

## Domestic Fundamentals:

## Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed a mixed trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price was higher at Rs.44,560/bale on Thursday. ICE cotton futures closed red on Wednesday.

**News:** Cotton farmers from Haryana are expecting a crop loss due to heavy rains in the past week. The Hisar district of Haryana has received above the average rainfall which poses a threat to the cotton crop. Although no major damage has been received so far but water-logged fields may further result in pest attack and yield losses. The Agriculture Department has asked the farmers to drain out the standing water from the cotton fields and also alerted the farmers to keep observation on the crop about attack by any pest. Overall, around 18-19 lakh acres of area is estimated to be in under cotton cultivation in the state for the 2022-23 season.

As of 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022, Gujarat Cotton sowing has reached 25,04,390 hectares for the 2022-23 season which is higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 22,22,372 hectares.

As of 03<sup>rd</sup> Aug 2022, Telangana Cotton sowing has reached 4542355 acres for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 4985895 acres. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 27.07.2022 has reached 675.8 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 546.6 mm.

According to the data released by Agriculture Ministry, as of 29<sup>th</sup> July 2022, Cotton sowing has been reported at 110.73 lakh hectares which was 119 lakh hectares in the previous 2021-22 season.

Cotton Crop has been damaged due to excessive rains in Gujarat, Maharashtra, and Telangana. Also, If rains continue to hit the state for the next few days more crop is likely to get damaged. Cotton sowing in Maharashtra is expected to cross 4.2 million hectares. In Gujarat, it would be around 2.7 million hectares. Overall, the cotton acreage in the north is expected to be around 1.5 million hectares and the same for southern states is likely to remain at around 3.5-4.0 million hectares. Agriwatch expects area under cotton cultivation to be 137 lakh hectares in the 2022-23 season.

Also, In Punjab, the area under cotton cultivation is the lowest since 2010, also the Cotton crop is on the radar for a second straight year as attacks of whitefly and pink bollworm have been witnessed in Punjab.

As per Agriwatch, for the coming week heavy rains may be witnessed across the key cotton-growing regions such as Maharashtra, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Telangana, Gujarat, Saurashtra, Kutch, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Punjab, and Haryana. These rains will further likely to affect the cotton crop in the coming week. Also, Due to these heavy rains cotton sowing has been affected and we expect that cotton farmers from Telangana may shift towards chilies if these rains continue to affect the crop.

The areas of Adilabad, Karimnagar, Nizamabad, Warangal, Khammam, Medak, and other some districts in Telangana have witnessed heavy rains this week. These rains and floods have damaged around 20 lakh acres of cotton fields, in the previous season around 25 lakh acres of cotton crop was destroyed due to heavy rains. In the Vanakalam (Kharif) season this year, farmers had sown cotton in around 43 lakh acres, but incessant rains have

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damaged around 20 percent of the crop. The cotton farmers are worried over the sowing in the rainy season as delay in sowing would adversely affect the yield.

## Weather Forecast:

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Coastal and South Interior Karnataka, and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra, Konkan & Goa, North Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, Karikal, Kerala & Mahe, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gujarat region, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Marathwada. Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, and with lightening at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Madhya Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Gangetic west Bengal, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, & Tripura, Gujarat region, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karaikal.

## **International Fundamentals:**

The ICE cotton Futures was lower by 51 points at 100.36 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was stable at 114.60 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was 104.48 cents/lb.

According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as of 31<sup>st</sup> July 2022, U.S cotton Squaring stands at 89 percent which is higher than that of the previous season (81 percent). In the previous week cotton squaring was 80 percent. Overall 6 percent of the U.S Cotton Crop is in excellent condition, 34 percent in good to a fair condition which was 32 percent in the previous week.

According to the USDA Cotton estimate for the 2021-22 season, Global cotton production is lowered by 725,000 bales due primarily to a decline in Brazil. Global use is estimated lower by 1.9 million bales, and ending stocks are up over 1.0 million bales. Further, Global trade is down with a 1.3-million-bale drop in imports and 1.2-million-bale drop in exports. Notable decreases in imports were seen from Bangladesh, China, India, and Vietnam. Also, exports are down from Australia, India, Mali, and the United States. Overall Global Cotton production is estimated at 121.27 million bales in the 2021-22 season, Imports are estimated at 43.32 million bales, and domestic use at 119.79 million bales. Further global exports for the 2021-22 season are estimated at 43.93 million bales resulting in an ending stock of 84.04 million bales. Stock to use ration for the 2021-22 season is estimated at 51.38 percent.
