

#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

#### **Market Outlook:**

The cotton physical market showed a mixed trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price was higher at Rs.40,060/bale on Saturday. MCX cotton prices have reduced over 25 % as compared to the last week mainly because of the expectation of good production in the 2022-23 season. ICE cotton futures closed red on Friday.

**News:** As of Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Cotton sowing has reached 127.14 Lakh Ha. Vs 118.23 Lakh Ha. same period last year. Agriwatch expects overall cotton sowing to reach 128 Lakh Ha. in 2022-23 season. Earlier, due to excess rainfall in July month cotton sowing was affected in central and southern India.

AgriWatch expects that the coming 2-3 weeks are very crucial for the cotton crop. The ongoing heavy rains in Maharashtra and Gujarat may affect the cotton arrivals in the coming weeks. Also, if rain continues the cotton yield and quality may get affected adversely, currently the crop is in flowering stage in most of the key producing regions. In the coming days, raw cotton prices may see an uptrend if rains continue as predicted by Indian Metrological Department (IMD).

As of 14<sup>th</sup> Sept 2022, Telangana Cotton sowing has reached 4979225 acres for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 5095678 acres. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 14.09.2022 has reached 1028 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 881 mm across the state.

Andhra Pradesh Cotton sowing has reached 6.37 lakh hectares for the 2022-23 season which is slightly higher as compared to the previous season's sowing of 4.86 lakh hectares, till 14<sup>th</sup> Sept 2022. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 14.09.2022 has reached 528 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 484 mm across the state.

Cotton arrivals have also started from Warangal around one month before the new 2022-23 season. However, arrivals are very slow in the market. Cotton prices in Warangal are trading at Rs. 8,199 per quintal. As per Agriwatch Sources, the overall quality of cotton is good in the market.



#### **Weather Forecast:**

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttarakhand, East Uttar Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, ghats area of Madhya Maharashtra, and Konkan & Goa. Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Bihar, Gangetic West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, Karikal.

#### **International Fundamentals:**

The ICE cotton Futures was lower by 400 points at 99.29 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was high at 121.25 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was 95.17 cents/lb.

According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as of 11<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022, U.S cotton Cotton Bolls opening stands at 49 percent which is higher than that of the previous season (35 percent). In the previous week cotton bolls opening was 39 percent. Overall 4 percent of the U.S Cotton Crop is in excellent condition, 30 percent in good to a fair condition which was 34 percent in the previous week.

According to USDA, Cotton and product update report, global cotton production is estimated higher at 118.40 million bales, and stocks are projected higher this month. However, Consumption has slightly decreased to 118.60 million bales with lower projected use in Pakistan and Vietnam. Global trade is unchanged as higher U.S. exports more than offset lower Brazil shipments.

Pakistan cotton production is forecasted down by 700,000 bales to 5.5 million bales amid smaller crop estimation due to heavy rains and floods. Cotton consumption is estimated lower by 400,000 bales to 10.5 million bales. Overall cotton imports are likely to increase in the 2022-23 season to 4.8 million bales. However, with a significant decline in production from the United States, The All-Pakistan Textile Mills Association is reported to have asked government officials to consider lifting the country's restriction on imports of Indian cotton. Earlier, Pakistan has restricted India cotton in 2019 due to border disputes and this urgent request underscores Pakistan's dire need for cotton.
