

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed a mixed trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price was lower at Rs.41,490/bale on Tuesday. MCX cotton prices have reduced over 25 % as compared to the last week mainly because of the expectation of good production in the 2022-23 season. ICE cotton futures closed green on Monday.

News: Domestic cotton arrivals have started in the market and with the increase in arrivals, the cotton prices have

reduced from nearly Rs. 1,00,000 to Rs. 90,000 a candy in the market. However, Indian cotton prices are still higher by around 15% to 20% compared to international prices.

As per the Southern India Mills Association, the cotton requirement by the domestic textile industry is likely to be more than the production in the 2022-23 season and duty-free export of cotton that may result in 12% to 15% of good quality raw cotton going out of the country, which may lead to cotton shortage during the off-season.

As per the market sources, the Cotton crop in Kurnool has been affected by Tobacco Streak Virus (TSV) in some of the areas including Gudur, Kodumuru, Emmiganur madals of Kurnool district and Atmakur and Nandyal district. Although the cotton crop is not affected much as of now (the incidence is below TTL) but if rain continues further, the crop yields may get affected.

According to AgriWatch sources, overall cotton crop is in good condition across the country. Although, coming 15-20 days are crucial for the crop in terms of adverse weather and pest attack in major cotton growing states.

expects overall cotton sowing to reach 128 Lakh Ha. in 2022-23 season. Earlier, due to excess rainfall in July month cotton sowing was affected in central and southern India.

According to the trade sources, Indian cotton production for the 2022-23 season is expected to increase to 375 lakh bales as compared to 312 lakh bales in the 2021-22 season. Prices are further expected to come down in the 2022-23 season. The increase in acreages, good crop with a demand slowdown in the cotton value chain may cause supply pressure thereby triggering a downward price trend in the 2022 year. AgriWatch expects cotton production to reach 348.16 lakh bales in the 2022-23 season.

International Fundamentals:

The ICE cotton Futures was higher by 87 points at 105.71 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was high at 122.40 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was 94.92 cents/lb.

According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as of 11th Sep 2022, U.S cotton Cotton Bolls opening stands at 49 percent which is higher than that of the previous season (35 percent). In the previous week cotton bolls opening was 39 percent. Overall 4 percent of the U.S Cotton Crop is in excellent condition, 30 percent in good to a fair condition which was 34 percent in the previous week.

According to USDA, Cotton and product update report, global cotton production is estimated higher at 118.40 million bales, and stocks are projected higher this month. However, Consumption has slightly decreased to 118.60 million bales with lower projected use in Pakistan and Vietnam. Global trade is unchanged as higher U.S. exports more than offset lower Brazil shipments.

Pakistan cotton production is forecasted down by 700,000 bales to 5.5 million bales amid smaller crop estimation due to heavy rains and floods. Cotton consumption is estimated lower by 400,000 bales to 10.5 million bales. Overall cotton imports are likely to increase in the 2022-23 season to 4.8 million bales. However, with a significant decline in production from the United States, The All-Pakistan Textile Mills Association is reported to have asked government officials to consider lifting the country's restriction on imports of Indian cotton. Earlier, Pakistan has restricted India cotton in 2019 due to border disputes and this urgent request underscores Pakistan's dire need for cotton.
