

#### Cotton-Daily-Fundamental-Report 13th Sep, 2021

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

#### Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed a mixed trend today as Cotton arrivals have slowed down in the market as the season is coming to an end. Although, the new cotton arrivals have started coming in the northern market. MCX cotton spot price was lower at Rs.26,600/bale on Saturday.ICE cotton futures closed green on Friday.

**News:** Cotton production is expected to increase up to 12 percent in Gujarat. The cotton production in Gujarat is expected to rise by 10-12 percent in the new cotton season beginning October. Despite the lower acreages around 22.51 lakh hectares under the cotton crop this kharif, the cotton output is expected to increase up 105 lakh bales in 2021-22 season due to the improved yield following recent spell of rains and favorable climatic conditions.

**Punjab Agriculture University has advised the farmers to monitor their cotton crop.** As the Pink Bollworm infestation was detected in Bhatinda and Mansa, the Punjab Agriculture University has advised the cotton growers to monitor their cotton fields for pink bollworm infestation. The agricultural expert has also advised the farmers that if any incidence occurs on their crop they can contact to PAU.

**Cotton crop has been affected due to heavy rains in Khammam.** The heavy rains during the past few days have affected the cotton and paddy crop in Khammam and Bhadradri -Kothagudem districts. According to the preliminary estimates of the Agriculture department around 1,887 acres of area has been damaged in Bhadradri -Kothagudem districts affecting over 1,393 farmers. In Khammam district, crops mainly paddy and cotton, were inundated by rainwater in around 1,720 acres.

**Cabinet has approved Production Linked Incentives scheme.** The cabinet has approved the PLI scheme for textiles for MMF (man-made fibre) apparel, MMF fabrics and ten segments of technical textiles with a budgetary outlay of ₹10,683 crore that will be provided over 5 years.

**Cotton sowing in Telangana is expected to decrease compared to previous season.** Telangana plans to touch the 28.32 lakh hectares mark in cotton has fallen as the farmers have sown the cotton crop only on over 20.23 lakh hectares as on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Also, the sowing is coming to an end; it is highly unlikely that there will be any improvement in acreages.

**Pink Bollworm infestation in Bhatinda.** As per the State Agriculture Department data, all the 14 blocks of Bhatinda and Mansa have reported the Pink Bollworm infestation in cotton. Around 3.25 lakh hectares is under cotton cultivation in Punjab, out of that nearly 5 percent of the area is under the Bathinda (96,000 hectares) and Mansa (65,000 hectares) is under pest attack. According to the agricultural officials, there is no serious threat to cotton production. The maiden picking of the three-picking cycle of cotton is expected to begin after September 15 whereas farmers have started harvesting in the early-sown fields.

**Tamil Nadu has removed 1 percent cotton cess on purchase of cotton and cotton waste.** The Southern India Mills Association lauded the decision on the revoking of the tax as it would benefit 200k farmers and help increase cotton production from 500k bales to 2.5 million bales by 2030. Also, this would encourage farmers to switch over to cotton crop from other cash crops and may benefit 1 million farmers in the long run.

According the Agriwatch estimates, till 02nd September '2021, about 118.13 lakh hectares area was sown in India compared to normal of corresponding week 126.45 lakh hectares last year. Higher area was reported from the states of Maharashtra (39.37 lakh hectares), Telangana (20.51 lakh hectares), Karnataka (6.28 lakh hectares), Rajasthan (6.17 lakh hectares), Haryana (6.88 lakh hectares), Madhya Pradesh (6.15 lakh hectares), and Gujarat (22.51 lakh hecatres). Less area was reported from the states of Andhra Pradesh (4.81 lakh hectares), Tamil Nadu (0.10 lakh hectares), Punjab (3.03 lakh hectares) and Odisha (1.95 lakh hectares).

#### Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening & gusty winds very likely at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal and with lightening at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Kerala & Mahe, Tamilnadu, Pondicherry & Karikal, Telangana. Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Odisha, Konkan & Goa, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra, Gujarat State and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttrakhand, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Coastal & South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe.

#### **International Fundamentals:**

The ICE cotton Futures was lower by 86 points at 93.22 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was at 103 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was at 80.11 cents/lb.

**Egyptian cotton production and exports may rise in the marketing year 2021**-22 as the country's area under cotton harvest is likely to increase to 85,000 hectares, a 30.77 percent growth over the previous MY's area of 65,000 hectares. The expected increase in cotton production coupled with the rising demand across the world will boost the country's exports.

According to the Food and Agriculture Outlook Report, India is expected to be the world's largest cotton producer till **2030.** Despite the challenges including land constraints, water shortage, climate change and crop's susceptibility to pest and disease attacks, India will continue to be the World's largest cotton producer till 2030. India's cotton production is expected to expand to 7.2 million tonnes (approximately 43 million bales of 170 kg each) compared with the current output of 6 MT equivalent to roughly 36 million bales. India will contribute to as much as 40 percent global increase in cotton production during the outlook period.

According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, For 2021-22 U.S. Cotton production is forecasted at 18.5 million bales up 1.2 million bales despite a decline in harvested area, largely due to increased projected yield in Texas.

**Pakistan cotton prices increases amid low yield and delayed imports**. The cotton prices are increasing in the local market amid a fall in the local production delay in cotton shipments from abroad and rising dollar rupee disparity. The Karachi cotton Association quoted Rs. 13,580 per maund as the spot rate for white lint, while the seed cotton prices were between Rs. 5200 – Rs. 6200 per maund.
