

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed a mixed trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price was higher at Rs.34,240/bale on Thursday. ICE cotton futures closed green on Wednesday.

News: As per AgriWatch Sources, the rainfall during the last week has affected the quality of cotton in some parts of Gujarat. Overall, the moisture percentage has increased to 30-35% in the new cotton. The market is currently witnessing low demand as textile mills are closed for the 2021-22 season but will soon start operations for the 2022-23 season as the new cotton season is going start from 01^{st} October 2022.

As of 28th Sept 2022, Telangana Cotton sowing has reached 5000724 acres for the 2022-23 season which is slightly higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 4668057 acres. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 28.09.2022 has reached 1075 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 1007 mm across the state.

The heavy rainfall during the past week has affected the cotton crop in Mansa district of Punjab. As per the market sources around 24 villages have been damaged as fields have become inundated. The Agriculture Department is yet to access the loss suffered by farmers. Along with Punjab, farmers from Haryana had also suffered crop loss due to incessant rains during the last week. Farmers from Bhiwani district of Haryana had suffered losses majorly.

The Department of Agriculture, Rajasthan has released its first advance estimate for the 2022-23 season. Overall cotton production in the state is expected to reach 2897428 tonnes during the 2022-23 season. The area under cotton cultivation in the state has increased from 6.28 lakh hectares to 6.83 lakh hectares. The average yield is expected to be 721 kgs per hectare in the 2022-23 season.

The Directorate of Agriculture, Gujarat has released its first advance estimate for the 2022-23 season. Overall cotton production in Gujarat is expected to reach 9184.96 bales (170kg each) during the 2022-23 season. The area under cotton cultivation in the state has increased from 22.53 lakh hectares to 25.48 lakh hectares. The average yield is expected to increase in the 2022-23 season to 615 kgs per hectare due to favorable weather conditions.

According to the Indian Cotton Federation (ICF), the cotton scenario for the 2022-23 season remains unpredictable. The overall estimates of cotton area and production are changing almost on a daily basis. Further, Textile mills are demanding contamination-free cotton with just 8 % moisture level. The Central government is considering a model cotton contract along with arbitration norms for dispute resolution.

As of 26th Sept 2022, Gujrat Cotton sowing has reached 25,48.932 hectares for the 2022-23 season which is slightly higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 22,53,933 hectares. Cotton Arrivals have been delayed in Gujarat due to heavy rains. The prices for raw cotton have also fallen in the local market to Rs. 5,000-7,000 per candy during the last week.

As of Sept. 23rd, 2022 Cotton sowing has reached 127.39 Lakh Ha. Vs 118.56 Lakh Ha. same period last year. Agriwatch expects overall the cotton sowing to reach 128 Lakh Ha. in 2022-23 season. Earlier, due to excess rainfall in July month cotton sowing was affected in central and southern India.

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, North Interior Karnataka. Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Odisha, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Konkan, Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, North Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karaikal.

International Fundamentals:

The ICE cotton Futures was higher by 40 points at 88.49 cents/lb. The Cotlook A index was lower at 110.85 cents/lb. The AWP for cotton was 88.88 cents/lb.

According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as of 26th Sep 2022, U.S cotton Cotton Bolls opening stands at 67 percent which is higher than that of the previous season (59 percent). In the previous week cotton bolls opening was 58 percent. Overall 4 percent of the U.S Cotton Crop is in excellent condition, 27 percent in good to a fair condition which was 28 percent in the previous week.

Cotton production in Pakistan has reached 2.19 million bales till 15th September 2022, which is around 19% lower from the previous season. The production has fallen mainly due to heavy rainfalls. As a result, Pakistan may import 5.5-6 million bales of cotton to overcome the shortfall in the 2022-23 season.

According to USDA, Cotton and product update report, global cotton production is estimated higher at 118.40 million bales, and stocks are projected higher this month. However, Consumption has slightly decreased to 118.60 million bales with lower projected use in Pakistan and Vietnam. Global trade is unchanged as higher U.S. exports more than offset lower Brazil shipments.
