

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed bearish trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price traded lower at Rs. 61,160/candy on Thursday. ICE cotton futures closed green on Wednesday.

News

As per the Cotton Association of India latest estimate of the cotton crop for 2022-23 season. The CAI has reduced its cotton crop estimate by 8.50 lakh bales for the 2022-23 season to 313 lakh bales from 321.50 lakh bales. The CAI has reduced its cotton crop in Punjab by 0.50 lakh bales, Haryana by 1.00 lakh bales, Maharashtra by 2 lakh bales, Telangana by 3 lakh bales, Tamil Nadu by 0.50 lakh bales, and others by 0.50 lakh bales, 1.50 lakh bales and Karnataka by 1 lakh bales.

Cotton imports were maintained at 12 lakh bales and exports at 30 lakh bales. Domestic consumption was estimated at 300 lakh bales. Overall, the ending stock for the 2022-23 season was estimated at 26.89 lakh bales. As per Cotton Association of India, Cotton arrivals between October 2022 to February 2023 were estimated at 154.84 lakh bales.

Punjab cotton sowing is likely to start from 15th April 2023. The Punjab government has decided to provide subsidy up to 33% on Bt cottonseed to cotton farmers. During the previous season about 2.47 lakh hectares of land was under cotton cultivation. For the coming season, the government has set a target of around 3 lakh hectares for cotton sowing.

According to Indian Cotton Association Limited, Cotton arrivals till 28th February in Punjab was reported at 1.69 lakh bales, in Haryana about 6.86 lakh bales and in Rajasthan about 22.53 lakh bales. Also, the cotton production is expected to fall in Punjab, and Haryana. While in Rajasthan production is expected to improve in the 2022-23 season.

The Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) will procure fair average quality (FAQ) grade cotton from farmers till 31st March 2023 for the 2022-2023 cotton season.

As per the Madhya Pradesh Association of Cotton Processors and Traders, about 50 percent of ginning units have closed their operation due to the unavailability of raw cotton, while those operating are getting just 30-40 percent raw cotton against their full capacity.

Daily arrivals of cotton in the spot market at Khargone has reduced to 5,000- 6,000 quintal as against 20,000 quintal in the corresponding period last season. Farmers are holding stock in anticipation of better prices.




Cotton daily arrivals were at around 1,30,000-1,40,000 bales per day and total arrivals were around 12 lakh bales., during the past week. Arrivals have increased during the past week as farmers are releasing their stocks. Cottonseed and oilcake prices remained lower during the last week. There is very limited demand for cottonseed in the market. So, prices are likely to go down with the pressure of arrivals and due to weak demand.

According to USDA WASDE report, U.S. cotton supply and demand forecasts for the 2022-23 season are unchanged relative to last month. The global 2022-23 cotton supply and demand forecasts this month include lower consumption and trade, and higher production and stocks. Beginning stocks are almost 900,000 bales higher. World cotton consumption in 2022-23 season is 555,000 bales lower this month with reductions in Turkey, Pakistan, Indonesia, and Bangladesh.

Projected imports are lower for each of these countries and for China, while exports are lower for Brazil, India, and Argentina, with world trade totaling 785,000 bales lower. Production is more than 700,000 bales higher as larger expected crops in China, Australia, and Uzbekistan more than offset reduced prospects for India. At 91.1 million bales, 2022/23 world-ending stocks are projected 2.1 million higher than a month earlier and 5.0 million higher than in 2021/22.

Cotton Yarn

As per the market sources, Cotton yarn prices in South India remained stable yesterday, despite slower demand from the downstream industry. In Mumbai and Tiruppur market, cotton yarn was sold at previous levels. However, spinning mills in South India were aggressively selling yarn in Maharashtra, as weaving industries were facing a labour shortage due to the absence of migrant workers after the Holi festival.

In Mumbai, the 60 count carded cotton yarn of warp and weft varieties were traded at Rs.1,525-1,540 and Rs.1,400-1,450 per 5 kg. The 60 count combed warp was priced at Rs.342-345 per kg. Meanwhile, the 80 count carded (weft) cotton yarn was sold at Rs.1,440-1,480 per 4.5 kg, and the 44/46 count carded cotton yarn (warp) was priced at Rs.280-285 per kg.
