

Domestic Market Scenario

Major Highlights (Jun 2023):

- Cotton sowing is been progressing for the 2023-24 season in India. For Northern states of Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan sowing has been completed.
- Indian market sentiment has turned bearish during the last month and there was a downtrend in cotton as well as cotton seed prices.
- Indian cotton arrivals have reduced during the last month as monsoon has arrived in India. However, we have seen a peak arrivals between Mar-May in the 2022-23 season as farmers have started relasing the stocked cotton in the market.
- The daily arrival of cotton in India has declined to approximately 30,000 to 35,000 bales in June month.

Production Estimate:

 The Cotton Association of India in its latest estimate of the cotton crop for 2022-23 season has reduced its cotton production estimate by 4.65 lakh bales to 298.35 lakh bales from 303 lakh bales with reduction in Telangana and Tamil Nadu.

 Cotton imports were maintained at 15 lakh bales whereas exports reduced to 20 lakh bales from previous 25 lakh bales. Domestic consumption was estimated at 311 lakh bales. Overall, the ending stock for the 2022-23 season was estimated at 14.24 lakh bales.



• Agriwatch has estimated cotton production at 330 lakh bales for the 2022-23 season. We expect that about 30-35% of the cotton stock is still with farmers which may get released in the coming months.

Production Estimate

As per USDA, India's Cotton crop is estimated at 32.66 million bales higher than 31.25 million bales in the 2021-22 season. The increase in production is due to the increased acreages and yield for the 2022-23 season.

The government of India in its Third advance estimate has estimated the Cotton production at 34.34 million bales against 31.20 million bales in the 2021-22 season.

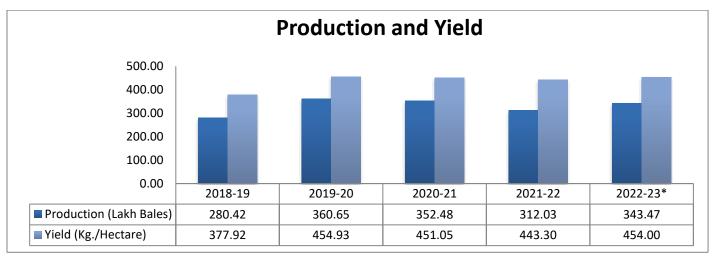
AgriWatch has maintined its Cotton production estimate to 33.00 million bales from previous season estimate of 31.50 million bales due to increased yield reported from major cotton producing states.

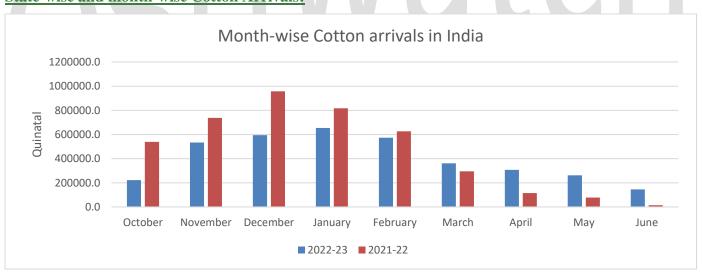
Domestic Production & Yield

According to Min. of Agriculture's 3rd advance estimate, Cotton output in the country for the coming 2022-23 season is likely to increase by around 10% to 343.47 lakh bales from 312.03 lakh bales produced during 2021-22. The major reason behind the increase in production is the expected increase in acreage and yield during the 2022-23 season.

Sowing Update:

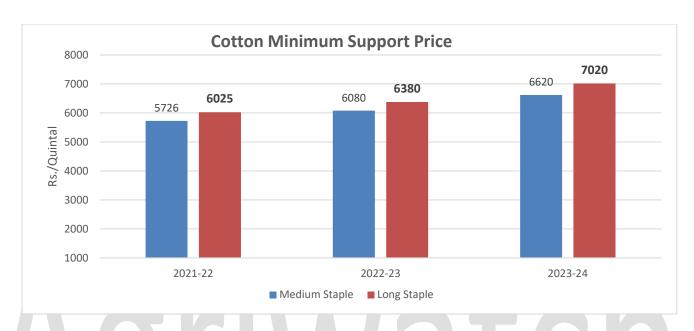
According to the recent release by Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Till 30th June 2023, farmers have covered 40.49 lakh ha. area under cotton crop, significantly down by -13.91% from 47.03 lakh ha. same time last year. Agriwatch expects cotton sowing to progress with the progress of monsoon in the coming month.

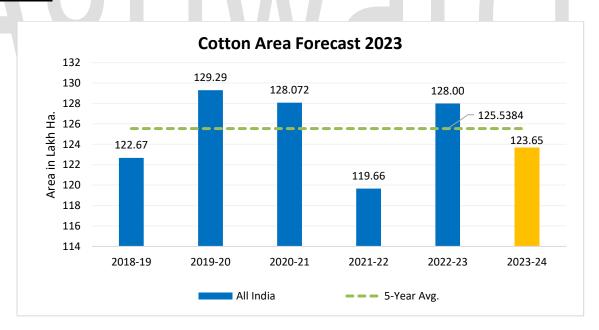
All India avg. return on cotton has comparatively decreased during the 2022-23 season by around 72% compared to previous 102%. We expect cotton acerages to come down during the 2023-24 season. Farmers are likely to shift to other profitable crops like rice, maize, red chillis etc. Although, CACP has recommended to increase the minimum support price for major kharif crops for the 2023-24 season.



Despite the decent increase in MSP cotton acreage is not likely to incraese in India as prices for other profitable crops remain higher.

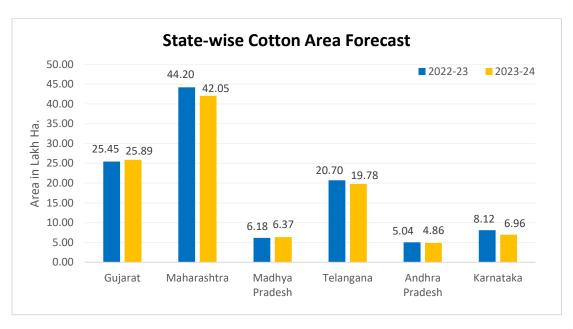


New Analaysis:



Cotton acreage for the 2023-24 season is expected to remain lower than the past 5-years average at 123.65 lakh hecatres against 125.53 lakh hecatres. During the previous season area under cotton crop was at 128.07 lakh hecatres.



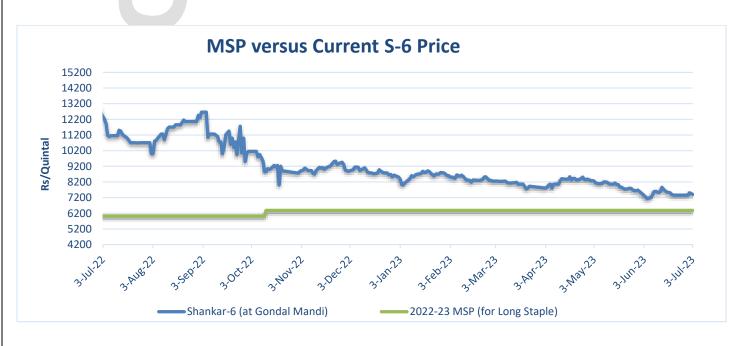


In the states of Mahrashtra, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Karntaka farmers are likely to shift towards Red chilli and Tur crop.

MSP V/s Shanker-6 Prices

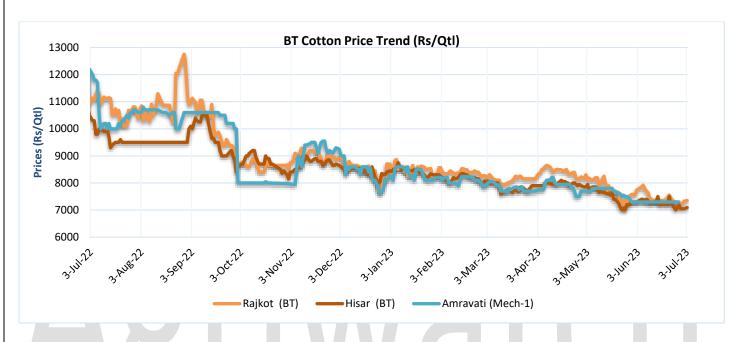

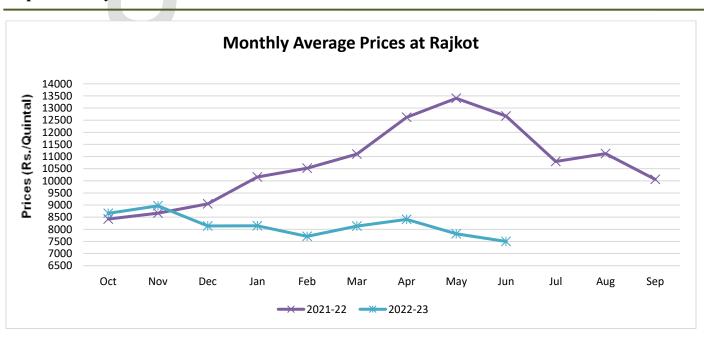


Kapas (Raw Cotton) Monthly Price Scenario

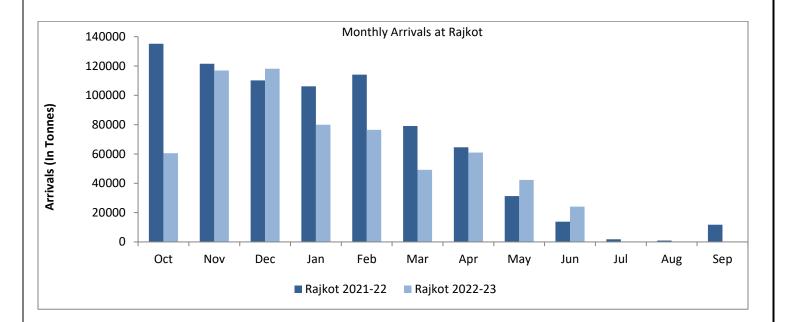
Monthly Price Review: Monthly kapas average price at Rajkot and other markets were significantly lower and stood at Rs.7,459/quintal in Rajkot as compared to previous month price of Rs. 7,807/quintal. Arrivals are almost over for the 2022-23 season.



Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



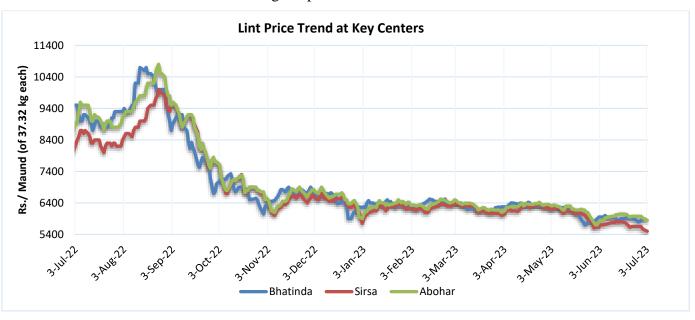




The arrivals in the month of Jun month have decreased in the market, and the monthly average price was at Rs. 7499/Qtl compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season. (Rs. 12,669/Qtl).

Lint price Outlook

Monthly average price of Lint at Sirsa stood lower compared to previous month at Rs.5674 per maund of 37.32 kg each in Jun, in Bhatinda market the prices have decreased from Rs. 5905 per maund to Rs. 6086 per maund of 37.32 kg each. The cotton crop quality (staple length) has been affected in Punjab and Haryana due to unresistant weather condition during the past months.





Cotton Fiber Price Outlook

The average spot price quoted for Shankar-6 (29mm) by CAI was Rs. 57,400 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the June month , lower than Rs. 59,362 per candy from previous month. Agriwatch expects cotton fiber to remain around of Rs.54,200-56,400 per candy in the coming month.

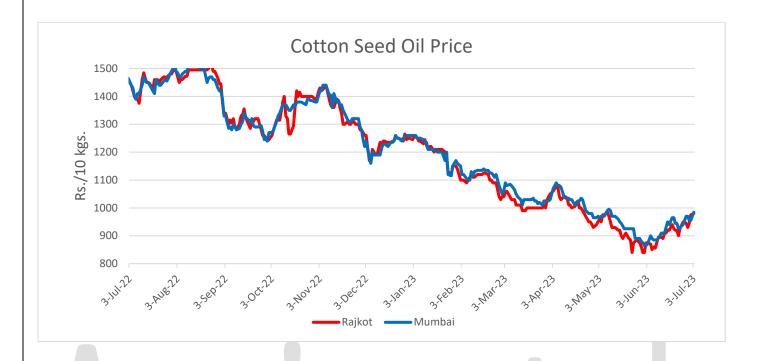


Cotton Seed Oil Monthly Price Scenario

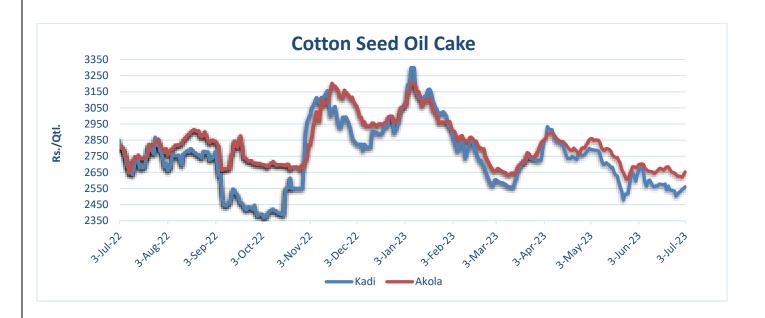
Cotton Seed Oil Cake Monthly Price Scenario

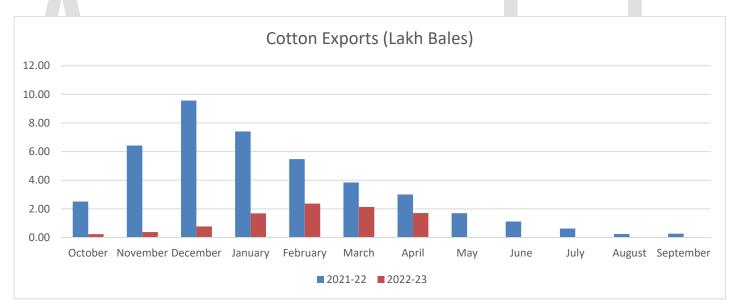

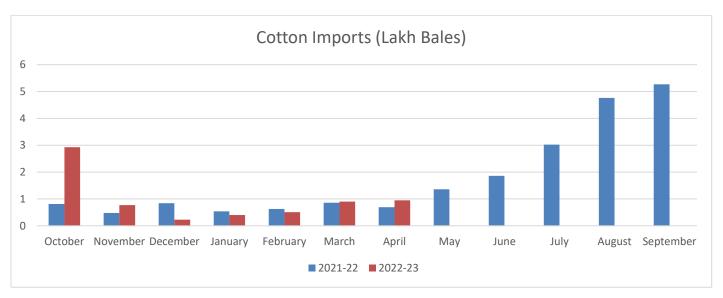


Cotton Export and Import Scenario:

The 2022-23 cotton has started with 53% lower beginning stocks compare to last year. The cotton production during the 2022-23 season is maintained at 330.14 lakh bales. Overall supply is estimated at 378.56 lakh bales against the total demand of 365 lakh bales. Consequently, the stock to use ration is likely to remain lower than last year (last year itself the stock to use ratio was lower).

International Market Scenario

Major Market Highlights:

USDA has estimated India's cotton exports to decline by 5,00,000 bales in May month to 1.8 million bales, roughly equal to its import forecast. Industry experts have projected export to be under 20 lakh bales during 2022-23 (October-September).

The USDA's crop progress report for the week ending on 04th June '23 indicates that 71% of the cotton crop was planted which was 60% in previous week and 82% in previous year. Cotton squaring stands at 6% which



was 10% previous season. Around 43% of the crop is in good condition as compared to previous week 41%, around 11% of the crop is in poor condition.

As per Cotlook Outlook, the global raw cotton production is forecasted lower by 69,000 tonne to 24,852,000 tonne during the 2022-23 season. Reduction for the African Franc Zone and the United States were partially offset by increase for China and Australia.

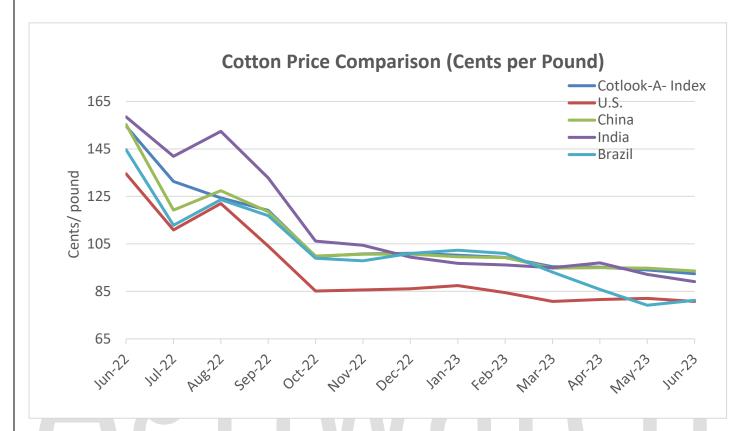

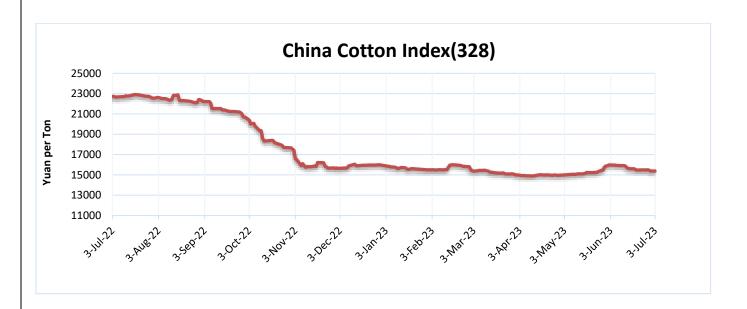

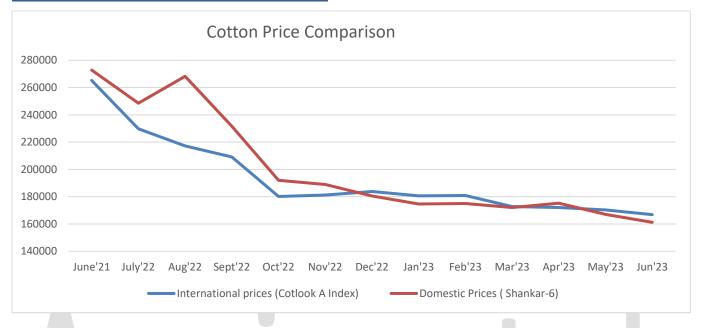

Both the International as well as the domestic prices traded lower during the past June month. The international cotton price traded lower at Rs. 1,66,846 per tonnes in Jun month compared to past month of Rs. 1,61,235 per tonnes. Poor demand both from domestic and international market has affected the prices adversely.

ICE front month futures was slightly lower by around 1.60% in Jul'23 contract compared in Jul'22. The average of ICE Jul contract stood at around 83.43 cents/lbs in Jul'23, down by 19.53% points compared to the average price that stood in Jul'22 around 103.68 cents/lbs.

Cotton Yarn

• Cotton yarn prices remained steady in north India during the month. In Delhi market, 30 count combed yarn was traded at Rs. 260-265 per kg, 40 count combed at Rs.285-290 per kg, 30 count carded at Rs.232-237 per kg and 40 count carded at Rs.262-267 per kg.



 Recycled yarn and raw materials like cotton comber and recycled polyester fiber remained stable amid poor demand.
