Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed mixed trend across India today. MCX cotton was closed due to Bhim Rao Ambedkar Jayanti. ICE cotton futures closed green on Thursday.


News

- Cotton exports in India is likely to decline to a 19-year low in the 2022-23 season due to poor demand from importing nations in view of the economic slowdown in the US and Europe.
- According to the USDA, Cotton: World Markets and Trade report, Indian cotton exports are projected lower by 500,000 bales this month to 1.8 million (US bales of 227.72 kg or 23.05 lakh Indian bales of 170 kg), roughly equal to its import forecast.
- Whereas, Global trade is forecast down more than 700,000 bales from the previous month to 38.8 million bales. This month's adjustments are mostly attributed to less imports in China, Turkey, and Bangladesh. Lower Brazil and India shipments more than offset higher Australia and U.S. exports.
- According to Cotton Association of India, Indian cotton prices are currently prevailing at Rs. 62,500-63,000 per candy. It is expected that the rates may trade steady now but after May month, cotton arrivals are expected to reduce and cotton prices may trade upward. Cotton prices may touch Rs 70,000-75,000 per candy in June-July in coming months

Weather Forecast

- According to USDA, WASDE April 2023 report, U.S. cotton supply and demand forecasts show higher exports and lower ending stocks relative to last month, with production and domestic mill use unchanged for the 2022-23 season. The export forecast is raised 200,000 bales, to 12.2 million, based on the pace of recent sales and shipments. Further, ending stocks are forecast at 4.1 million bales, equivalent to 29% of total disappearance.
- The Global cotton balance sheet for 2022-23 season, World production is forecast 829,000 bales higher than in March as a 1-million-bale increase for China more than offsets a lower Brazilian crop. World 2022-23 ending stocks are projected 867,000 bales higher, with the largest increase in India, where projected stocks are 450,000 higher on lower exports. The expected volume of world trade in 2022-23 is 745,000 bales lower this month, with imports reduced for Bangladesh, China, and Turkey.
- On the export side, higher U.S. and Australia exports are more than offset by a 550,000-bale reduction for Brazil and a 400,000-bale reduction for India. Projected 2022-23 global consumption is 65,000 bales higher this month as a 500,000-bale increase for China more than offsets declines in Bangladesh and Turkey.

Cotton Yarn

• Due to rise in Fibre prices, south Indian yarn prices have increased by Rs. 4-6 per kg yesterday. Trippura market witnessed increase in demand for cotton yarn. In the Tiruppur market, 30 count combed cotton yarn



was traded at Rs. 280-285 per kg, 34 count combed at Rs.292-297 per kg, and 40 count combed at Rs.308-312 per kg.

• The Bangladesh Textile Mills Association (BTMA) had temporary halt on cotton yarn import for use by the readymade garment (RMG) industry to retain forex reserves and to boost value addition.
