Cotton sowing reduces in Marathwada.** The area under cotton cultivation has decreased during this kharif season as farmers are shifting towards soybean over the traditional cash crop, due to range of factors including lower cultivation cost, shorter harvesting period, and resistance to diseases and pests. As per the latest official data, cotton has been sown on 67% of the estimated area of 6.97 lakh hectares in Aurangabad Division and 65 percent of the estimated area around 3.58 lakh hectares in Latur Division.

India is planning to sign MOU with Bangladesh to export 10 lakh bales of cotton annually. The Indian government is planning to sign a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with Bangladesh to export 10 lakh bales of cotton every year. Bangladesh is one of the largest buyers of Indian cotton and for its expanding textile industry, particularly garments the Bangladesh government wanted India to ensure an uninterrupted supply of cotton. According to Cotton Corporation of India, the MOU will facilitate a government-to-government transaction and it is expected that the memorandum will be signed soon.

**Cotton cultivation area increases in Gujarat but reduces in other North Indian states.** As farmers are opting for other oilseeds and pulses the area under cotton cultivation has decreased in North India. According to the latest data, cotton has been planted on about 18.43 lakh hectares in Gujarat, a marginal increase from 18.25 lakh hectares in the same period a year ago. Over all across India the area is lower by 17 percent as of 9<sup>th</sup> July 2021 at 86.45 lakh hectare compared with 104.82 lakh hectares a year ago.

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### Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening & gusty winds very likely at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana and with lightening at isolated places over Bihar, Jharkhand, Sub-Himalayana West Bengal & Sikkim, and Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Konkan & Goa, and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Ghat areas of Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Telangana, Kerala & Mahe, Odisa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, & Yanam, Coastal Karnataka, and Heavy rainfalls at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Jharkhand, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, & Tripura, Marathwada, Gujarat region, Interior Karnataka, and ghat areas of Tamil Nadu.

### **International Fundamentals:**

The ICE cotton Futures was lower by 35 points at 90.55 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was 120 points higher at 98.70 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was at 75.96 cents/lb.

According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, export projection for US cotton for the season 2021-22 shows a higher production, exports and ending stock compared with last month. While the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 U.S. cotton acreage report shows 300,000 fewer planted acres for U.S. cotton than NASS's previous survey, a rainfall driven reduction is projected. Texas abandonment means U.S. harvested area is projected 9 percent higher. While the 2021-22 production is estimated 800,000 bales higher, consumption is unchanged and exports and ending stock are each projected 400,000 bales higher.

According to USDA's Cotton and Wool Outlook report, World 2021-22 ending stock of cotton are projected 1.6 million bales lower than in June as largely offsetting changes in production and consumption do little to offset lower estimated beginning stocks. Beginning stocks are 1.5 million bales lower, largely due to reduced 2020-21 Brazilian and Indian production and higher Indian consumption. World production for 2021-22 is projected about 500,000 bales higher this month as a larger U.S. crop more than offsets a 300,000 bales decline for Pakistan. Although, consumption is slightly more than 600,000 bales higher largely due to an increase for India. World trade is projected 670,000 bales lower with China's import 1 million lower and Brazil's Export 1.1 million bales lower.

**Global Consumption has gained 12.5 percent in 2020-21.** According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, production is projected to return to pre pandemic levels next year. Global Consumption has also recovered from 2019-20, to post a 12.5 percent increase to 25.59 million tonnes in 2020-21 and is projected to improve further to 25.8 million tonnes. Also, Lower production with higher demand will cause ending stock to decline for the first time in four years at 20.96 million tonnes. For 2021-22 ending stock are forecasted to decline further to 20.77 million tonnes as mill use is expected to exceed production. Exports have also increased by 11.75 percent in 2020-21 compared to 2019-20 season and should remain at the same level in 2021-22.
