

Current Market Outlook

Cotton spot pricesnoticed weak movements during this week as compared to previous week. Average price of Kapas at Rajkot during the week was Rs. 4550 per quintal, which stood at Rs 4620 previous week.

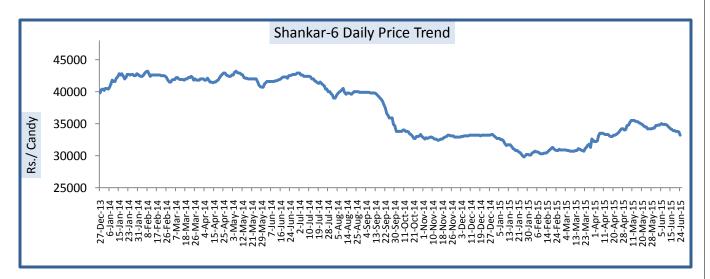
According to Investment Information and Credit Rating Agency of India (ICRA), cotton prices in year 2016 is likely to remain range bound despite the expectation of fall in production by 10-15%. ICRA in its report said that in the last four years (CY 2011-12 to 2014-15), the global cotton prices and trade were majorly driven by government policies in various producing and consuming countries, despite the increasing supply and negligible growth in demand.

Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has sold around 15 lakh bales of cotton so far from the stock of 87 lakh bales which it procured during the current season under the procurement operation, said Indian Cotton Federation (ICF).

Minimum Support Price (MSP) of cotton has been revised upwardly for the year 2015-16 by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CACP) by Rs 50 for each of Medium and Long staple. The MSP of Medium staple cotton has been revised to Rs 3800 per quintal for 2015-16 which was Rs. 3750 in 2014-15. Similarly, the MSP for Long staple has been revised to Rs. 4100 for the upcoming season 2015-16, which was Rs 4050 in the current season.

Central Institute for Cotton Research (CICR) has issued the district specific advisory for sowing cotton across the country, considering the difference in the status of monsoon in different states. CICR has suggested the immediate sowing in Maharashtra in the coming week particularly in Jalgaon, yavatmal, Nanded, Amravati, Buldana and Aurangabad districts as dry situation is expected in the period of July 03-16.

Around 19.66 lakh hectares of cotton has been sown so far throughout the country, as on 19 June this year, which is around 1.7% lower when compared to the sowing progress of last season during the corresponding period which was 20.00 lakh hectares, according to Ministry of Agriculture.

Balance Sheet Highlight (2014-15):

As per the latest revision in the cotton balance sheet by CAI, cotton availability would be on a lower side this season due to lower production, although imports would stand higher. Total consumption will be higher but lower export in the season would make the total demand to be weaker and hence ending stock will bulge up.

Cotton Crop Prospects for Season 2015-16:

Cotton production in India would be on lower side in 2015-16, said USDA. Cotton output in the country would be around 6.423 million ton in the coming season, slightly lower compared to the current season which is around 6.523 million tones.

Acreage of cotton in India would shrink in the coming season to 12 million hectares from 12.7 million hectares in the current season. Yield of cotton would be higher at 535 kg per hectare in the coming season as compared to 514 kg per hectare in the current season.

Cotton consumption in India is likely to surge up to 5.606 million tons in the coming season compared to 5.334 million tons in the current season.

Cotton exports in the coming season that is 2015-16 is likely to be around at 1.089 million tones (64.05 lakh bales approx.) around 28.6% lower when compared to 849 million tones (49.9 lakh bales approx.) in the current season.

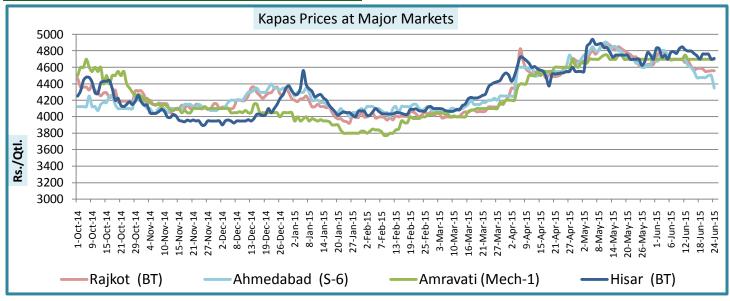

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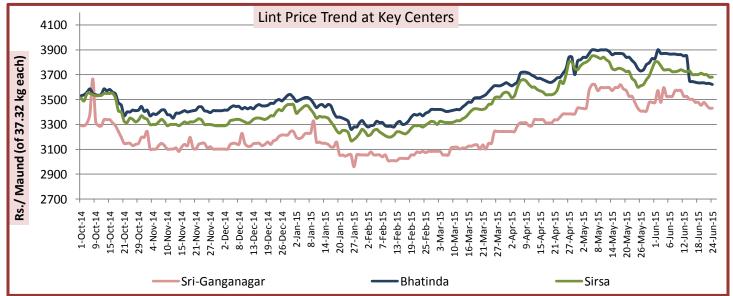

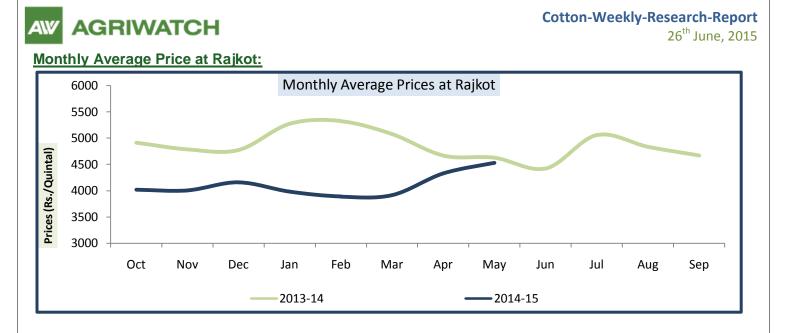

Price Trend of Kapas (Seed Cotton) at Key Centers:

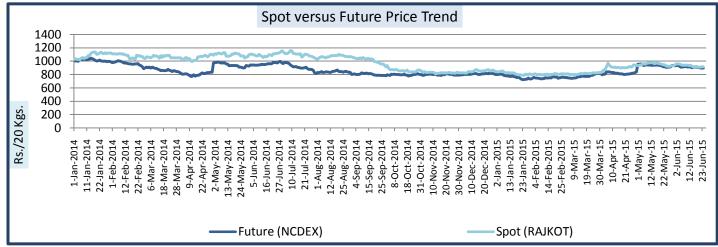


Price Trend of Lint at Various Centers:

International Market Scenario

International cotton prices remained dull during the week. Cotlook A index weekly average stood 71.75 cents/pound this week, which was 71.93 cents/pound during last week.

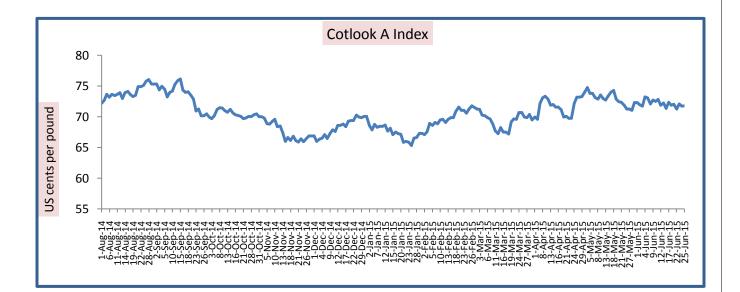
Around 94% of cotton planting has been completed in USA as on June 21 this year, which was 91% last week and 99% last year on same date, according to USDA. The five year average sowing progress is 100% as on date.

In the month of May, China imported 163,000 tons of cotton, around 14.8 percent lower as compared to the imports during the same month in 2014. China cotton imports has fallen drastically this year after the country announced that it would restrict low-tariff quotas to 894,000 tons, the amount agreed with World Trade Organization.

World cotton production estimates for the season 2015-16 has been upwardly revised by USDA. Cotton production on global front is likely to stand around 24.238 million tons in the coming season around 0.07% higher when compared to the estimates of previous month which was 24.222 million tons and around 6.34% lower when compared to the production of current month.

In its June estimates, USDA lowered the world cotton exports estimates for the season 2015-16 by around 0.42% to 7.36 million tons as compared to the estimates of previous month which was 7.329 million tons. The export during the season 2015-16 would be around 1.06% lower when compared to the export of current season and around 15.65% lower when compared to the season 2013-14.

USDA has revised the import estimates of China for the season the 2014-15 at 1.742 million tons in June which was estimated 1.676 million tons earlier in May this season. USDA expects the increase in China cotton imports as the country is carrying the strong demand for high grades of cotton which it will source from other countries.





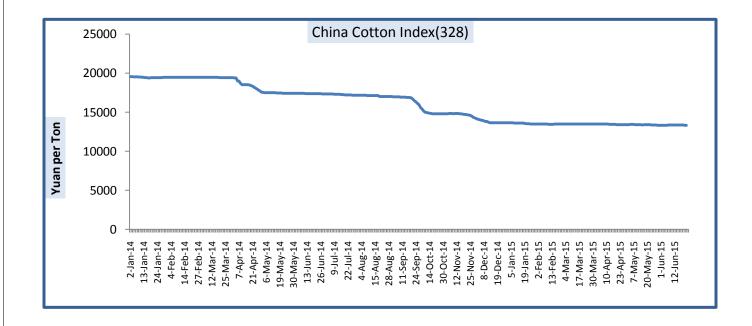

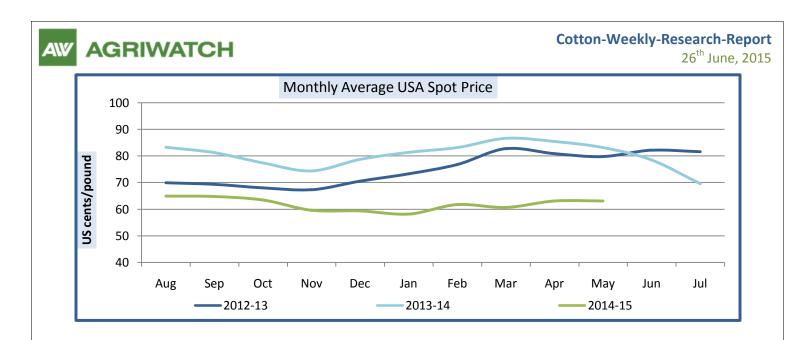
