

Domestic Fundamentals:

Market Outlook:

The cotton physical market showed bearish trend across India today. MCX cotton spot price traded down at Rs. 58,260 per candy on Monday. ICE cotton futures closed green on Friday.

News


- The cotton prices continue to fall in the domestic market. At Rajkot, cotton prices were trading lower at Rs. 7650 per quintal against the previous week price of Rs. 8250 per quintal. Although, arrivals had increased to 1650 quintals per day.
- As per the market sources, in central India i.e. in Maharashtra about 40% of the crop has been damaged due to rains and hailstorm during the ongoing season. However, cotton prices continue to fall at Arvi market and were trading at Rs. 7650 per quintal against the previous week price of Rs. 7700 per quintal.
- Indian market sentiment remained bearish during the last week.
- Cotton sowing is progressing for the 2023-24 season in some parts of Punjab, Haryana, and Rajasthan. During the previous 2022-23 season, around 15.50 lakh hectares was under cotton cultivation in these three states.
- The Cotton Association of India in its latest estimate of the cotton crop for 2022-23 season has reduced its cotton production estimate by 4.65 lakh bales to 298.35 lakh bales from 303 lakh bales with reduction in Maharashtra, Telangana, and Tamil Nadu.

- The USDA's crop progress report for the week ending on May 14th indicates that 35% of winter cotton crops was planted which was 22% in previous week and 34% in previous year.
- According to USDA Cotton and Product outlook report, Global cotton production is up from the previous month to 116.5 million bales and attributed to higher production in China, Mexico, and Uzbekistan. Although, Consumption is lowered more than 500,000 bales to 109.6 million and attributed to lower use in Bangladesh.



• Global imports are forecast down more than 900,000 from the previous month to 37.9 million bales, mostly on lower demand from Bangladesh and China. Exports are lowered for Brazil and India, reflecting a persistently slow pace of shipments. Global ending stocks are forecast up nearly 700,000 bales to 92.7 million.

Cotton Yarn

- South India's cotton yarn market witnessed low demand during the week under review. While prices remain stable in Tiruppur and Mumbai.
- In Tiruppur, yarn prices traded at Rs. 270-275 per kg (excluding GST) for 30 count combed cotton yarn, Rs. 282-287 per kg for 34 count combed cotton yarn, Rs. 295-300 per kg for 40 count combed cotton yarn.
- Similarly, in Mumbai, cotton yarn prices have remained stable, the 40-41 counts yarn has experienced a downward trend with prices dropping by Rs. 10-12 per kg.
