As evident from the above Balance Sheet, overall supply during 2021-22 season to remain tight with stock to use ratio falls to 9.71% compared to past year amid lower cotton production in 2021-22 season and anticipated increased consumption by almost 2%. Given tight supply situation, overall cotton prices are expected to remain on stronger note.

Domestic Market Highlights:

Indian domestic market remained stable with slow supply against regular demand, through mills have reduced consumption. Weaker Indian rupee had made imports costly. Cotton fiber (Shanker-6) prices have touched a record high at Rs. 1,02,500 to Rs. 1,03,000 per candy in the last month.

Cotton Association of India (CAI) and International Cotton Association (ICA) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to increase co-operation and address quality issues in cotton in the coming 2022-23 season.

As per the Spinners Association of Gujarat, Yarn demand has declined due to the increase in prices. Spinning unit in Gujarat have reduced cotton procurement to 50 percent to 3.1 lakh bales per month instead of 6.2 lakh bales per month. The textile value chain in Gujarat has also reduced cotton production by nearly half as textile mills are facing the possibility of shutting down units as raw cotton and cotton yarn prices kept on rising despite the governments steps to remove import duty.

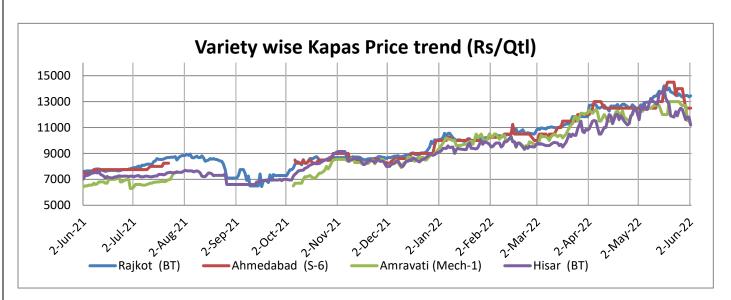
The Tamil Nadu government is planning to establish procurement centers like Cotton Corporation of India in the state, to procure cotton directly from farmers across the state.



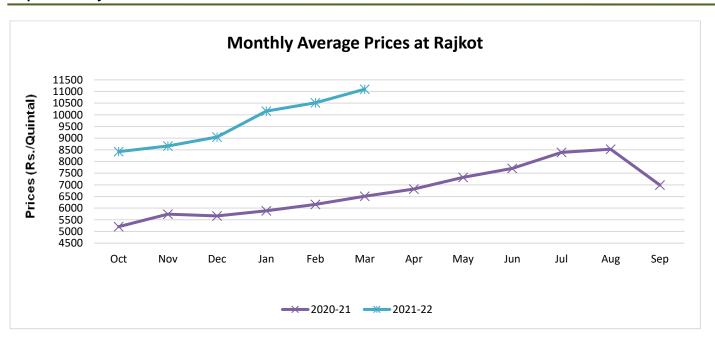

Kapas (Raw Cotton) Monthly Price Scenario

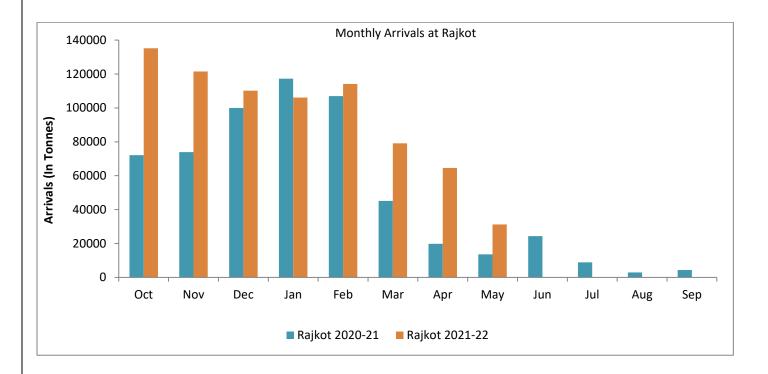
Monthly Price Review: Monthly kapas average price at Rajkot and other markets were significantly higher and stood at Rs.13,407/quintal in Rajkot as compared to previous month price of Rs. 12,592/quintal and Rs. 12,612/quintal in Hisar as compared to previous month price of Rs. 11,505/quintal. Prices have improved in Amravati and Ahmedabad market in the May month and were at Rs. 12,528/quintal and Rs. 13,250/quintal.



Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



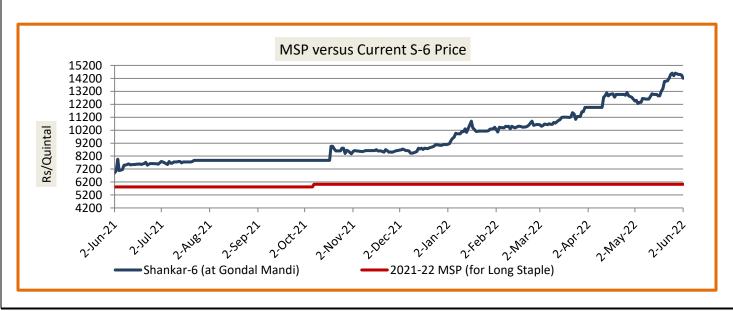




The arrivals in the month of April has declined in the market as the 2021-22 season is coming towards its end, whereas the prices continued a steady trend and the monthly average price was at Rs. 12,620/Qtl compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season. Spot Price versus MSP

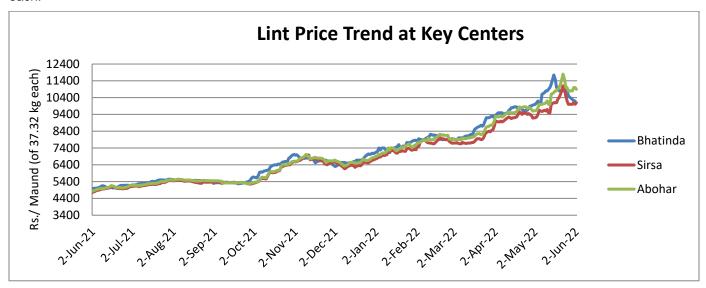
Average kapas price at Gondal market stood slightly higher at Rs. 13,674/qt in May 2022 as compared to Rs. 12,714/qt in April 2022.





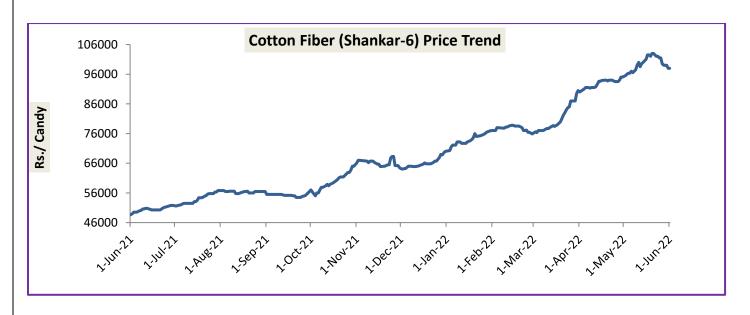
Lint price Outlook

Monthly average price of Lint at Sirsa stood higher compared to previous month at Rs.10036 per maund of 37.32 kg each in May whereas in Bhatinda market the prices have increased and were at Rs. 10692 per maund of 37.32 kg each.



Cotton Fiber price Outlook

The average spot price quoted for Shankar-6 (29mm) by CAI was Rs.99561 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the May month , higher than Rs.92940 per candy from previous month. While the prices during the same month last year were low around Rs. 46762 per candy. Agriwatch expects cotton fiber to remain around of Rs.94,500-95,800 per candy in the coming month.

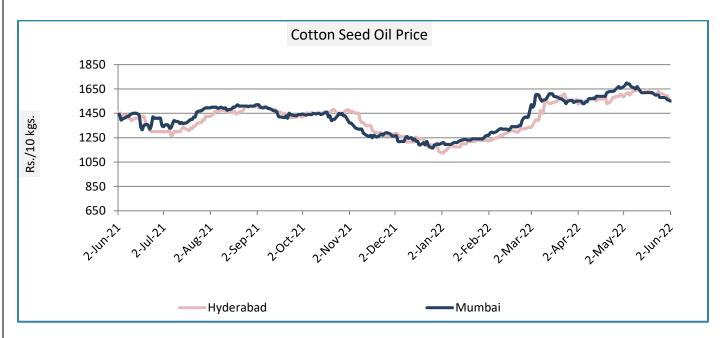




Cotton Seed Oil monthly Price Scenario

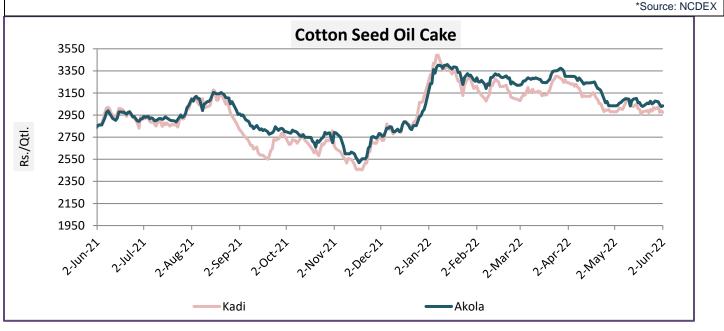


Cotton Seed Oil Cake monthly Price Scenario

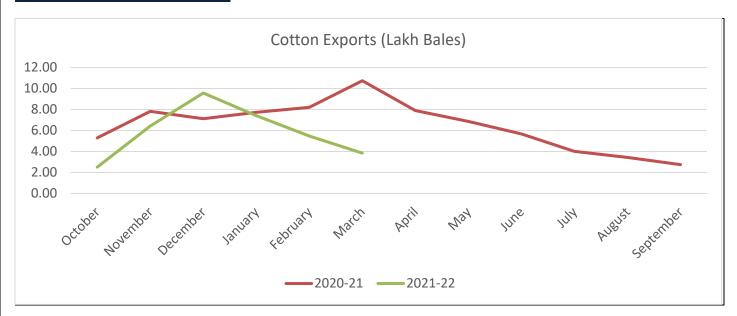

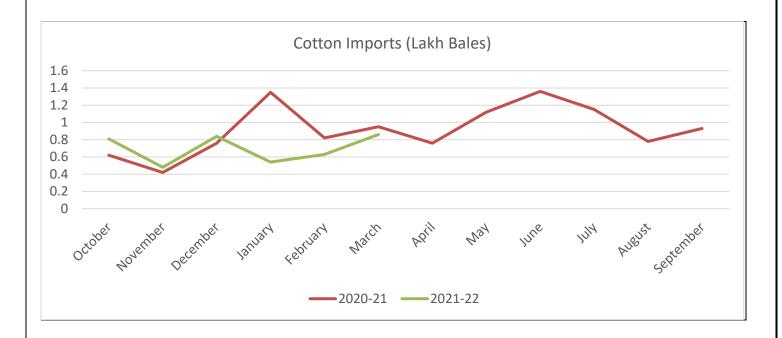

As the 2021-22 cotton season is coming towards its closure, the production and consumption both are on higher side. Global cotton production is higher by 8.4 percent from 24.39 million tonnes to 26.43 million tonnes in 2021-22 season. While the global cotton production is on the higher side, India(3.7%) and china(3.1%) cotton production is on its lower side as compared to the previous season mainly because of the lesser sown area. Further, Global cotton consumption has increased by 1.9 percent to 26.16 million tonnes as compared to the previous season. Global cotton trade was down from the previous season. The drop is mainly due to logistical complications and supply chain distruptions over the course of the 2021-22 season.

Major Market Highlights:

According to the USDA's WASDE May Report, the 2021-22 global cotton production was lowered by 1.8 million bales to 118.4 million bales. This was primarily a result of a 1.0 million bales reduction for India at 25.5 million bales and a 650,000 bales reduction for Uzbekistan at 2.8 million bales. World mill use in 2021-22 season, was lowered by 1.1 million bales to 122.9 million bales. The reduction in Consumption was primarily a result of lowered estimate for china to 500,000 bales to 38.5 million bales. The U.S. export forecast was unchanged, but the Chinese import number dropped to 400,000 bales at 8.8 million tonnes. Also, India's export forecast was lowered by 500,000 bales to 4.44 million bales.

According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as on 29th May 2022, U.S cotton planting stands at 68 percent which was 54 percent a week ago and around 64 percent in the previous year. The crop is 44 percent in good to excellent condition which was 43 percent a year ago.



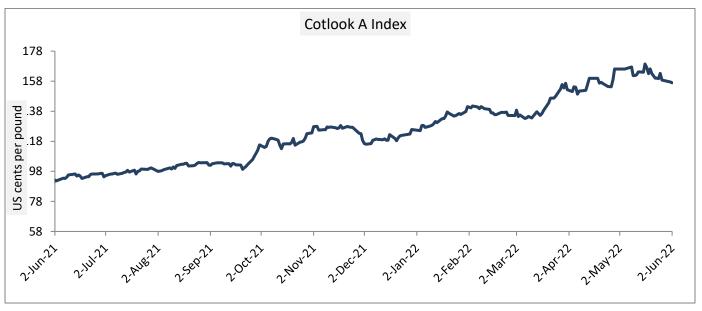
Pakistan cotton sowing has reached 90 percent in Punjab, over 3.6 million acres of area has been cultivated under cotton crop. As Pakistan agriculture department, cotton sowing is still underway due to good availability of water in the current season.

The United States department of agriculture (USDA) has forecasted that the area under cotton cultivation in Burkina Faso in the 2022-23 season (August to July) is expected to increase by 9 percent compared to the previous year 650,000 ha.

Cotlook A Index

The average CotlookA Index stood higher at 163 US cents per lb in May month and that has increased by 5 percent from previous month.

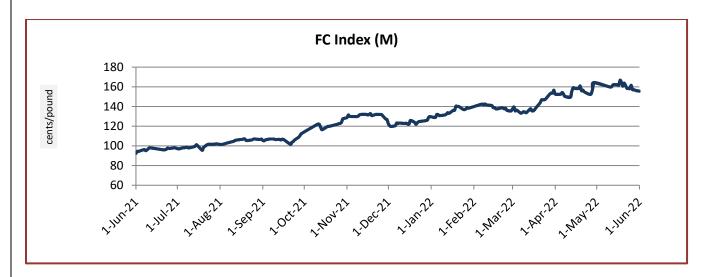
China Cotton Index and Foreign Cotton Index

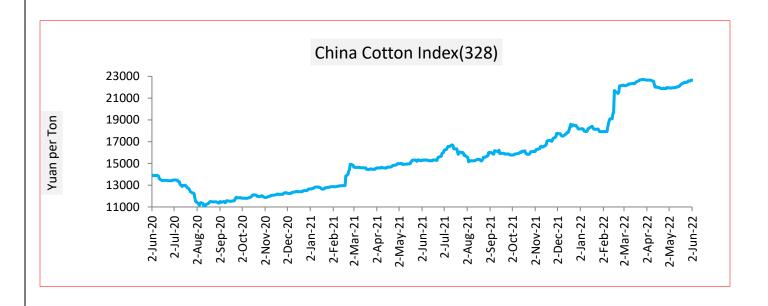

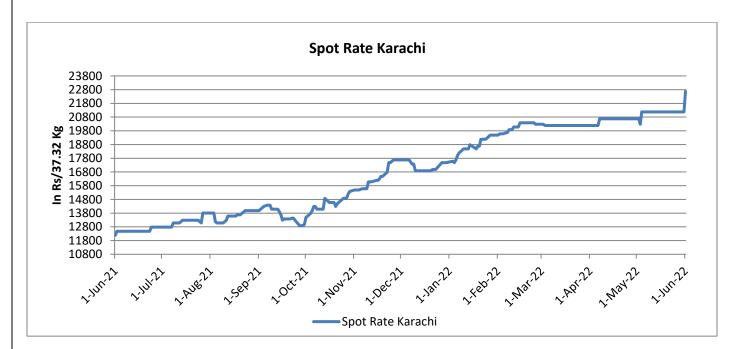

The Karachi spot price stood around Rs.21420/q slightly higher compared to the previous month.

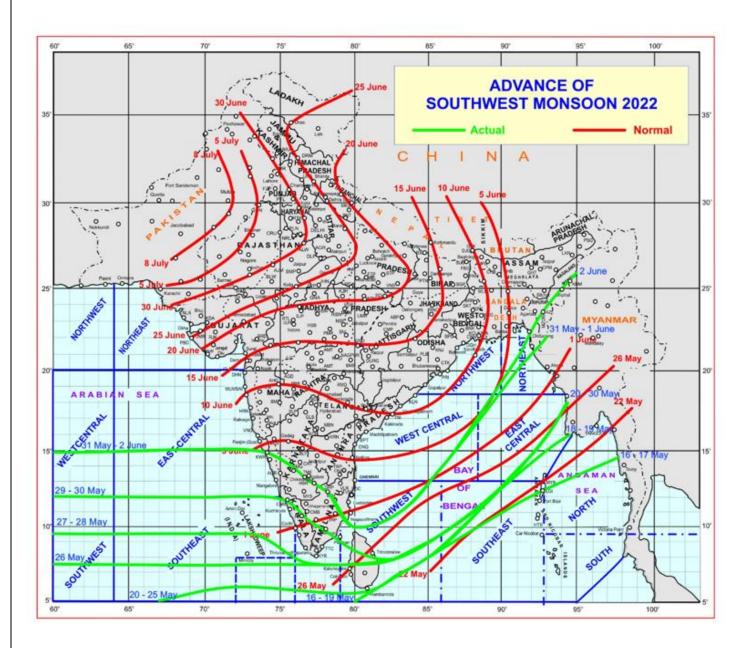

Weather Forecast



The conditions are favorable for the further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of central & North Bay of Bengal, remaining parts of northeastern states and some parts of sub- Himalayan West Bengal. India Meteorological Department has predicted the long-range forecast for the monsoon season, it indicates that from June to September 2022, the countrywide precipitation is likely to be 103 percent of the long period average (LPA) with a model error of 4 percent. The country may record seasonal precipitation up to 89.6 cm this year. Also, India is likely to receive more rainfall in this season.



Cotton Sowing 2022-23 season:

According to the market sources, area under cotton cultivation is expected to grow in 2022-23 season by 7-9 percent on year-on-year basis to 13.2 million hectares on account of a strong demand and sufficient availability of seeds. The farm ministry has estimated cotton acreages at 12.0 million hectares. Agriwatch expects cotton acreages to increase by 8-9 percent in the 2022-23 season. Cotton sowing is still progressing in Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan and is expected to continue till 15th June 2022.

Telangana government is targeting to increase the area under cotton by 55–65 percent to about 28–30 lakh hectares as compared to last year's 18 lakh hectares even as the cottonseed industry pegged the growth in cotton acreage at 15 per cent in the upcoming Kharif season.

According to Agriwatch, Cotton was sown in 20.69 lakh hectares in Telangana last year. For the coming 2022-23 season, we expect area to increase by 8-10 percent due to higher realization to farmers in the ongoing season. Cotton is been trading at Rs. 12,350 per quintal in 2021-22 season in Khammam from previous year's around 6,300 per quintal.

Cotton sowing is being progressing in northern states along with some parts of Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat. As per Agriwatch market sources, around 5 percent of the cotton sowing is done in Gujarat where water availability was there. Also, In Madhya Pradesh sowing is progressing in Khandwa region.

Cotton sowing is being progressing in Andhra Pradesh. Around 0.097 lakh hectares of area has been sown under sugarcane as of 01st June 2022 which was 0.06 lakh hectares as on the corresponding date last year.

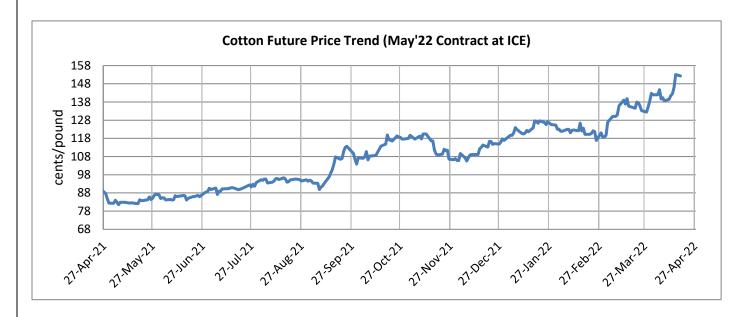

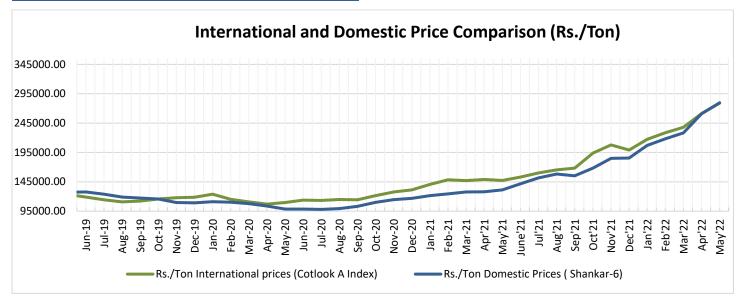
