

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed a mixed trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price was stable at Rs.47,070/bale on Monday. ICE cotton futures closed green on Friday.

News: MCX under the circular no. MCX/TRD/499/2022 has notified that the exchange is in process of modifying the Cotton contract specification. Accordingly, with effect from August 29, 2022, no fresh positions will be permitted in Cotton January 2023 expiry contract which has currently nil open interest. Cotton February 2023 expiry and subsequent expiry contracts will temporarily not be launched for trading till such time the revised contract specification is finalized. Also, No changes for other running Cotton contracts with Open Interest.

New Cotton Arrivals

Northern India: As per Agriwatch, New cotton arrivals are expected to come late in the 1st week of September 2022 from Rajasthan and Haryana. Although, arrivals had started from some districts of Punjab but are very slow. The new cotton prices at Bhatinda are currently at Rs. 9300 per quintal.

Central India: Arrivals have also started in Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh but are in smaller quantities, prices for the new cotton in Gujarat are currently at Rs. 11,600 to 12,000 per quintal whereas in Madhya Pradesh prices are at Rs. 9,511-11,001 per quintal. Arrivals are currently around 2-3 quintal; overall moisture content in the new cotton crop is around 30-35%.

As of 24th Aug 2022, Gujarat Cotton sowing has reached 5.72 lakh hectares for the 2022-23 season which is higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 4.46 lakh hectares. Average rainfall reported during the

01.06.2022 to 24.08.2022 is around 384.70 mm against the normal 384.3 mm.

As of 22nd Aug 2022, Gujarat Cotton sowing has reached 25,38,383 hectares for the 2022-23 season which is higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 22,50,743 hectares.

According to the data released by Agriculture Ministry, as of 19th August 2022, Cotton sowing has been reported at 124.27 lakh hectares which was 116.51 lakh hectares in the previous 2021-22 season. Agriwatch expects cotton sowing to reach 128 lakh hectares in the 2022-23 season. Earlier, due to excess rainfall in July month cotton sowing was affected in central and southern India.

According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare Fourth Advance estimate, total cotton production in India for the

2021-22 season is expected to be at 312 lakh bales as compared to the previous season of 352 lakh bales in the 2020-21 season. As per Agriwatch, the decrease in production is mainly due to a decrease in area and yield earlier in the 2021-22 season.



Weather Forecast:

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Bihar, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, Kerala & Mahe, & Karaikal, Arunachal Pradesh. Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning at isolated places over Rayalaseema, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Westt Bengal & Sikkim, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

International Fundamentals:

The ICE cotton Futures was higher by 494 points at 122.12 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was high at 132.25 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was 104.48 cents/lb.

According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as of 21st Aug 2022, U.S cotton Cotton Bolls opening stands at 19 percent which is higher than that of the previous season (13 percent). In the previous week cotton bolls opening was 15 percent. Overall 5 percent of the U.S Cotton Crop is in excellent condition, 26 percent in good to a fair condition which was 29 percent in the previous week.

Overall, the cotton crop is likely to get affected in the 2022-23 season due to adverse weather in the major cotton-producing countries. As the U.S. cotton crop is being affected due to drought. The U.S. Department of Agriculture has forecasted for the domestic cotton crop to 12.6 million bales, which would be down by around 28% from last year. Severe drought and some of the hottest weather have scorched fields and driven a historically high level of abandonment in the Southwest.

China is also likely to have a lower production in the 2022-23 season as the crop is getting affected due to severe heat waves. Also, one of the largest cotton exporters Brazil is battling with extreme heat and drought that have already reduced the yields by nearly 30 percent in the 2022-23 season.

As per Agriwatch, In India too, the heavy rainfalls and pest attacks are affecting the cotton crop. In the northern states of Punjab, Haryana, and Rajasthan cotton crop has been affected due to pink bollworm infestation. As a result, new cotton arrivals are expected to come late in the 1st week of September 2022 from Rajasthan and Haryana. Although, arrivals had started from some districts of Punjab but are very slow. Whereas else in Maharashtra and Telangana excess rainfall in July, over the major cotton-growing districts has affected the crop.
