As evident from the above Balance Sheet, overall supply during 2021-22 season to remain tight with stock to use ratio falls to 14.51% compared to past year amid lower cotton production in 2021-22 season and anticipated increased consumption by almost 2%. Given tight supply situation, overall cotton prices are expected to remain on stronger note.

Domestic Market Highlights:

Despite the removal of import duty on cotton till the new season, the cotton prices had slightly fluctuated during the last month however, remained on the higher note. Indian mills are not interested to buy cotton at higher rate but short supply has forced them to buy limited quantities daily. So, despite higher MCX, liquidity in the market is good. Indian textile ministry has clarified that there is no proposal to put ban on cotton or yarn export but rumors has given chance to speculators.

The Indian government on 13th April 2022 has removed the Agriculture Infrastructure and Development Cess (5 percent) and Basic Custom Duty (5 percent) on the imports of cotton. The government has allowed duty free imports of cotton until 30th September 2022 as prices in the local market has increased because of lower production in 2021-22 season. Further, duty free imports will help textile mills to import cotton from Australia, African countries and United States.

As per Agriwatch, due to higher domestic prices of Cotton, farmers are more inclined to take up cotton cultivation in upcoming Kharif 2022-23 season and if pre-monsoon showers remain good, (predicting 99 percent normal monsoon as suggested by Indian Metrological Department) then it is very likely that sowing may start early in coming Kharif. Overall, there are expectation of 12-15% increase in sown area from last year which may contain the soaring domestic prices.



Telangana government is targeting to increase the area under cotton by 55–65 percent to about 28–30 lakh hectares as compared to last year's 18 lakh hectares even as the cottonseed industry pegged the growth in cotton acreage at 15 per cent in the upcoming Kharif season. As per USDA report, the all-cotton planted area for India in the coming season 2022-23 is estimated at 12.2 million acres, higher 9 percent from last year.

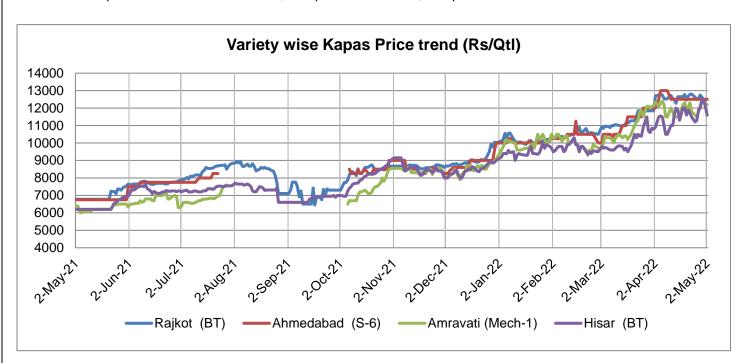
According to the Gujarat Trade Association, Gujarat Cotton production has decreased from 1.18 crore bales in 2017-18 to 90 lakh bales in 2020-21. In the 2021-22 cotton production is expected to fall to 80 lakh bales. The area under cotton cultivation has decreased from 26.42 lakh hectares in 2017-18 to 22.50 have lakh hectares in 2021-22 season.

Cotton sowing in Punjab has begun for the 2022-23 season. Cotton was sown on around 2,500 hectares in till mid April in Punjab. During 2021-22 season cotton was sown on over 3.03 lakh hectares in Punjab. Agriwatch expects area under cotton cultivation to increase in Punjab by around 2-3 percent in the 2022-23.

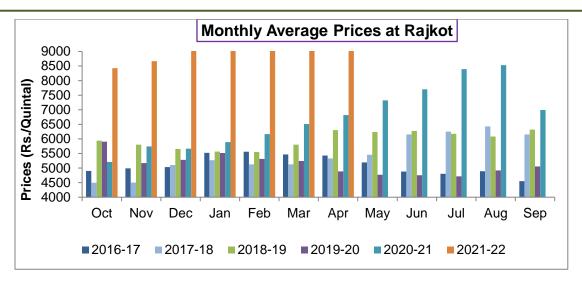
Kapas (Raw Cotton) Monthly Price Scenario

Monthly Price Review: Monthly kapas average price at Rajkot and other markets were significantly higher and stood at Rs.12,592/quintal in Rajkot as compared to previous month price of Rs. 11,307/quintal and Rs. 11,505/quintal in Hisar as compared to previous month price of Rs. 10,088/quintal. Prices have improved in Amravati and Ahmedabad market in the April month and were at Rs. 11,946/quintal and Rs. 12,557/quintal.





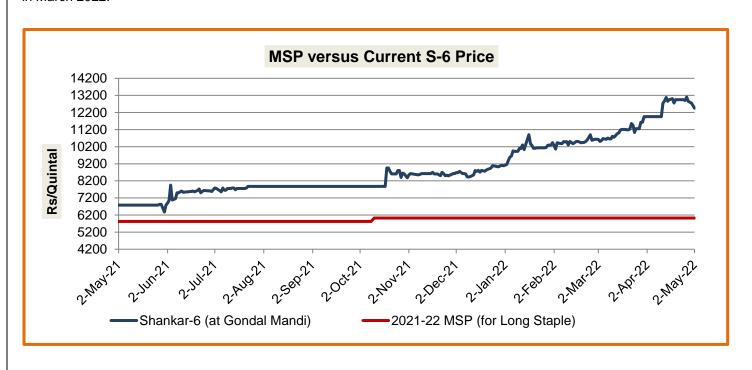
Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario

Spot Price versus MSP

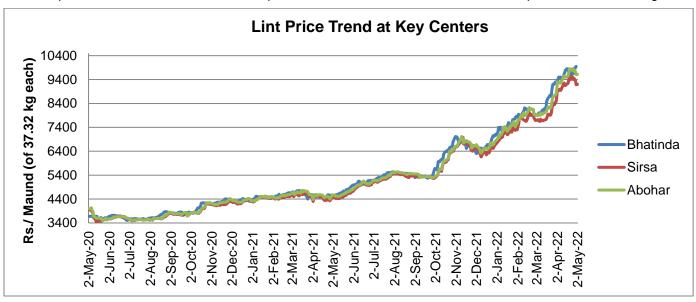
Average kapas price at Gondal market stood slightly higher at Rs. 12,714/qt in April 2022 as compared to Rs. 11,425/qt in March 2022.





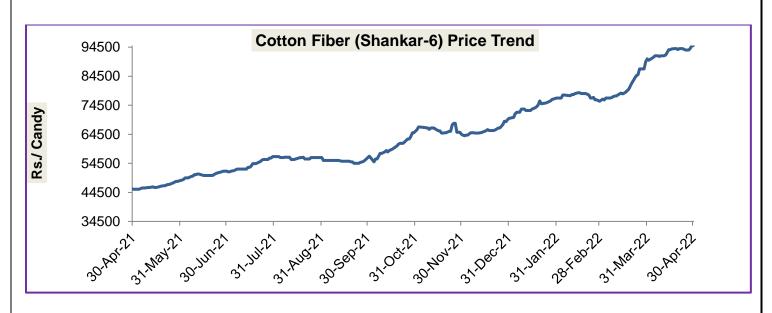
Lint price Outlook

Cotton Fiber price Outlook

The average spot price quoted for Shankar-6 (29mm) by CAI was Rs.92940 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the April month , higher than Rs.80679 per candy from previous month. While the prices during the same month last year were low around Rs. 45533 per candy. Agriwatch expects cotton fiber to remain around of Rs.94,500-95,800 per candy in the coming month.

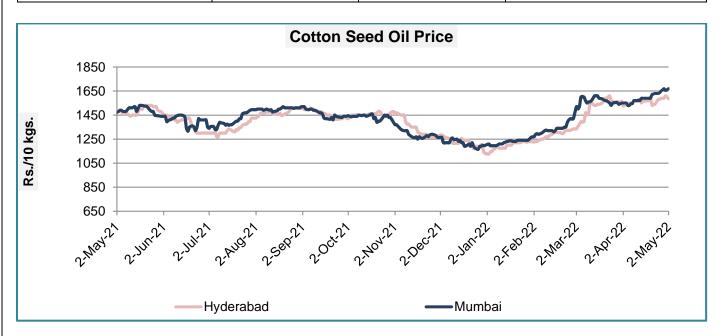




Cotton Seed Oil monthly Price Scenario

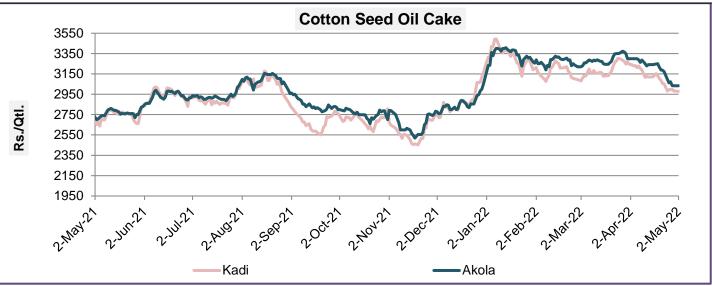
Cotton Seed Oil Cake monthly Price Scenario

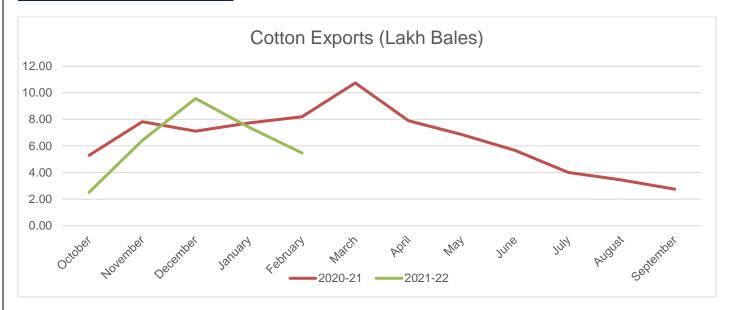

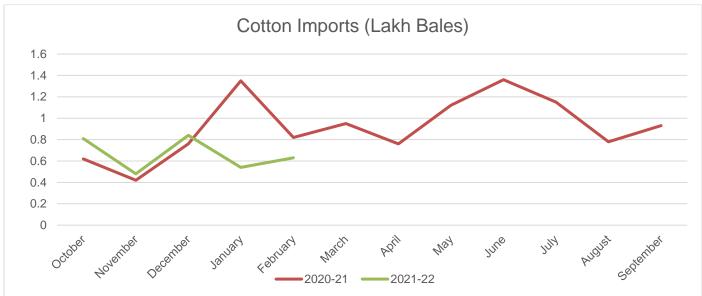

As the 2021-22 cotton season is coming towards its closure, the production and consumption both are on higher side. Global cotton production is higher by 8.4 percent from 24.39 million tonnes to 26.43 million tonnes in 2021-22 season. While the global cotton production is on the higher side, India(3.7%) and china(3.1%) cotton production is on its lower side as compared to the previous season mainly because of the lesser sown area. Further, Global cotton consumption has increased by 1.9 percent to 26.16 million tonnes as compared to the previous season. Global cotton trade was down from the previous season. The drop is mainly due to logistical complications and supply chain distruptions over the course of the 2021-22 season.

Major Market Highlights:

According to the China Cotton Association, as on 15th April 2022, new cotton crop sowing progress was 72 percent in Xinjiang, which is 23.8 percentage points higher than the same period last year. Currently Cotton Crop in Marabishi, Kashgar, Yarkant, and Turpan have been in seeding stage, and the planting progress was higher than the last year in the major cotton growing areas.

According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as on 01st May 2022, U.S cotton planting stands at 16 percent which is 1 percent higher as that of previous season of 15 percent. U.S. cotton planting was same as that of past 5 years average.

The All-Pakistan Textile Mills Association (APTMA), has asked the government to fix the cotton support price at Rs. 8,000 per maund to help farmers to increase cotton production for the coming 2022-23 season. As per the APTMA, Cotton support price was based on an international New York Future cotton price of Grade 3 of \$1.25/lb.

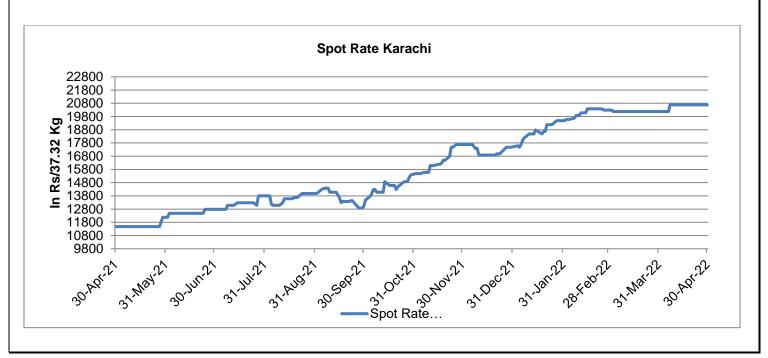

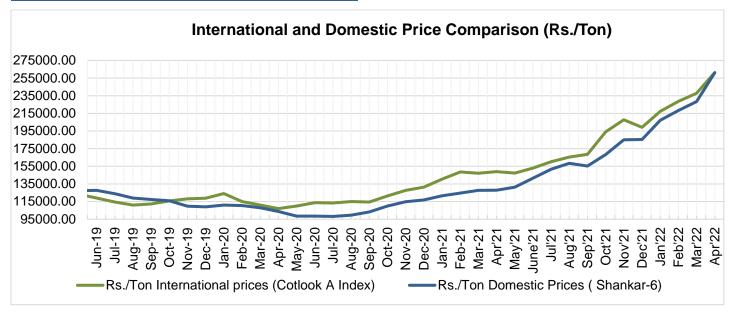
