

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed mixed trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price traded lower at Rs. 62,120/candy on Saturday. ICE cotton futures closed red on Friday.

News

The Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) will procure fair average quality (FAQ) grade cotton from farmers till 31st March 2023 for the 2022-2023 cotton season.

As per the Madhya Pradesh Association of Cotton Processors and Traders, about 50 percent of ginning units have closed their operation due to the unavailability of raw cotton, while those operating are getting just 30-40 percent raw cotton against their full capacity.

Daily arrivals of cotton in the spot market at Khargone has reduced to 5,000- 6,000 quintal as against 20,000 quintal in the corresponding period last season. Farmers are holding stock in anticipation of better prices.

Cotton daily arrivals were at around 1,30,000-1,40,000 bales per day and total arrivals were around 12 lakh bales., during the past week. Arrivals have increased during the past week as farmers are releasing their stocks. Cottonseed and oilcake prices remained lower during the last week. There is very limited demand for cottonseed in the market. So, prices are likely to go down with the pressure of arrivals and due to weak demand.

Cotton prices in Gujarat market traded with weak sentiments. Cotton arrivals had increased comparatively in Gujarat market, daily arrivals are around 35000 bales whereas prices are trading at Rs.8200 per quintal.

Indian Metrological Department has released its seasonal outlook for hot weather for the coming months, as per that, during the upcoming hot weather season (March to May), above normal maximum temperatures are likely over most parts of northeast India, east and central India and some parts of northwest India. Normal to below normal maximum temperatures are most likely over the remaining parts of the country.

At AgriWatch, we expect that the maximum temperature may affect the early cotton sowing for the coming 2023-24 season in northern and central India. Presently, the temperature is on the rise in most of the region. The reports of dry spell this year, may affect the standing crop although about 75% of the crop has been harvested.

Cotton daily arrivals were at around 1,12,000-1,16,000 bales per day. During the past week, arrivals were around 10 lakh bales. Arrivals has increased during the past week as farmers are releasing their stock.

The Cotton Corporation of India may stop procuring cotton at MSP after 31st March 2023. The raw cotton prices are currently trading at Rs. 8,250 per quintal at Rajkot Market which is much above the minimum support price of Rs. 6,380 per quintal.


The Tamil Nadu Agriculture University expects cotton prices to go down to Rs. 7,000 to Rs. 7,500 per quintal in the coming months. While the area under cotton cultivation has increased this year, demand from the domestic textile industry is low and export prices are under pressure. Hence, cotton offtake remains lower. Presently, only about 40% of the textile mills are working in the Tripura-Coimbatore region.

ICE cotton futures fell over 3% to hit their; lowest in nearly four months on Friday, as a lack of demand for the natural fibre and downbeat sentiments across wider financial markets weighed. The market was down about 4.2% for a week so far. Prices have dropped for a fourth consecutive session on Friday.

According to USDA WASDE report, U.S. cotton supply and demand forecasts for the 2022-23 season are unchanged relative to last month. The global 2022-23 cotton supply and demand forecasts this month include lower consumption and trade, and higher production and stocks. Beginning stocks are almost 900,000 bales higher. World cotton consumption in 2022-23 season is 555,000 bales lower this month with reductions in Turkey, Pakistan, Indonesia, and Bangladesh.

Projected imports are lower for each of these countries and for China, while exports are lower for Brazil, India, and Argentina, with world trade totaling 785,000 bales lower. Production is more than 700,000 bales higher as larger expected crops in China, Australia, and Uzbekistan more than offset reduced prospects for India. At 91.1 million bales, 2022/23 world-ending stocks are projected 2.1 million higher than a month earlier and 5.0 million higher than in 2021/22.

Cotton Yarn

As per the market sources, Cotton yarn prices remained steady yesterday in south India amid average buying. There has been no movement in the prices of cotton yarn in Tiruppur and Mumbai as the demand has weakened, though it is still better than last month. Mumbai has noted weaker demand for cotton yarn, while prices have remained steady.

In Mumbai, 60 count carded cotton yarn of warp and weft varieties were traded at Rs.1,525-1,540 and Rs.1,430-1,470 per 5 kg respectively. 60 combed warp was priced at Rs.342-345 per kg, 80 carded (weft) cotton yarn was sold at Rs.1,440-1,480 per 4.5 kg.
