

#### **Domestic Market Scenario**

#### Major Highlights (March 2023):

- Prices of Cotton bales were down on rising new crop arrivals amid better crop views.
- Fiber prices are likely to stabilize between Rs.60,000- Rs.62,000 per candy in view of good quality arrivals.
- Cotton crop was affected due to heavy rainfalls during the previous month. In Nellore, around 129 villages have suffered from untimely rains. Damage to cotton was recorded at around 250 acres.
   However, over 85% of the cotton crop has been harvested. So, there is minimal damage in cotton.
- Punjab cotton sowing is likely to start from 15<sup>th</sup> April 2023. The Punjab government has decided to provide subsidy up to 33% on Bt cottonseed to cotton farmers. During the previous season about 2.47 lakh hectares of land was under cotton cultivation. For the coming season, the government has set a target of around 3 lakh hectares for cotton sowing.
- Also, the cotton production is expected to fall in Punjab, and Haryana. While in Rajasthan production is expected to improve in the 2022-23 season. Overall in north zone cotton production is expected to fall at 42.09 lakh bales against 48.37 lakh bales during the previous season.
- Cotton seed oilcake prices may rise in the coming month due to improved demand from the stockiest.
- The Cotton Association of India in its latest estimate of the cotton crop for 2022-23 season has reduced it by 8.50 lakh bales to 313 lakh bales from 321.50 lakh bales with reduction in Punjab, Haryana, Maharashtra, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, and Karnataka.

Cotton imports were maintained at 12 lakh bales and exports at 30 lakh bales. Domestic consumption was estimated at 300 lakh bales. Overall, the ending stock for the 2022-23 season was estimated at 26.89 lakh bales. As per Cotton Association of India, Cotton arrivals between October 2022 to February 2023 were estimated at 154.84 lakh bales.

AgriWatch has estimated cotton production at 334 lakh bales for the 2022-23 season. We expect that about 40-45% of the cotton stock is still with farmers which may get released in the coming months. Cotton arrivals are continuously rising from northern and central India.

As per the market sources, many Cotton associations are demanding that the government should remove 10% import duty on cotton as India's cotton production is lower this year though it is slightly higher than the previous season. If the import duty is not removed after June-July it will be difficult for Indian spinning mills to operate.

#### **Production Estimate**

As per USDA, India's Cotton crop is estimated at 32.66 million bales higher than 31.25 million bales in the 2021-22 season. The increase in production is due to the expectationan of increased in acreages and yield for the 2022-23 season.

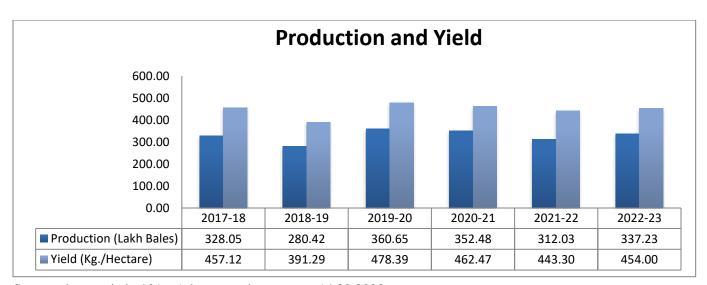
The government of India in its second advance estimate has estimated the Cotton production at 33.72 million bales against 31.20 million bales in the 2021-22 season.

AgriWatch has increased the Cotton production estimate to 33.41 million bales from previous season estimate of 31.50 million bales due to increased yield reported from major cotton producing states.

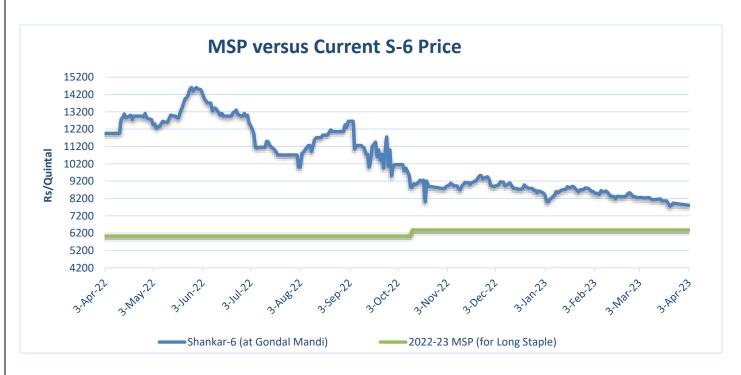


According to Min. of Agriculture's 2<sup>nd</sup> advance estimate, Cotton output in the country for the coming 2022-23 season is likely to increase by around 8% to 337.23 lakh bales from 312.03 lakh bales produced during 2021-22. The major reason behind the increase in production is the expected increase in acreage and yield during the 2022-23 season.

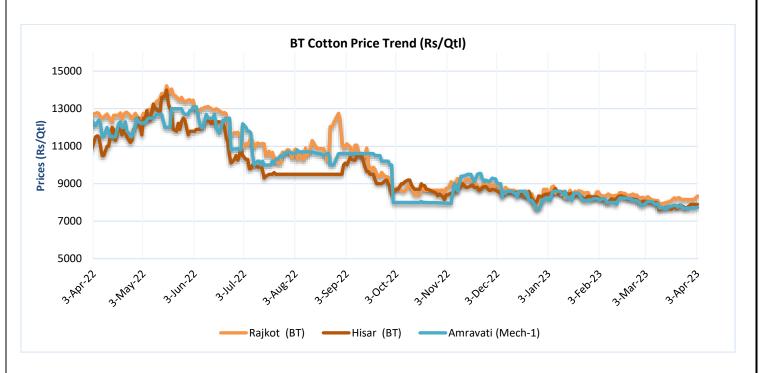

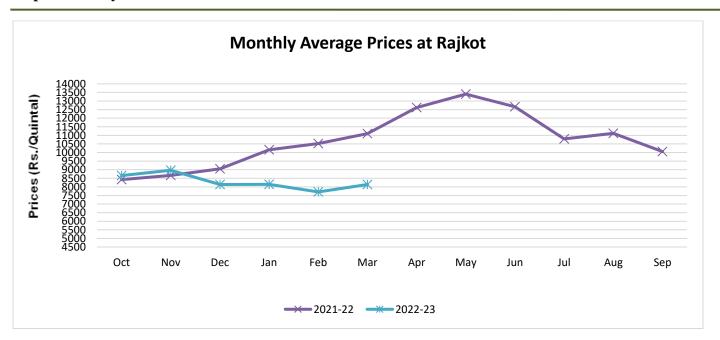
#### **Kapas (Raw Cotton) Monthly Price Scenario**

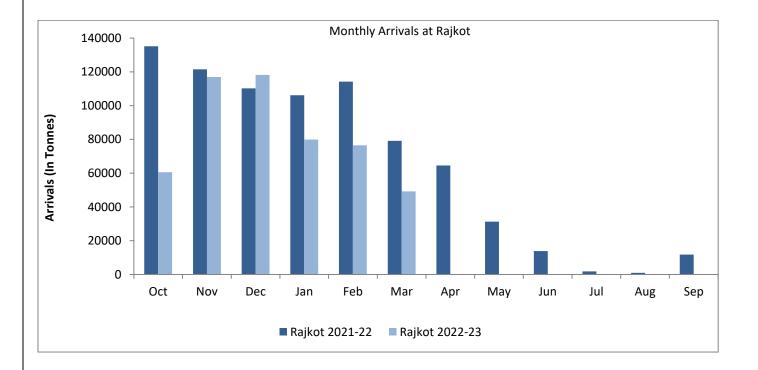




# Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario

#### **Lint price Outlook**

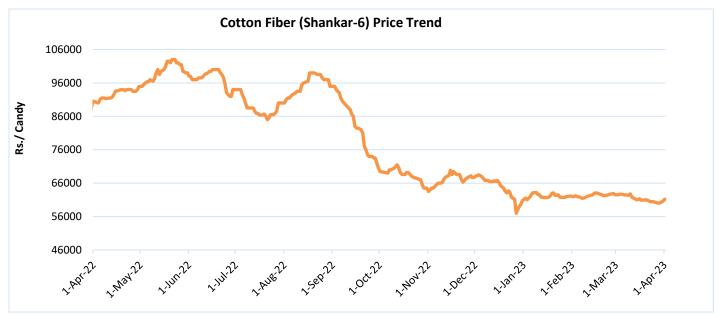
Monthly average price of Lint at Sirsa stood lower compared to previous month at Rs.6157 per maund of 37.32 kg each in March, in Bhatinda market the prices have decreased from Rs. 6392 per maund to Rs. 6252 per maund of 37.32 kg each. The cotton crop quality (staple length) has been affected in Punjab and Haryana due to unresistant weather condition during the past months.





## **Cotton Fiber Price Outlook**

The average spot price quoted for Shankar-6 (29mm) by CAI was Rs. 61,286 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the March month, lower than Rs. 62,321 per candy from previous month. Agriwatch expects cotton fiber to remain around of Rs.60,200-62,400 per candy in the coming month.

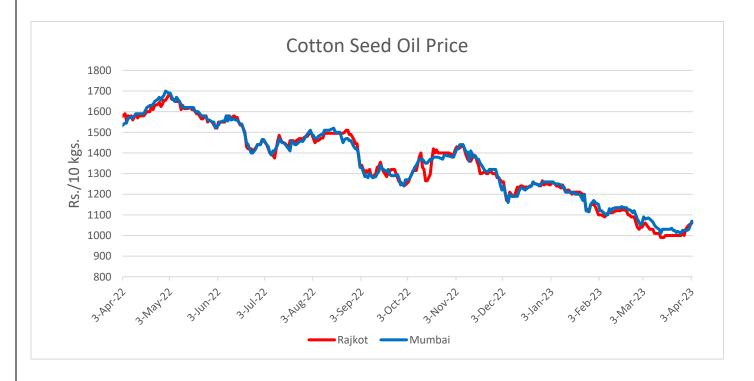




# **Cotton Seed Oil Monthly Price Scenario**

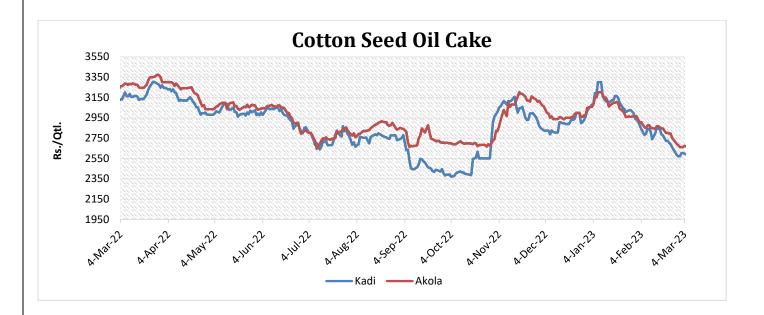


# **Cotton Seed Oil Cake Monthly Price Scenario**

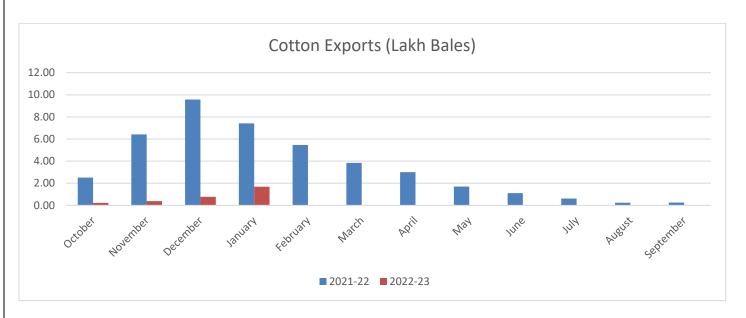

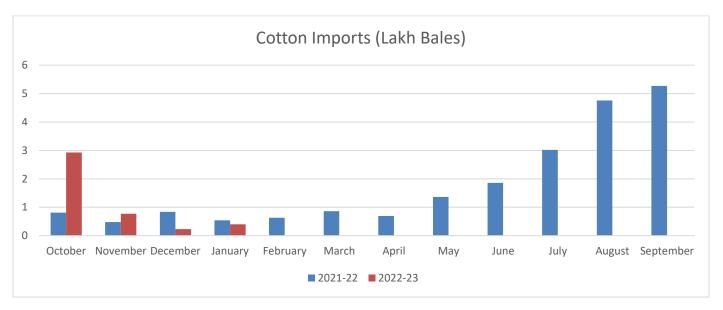
## **Cotton Export and Import:**

Cotton exports are getting affected in India. However, Bangladesh, Vietnam, and China are the major buyers of Indian Cotton. Further, exports may gain momentum as local prices had fallen and global prices had move higher. Export of raw cotton can be done minimally due to limited demand from the international market.

The 2022-23 cotton has started with 54% lower beginning stocks compare to last year. The cotton production during the 2022-23 season is estimated slightly higher at 334.16 lakh bales. Overall supply is estimated aat 382.58 lakh bales against the total demand of 365 lakh bales. Consequently, the stock to use ration is likely to remain lower than last year (last year itself the stock to use ratio was lower). Presently, supply is tight as farmers are holding stock.



#### **International Market Scenario**

#### **Major Market Highlights:**

According to USDA Prospective planting report, U.S. all cotton planted area for 2023 is estimated at 11.3 million acres, down 18 percent from last year. Upland area is estimated at 11.1 million acres, down 18 percent from 2022. American Pima area is estimated at 154,000 acres, down 16 percent from 2022.

The U.S. cotton export sales report for this week shows mixed results for the current and upcoming crop year. Net upland sales for 2022-2023 were 3,10,300 bales with 2,72,500 upland shipments and 16,900 net Pima sales with 7,100 Pima shipments, making the total sales 3,27,200. For the 2023-2024 crop year, net upland sales were 21,300 bales and net Pima sales were 400 bales, with a total of 21,700.

According to the National Food Security and Research, Pakistan cotton production is expected to fall to 4.78 million bales against the target of 9 million bales. The floods last year have affected the standing cotton crop. Lower cotton production has also hampered the textile industry. NFSR has proposed to fix the cotton intervention price at PKR 8,500/40kg to revive cotton production, bring about stability in the domestic cotton market.

According to USDA WASDE report, U.S. cotton supply and demand forecasts for the 2022-23 season are unchanged since last month. The global 2022-23 cotton supply and demand forecasts for march month include lower consumption and trade, and higher production and stocks. Beginning stocks are almost 900,000 bales higher. World cotton consumption in 2022-23 season is 555,000 bales lower this month with reductions in Turkey, Pakistan, Indonesia, and Bangladesh.

Projected exports are lower for Brazil, India, and Argentina, with world trade totaling 785,000 bales lower. Production is more than 700,000 bales higher as larger expected crops in China, Australia, and Uzbekistan more than offset reduced prospects for India. At 91.1 million bales, 2022/23 world-ending stocks are projected 2.1 million higher than a month earlier and 5.0 million higher than in 2021/22.

# **Future Price Trend (Active Contract):**





ICE front month futures was lower by 3% in Mar'23 contract compared in Mar'22. The average of ICE Mar contract stood lower around 82.78 cents/lbs in Mar'23, down by 38.99% points compared to the average price that stood in Mar'22 around 135.69 cents/lbs.

#### **Cotton Yarn**

North India's cotton yarn market witnessed limited trade. Prices were slightly lower than last month, but there was an improvement in cotton yarn exports. Mills can increase production if they do not face a disparity due to the costly natural fibre. Prices of recycled yarn in Panipat remained steady amid thin trade.

As per the Trade sources spinning mills received export orders from Bangladesh, Turkey, Egypt and Latin America. In Delhi, 30 count combed cotton yarn was traded at Rs. 260-265 per kg for exports. Export deals were carried out at around \$3.05 per kg (FOB). 30 count combed yarn was traded at Rs.280-285 per kg (GST extra), 40 count combed at Rs.305-310 per kg, 30 count carded at Rs. 255-260 per kg and 40 count carded at Rs.280-285 per kg,
