



Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed a mixed trend today. MCX cotton spot price was lower at Rs.26,300/bale on Thursday.ICE cotton futures closed green on Wednesday.

News: Cotton procurement in Maharashtra is likely to begin in November for the 2021-22 seasons. According to the Minister of Cooperation and Marketing, Kharif cotton procurement for 2021-22 seasons should commence from the first week of November to facilitate timely sales and income for farmers. The directives comes in the wake of a delay in the last kharif season due to covid 19 pandemic and lockdown through which cotton procurement centers did not opened on time.

Pink bollworm attack in Punjab is at alarming stage. The Pink Bollworm attack on cotton crop in Punjab has increased from previous week of 10-15 percent. Major damage was reported from Bhatinda and Mansa. The pest has also caused damaged to the crop in border areas of Fazilka and Muktsar but with less intensity. In some of the districts in Bhatinda, Maur, Sangat blocks the damage is found to be above 50 percent and at some places reaching up to 60-70 percent.

According to the Ministry of Agriculture and farmer's welfare, India's food grain production in Kharif 2021-22 seasons has estimated at a record of 150.5 million tonnes. Last year's Kharif production was estimated at 149.56 million tonnes for 2020-21 seasons. Among the Cash crops, Cotton production for this year is estimated at 36.22 million bales higher by 2.4 percent from last year.

New Cotton prices are ruling above minimum support price of Rs. 5,726 per quintal. The new cotton crop has started arriving in the northern market, Karnataka, Telangana with prices of raw cotton ruling at least 10 percent higher than the minimum support price of Rs. 5,726 per quintal for 2021-22 season. According to the trade estimates, the daily market arrivals are at over 10,000 bales, majorly from the north. Modal prices of raw cotton are ranging between Rs. 6,400- Rs. 7,000 per quintal across the various markets depending upon the quality and moisture content.

Pink Bollworm infestation spreads to Sangrur. After Bhatinda and Mansa, pink bollworm spread has now been reported in cotton crop in Sunam and Lehragaga subdivision of Sangrur in Punjab. The Punjab agriculture department on Wednesday directed all eight cotton-growing districts to immediately start a drive to check the spread of pink bollworm after an extensive infestation of the disease was reported in adjoining districts of Haryana and parts of Rajasthan. According to the Punjab Agriculture Department the next three weeks are crucial for the spread of the infestation. All cotton growing villages will be surveyed twice in the next three weeks. Experts have also asked the farmers to follow the quidelines issued by the department.

The All India Crop Situation Report issued by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare shows a decrease in sowing area this year. Cotton acreage till 10th September 2021 stood at 119.46 lakh hectares compared with the normal of the corresponding week last year at 119.33 lakh hectares. Thus 0.01 lakh hectares less area has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The higher area was reported from the states of Telangana (2.29 lakh hectares), Karnataka (0.89 lakh hectares), Haryana (0.37 lakh hectares), and Rajasthan (1.69 lakh hectares), Odisha (0.41 lakh hectares), and Tamil Nadu (0.01 lakh hectare). Less area was reported from the states of Gujarat (2.83 lakh hectares), Maharashtra (2.09 lakh hectares), Andhra Pradesh (0.49 lakh hectares), Madhya Pradesh (0.15 lakh hectares), and Punjab (0.12 lakh hectares).

Cotton crop has been destroyed due to heavy rains in old Adilabad. Unexpected rains during the past few days have affected to the cotton and soya crop in old Adilabad. The standing cotton crop is badly affected in the area and farmers who have suffered losses due to inundation of cotton plants are now planning to sow Bengal gram. The farmers are also demanding the state government to order a survey immediately to access the crop damage and pay compensation to them.



Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan, Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Jharkhand, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, and Pondicherry & Karikal. Heavy rainfall at isolated places over East Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, West Madhya Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Odisha, Gujarat state, and Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam.

International Fundamentals:

The ICE cotton Futures was higher by 84 points at 90.87 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index fell by 280 points and was at 99.35 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was at 79.53 cents/lb.

The Cotton Crop Assessment Committee had revised the Pakistan's cotton production target downward by 19 percent from 10.5 million to 8.46 million bales. Apart from lowest area under cotton cultivation i.e. 1.871 million hectares, some major biotic constraints including cotton leaf curl virus, mealybug, and whitefly attacks have also forced the government to cut the estimates. According to Syed Fakhar Imam, Federal Minister for National Food Security and Research, cotton production may exceed the estimate of 8.46 million bales, as 2.69 million bales of cotton have been transferred to the ginning factories till September 15, compared to 1.04 million bales in same period of last year. Whereas last year, the cotton production was around 5.57 million bales.

According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee September Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, production is projected to increase by 3 percent in 2021-22 season to 25.20 million tonnes. Global Consumption has also recovered from 2019-20, to post a 12.4 percent increase to 25.6 million tonnes in 2020-21 and is projected to improve further to 25.9 million tonnes in 2021-22. World Exports for 2021-22 are estimated at 10.31 million tonnes.

According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, World 2021/22 production is higher this month as increases for the United States, Australia, and Argentina offset declines in India, Greece, and several countries in West Africa's Zone. World trade in 2021/22 is still projected down from the previous year's record 48.5 million bales, but is projected 500,000 bales higher than in August, at 46.8 million bales.

Egyptian cotton production and exports may rise in the marketing year 2021-22 as the country's area under cotton harvest is likely to increase to 85,000 hectares, a 30.77 percent growth over the previous MY's area of 65,000 hectares. The expected increase in cotton production coupled with the rising demand across the world will boost the country's exports.
