

Current Market Outlook

Domestic Weekly Price Scenario: Cotton spot prices remained range bound during the week following the mixed sentiments in the market.

Average price of Kapas at Rajkot during the week was Rs. 4770 per quintal, which stood at Rs 4785 previous week. Average price of Lint at Sirsa during the week was Rs. 3520 per maund (of 37.32 Kg each), same as the previous week price of Rs 3520. Cotton fiber (Shankar-6) prices remained firm this week. Average price was Rs 33465 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week, which was Rs 33415 per candy previous week. Future price of cotton (at NCDEX, April'16 contract) closed higher this week at Rs. 797.5 per maund (of 20 kg each) which was Rs 782 a week earlier.

Cotton Price Outlook (For Coming Week): In the coming week we expect Kapas price to remain range bound with the price band of Rs. 4750-4820 per quintal in the bench mark market. Lint price at Sirsa is likely to be in range of Rs 3500-3570 per maund. Kapas prices at NCDEX (April'16 contract), is expected to hover in the range of Rs. 780-820 per maund (of 20 kg each).

Major Market Highlights: Cotton production in India during the next season that is 2016-17, could reach around 370-380 lakh bales, said the Chairman, Cotton Corporation of India (CCI). He believes that if the weather condition remains normal, the cotton production in the next season would be higher even if the area remains same as current season. The cause of lower production in the country is crop loss due to the unfavorable weather conditions. According to Cotton Advisory Board (CAB), cotton output is likely to be around 352 lakh bales in the current season.

Pakistan Cotton Ginners Association has raised its concern over the cotton imports from India. PGCA has urged the government to suspend the cotton and cotton yarn imports from India. Due to the crop loss, Pakistan fulfilled its demand from India and emerged as the one of the major buyer of Indian cotton.

According to the industry sources, Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has auctioned most of its stocks it procured under MSP operation in 2015-14 and currently it is holding 25000 bales (of 170 Kg each) of cotton.

Total cotton arrival till January 27 this season remained 144.07 lakh bales (of 170 Kg each), around 30% lower as compared to 206.76 lakh bales previous season during the same period, according to Cotton Corporation of India.

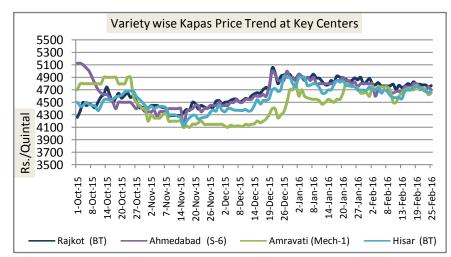


Domestic Cotton Prices Scenario

Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Kapas price remained firm during the week due to the strong domestic and overseas demand. Weekly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4785 per quintal, fairly lower as compared to previous week price of Rs. 4760 per quintal.

The Foreign Agriculture Services (FAS), division of USDA has lowered the production forecast for India in its latest report to 356 lakh bales. The reason for the downfall in the

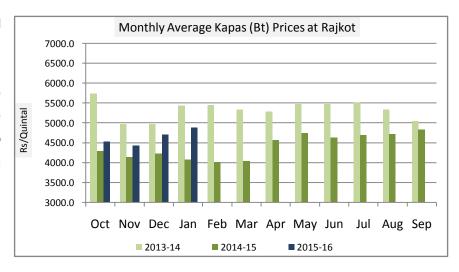


revision is lower yield expectation in Punjab and Haryana due to the attack of white fly and impact of pink bollworm in Gujarat.

Weekly Price Outlook: Kapas prices are expected to remain range-bound in coming days. The expected range for Kapas at Rajkot is Rs 4780-4820 per quintal for the coming week.

Kapas Monthly Y-o-Y Price Scenario

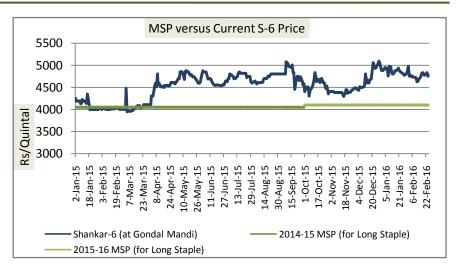
Kapas (seed cotton) prices in country noticed firm momentum during the January month following the strong overseas demand and diminishing arrivals, which has created the supply lag in the market. The cotton price remained strong during January compared to the previous month, and the same is ruling higher compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season.





Spot Price versus MSP

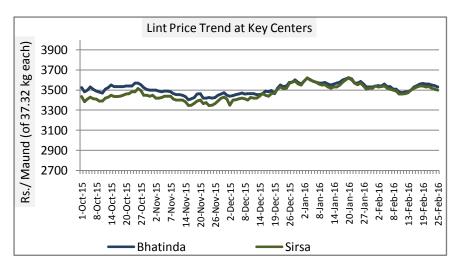
The Kapas prices are ruling above the MSP so far. The gap between the two prices has been widened this week due to the stronger prices. The average gap between the prices was Rs 691 this week compared to Rs 642 a week earlier. This indicates prices are in the uptrend movement.



Lint (De-Seeded Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

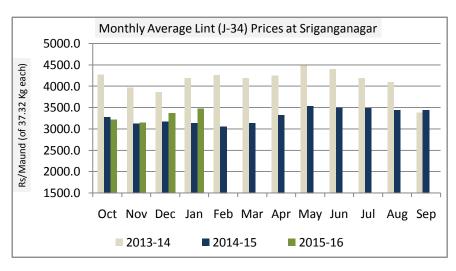
Weekly Price Review: As mixed sentiments are prevailing in market, lint prices remained steady during the week. Weekly average price of Lint at Sirsa remained Rs. 3520 per maund of 37.32 kg each same as the previous week price of Rs. 3520 per maund.

Weekly Price Outlook: Lint prices are expected to remain range bound during the week. We expect Lint at Sirsa to remain in range of Rs. 3500-3570 per maund.



Lint Monthly Y-o-Y Price Scenario

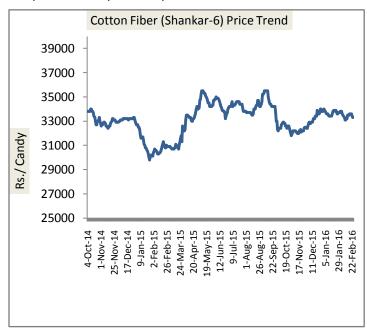
Following the firmness in Kapas prices, lint prices too remained strong during January compared to previous month and it remained firm compared to corresponding month last year also. In January this year, monthly average price of lint at Sri-Ganganagar remained Rs. 3475 per maund (of 37.32 Kg each), which was Rs 3375 last month and Rs 3128 during corresponding month previous year.

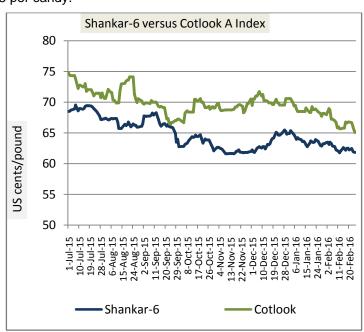




Cotton Fiber Weekly Price Scenario

Due to the firmness in Kapas prices following the strong demand and weaker supplies, cotton fiber too moved northwards this week. Weekly average price of cotton (Shankar-6) at Mumbai remained Rs 33415 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) compared to the prices of previous week which was Rs. 33335 per candy.



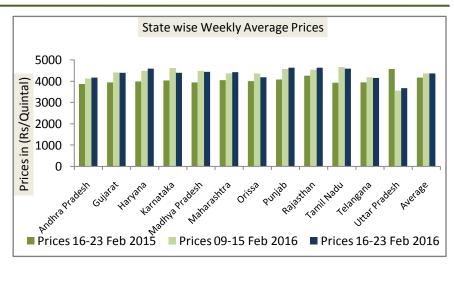


Indian Fiber price versus International Fiber Price: Indian fiber prices are ruling fairly below the international price. Against the weekly average Cotlook A Index of 66.14 cents/pound, Indian weekly average price stood 62.28 cents/pound, making Indian fiber competitive in international market.

Weekly Price Outlook: Shankar-6 price in the coming week is expected to hover in range of Rs 33300-33500 per candy.

State wise Weekly Price Scenario

On week on week basis, prices are by and large showing weak trend in most of the States, highest price was recorded in Pujab followed by Rajasthan this week and lowest was in Uttar Pradesh followed by Telangana. On year on year basis, cotton prices are reflecting uptrend in all of the States, except Uttar Pradesh. Prices have been summarized in the table given in annexure.

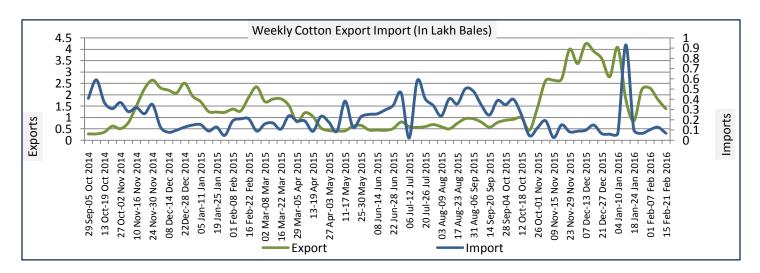




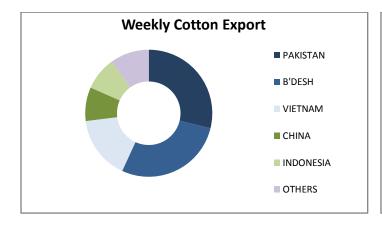
Cotton Weekly Export and Import

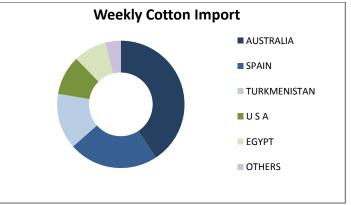
India exported 1.38 lakh bales of cotton last week (15 Feb-21 Feb 2016), which was 1.794 lakh bales previous to last week (08 Feb-14 Feb 2016), according to the data released by IBIS and compiled by Agriwatch. Imports on the other hand stood 0.070 lakh bales last week, which was 0.129 lakh bales previous to last week.

Major importer of Indian cotton during the week was Pakistan. According to the data released by IBIS, Pakistan imported 0.46 lakh bales of cotton from India in the past week (15 Feb-21 Feb 2016). Other major importers were Bangladesh, Vietnam, China and Indonesia and their imported volumes were 0.39 lakh bales, 0.22 lakh bales, 0.12 lakh bales and 0.12 lakh bales respectively. India imported cotton from Australia, Spain, Turkmenistan followed by USA and Egypt. The respective volumes these countries exported to India during the week are 0.029 lakh bales, 0.016 lakh bales, 0.010 lakh bales, 0.007 lakh bales, 0.006 Lakh Bales.





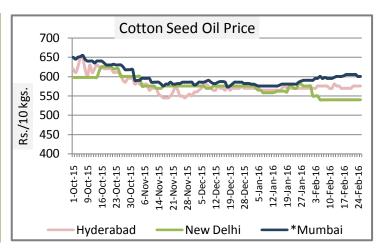

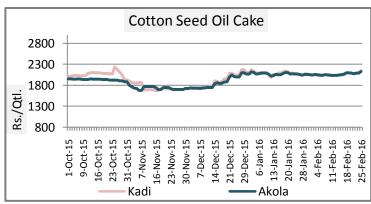

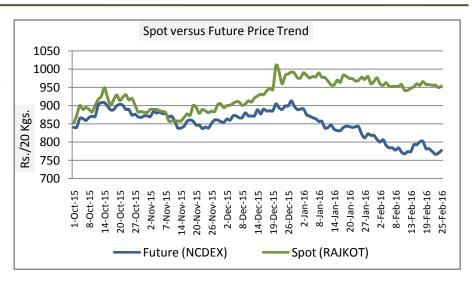

Cotton Spot and Future Price Trend

Cotton future price closed stronger this week. Kapas at NCDEX (April'16) closed at Rs 797.5 as on 25 Feb 2016, compared to 782 a week earlier and Rs 759.5 a year earlier. The gap between the spot and future prices has narrowed. Average gap between the spot and future price during the week was Rs.180 which was Rs 165 a week earlier.

International Market Scenario

International cotton prices remained range bound to weak during the week. Cotlook A index weekly average stood at 65.81 cents/pound this week, which was 66.14 cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights: Pakistan has lowered the cotton production target for the season 2016-17 to 141.01 lakh bales. The country has set the target of 154.9 lakh bales for the season 2015-16 a year earlier which has been revised thrice and now it expected to be around 96.87 lakh bales due to the severe crop loss of 34% due to pest attack. The lower production in the country may open channels for more exports from India, as Pakistan would import to fulfill its domestic demands.

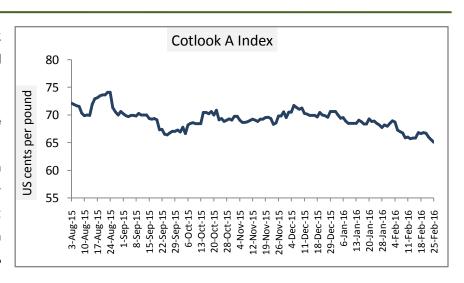
According to the latest estimates by International cotton Advisory Committee (ICAC), cotton production on the global front during the season 2016-17 would be around 23.08 million tons, around 2.8% higher compared to the estimates of 22.46 million tons in the current season.

According to USDA latest report, World cotton production would be around 22.07 million tons in 2015-16, around 0.2% lower compared to the estimates of previous month i.e. 22.11 million tons and around 15% lower than the production of previous year i.e. 25.94 million tons.

Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A index remained range bound to weak during the week following weak international demand, especially from the China.

Global cotton consumption is likely to be around 23.86 million tons in season 2015-16, which was estimated to be around 24.15 million tons a month earlier. In the earlier estimates by USDA, consumption was expected to rise but considering the current figures, cotton consumption would be standing around 0.6% lower compared to the previous season.

China Cotton Index and Foreign Cotton Index

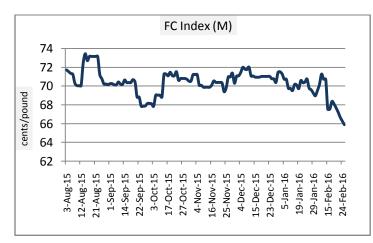
China is likely to import 1.08 million tons of cotton in 2015-16, around 9% lower compared to the estimates of 1.19 million tons previous month and around 39% lower compared to the imports during previous season which were 1.80 million tons, according to USDA.

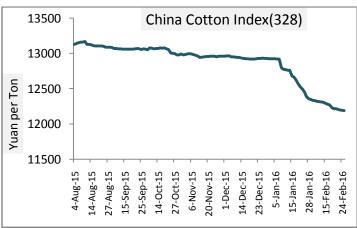
China cotton imports have moved to 9 years low, according to the calculation of Reuters. The country imported 188,200 tons of cotton in December, around 28.85 per cent lower compared to the volume in the corresponding month of previous year. However till December the total volume for the calendar year stood at 1.48 million tons, the lowest level in last nine years, according to Reuters.

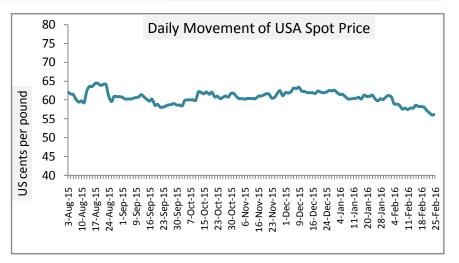

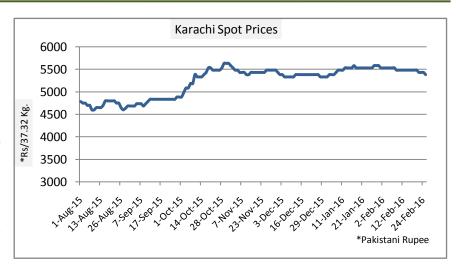

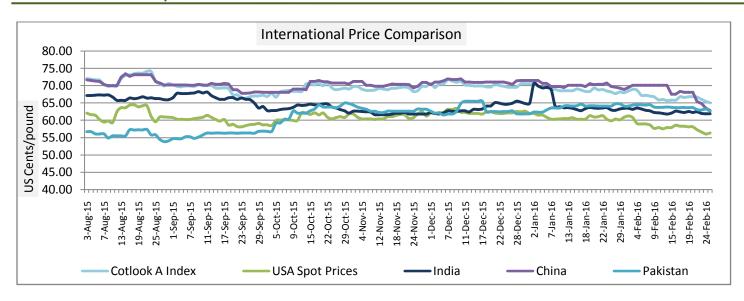
