COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT

18 June 2018



Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: Cotton spot markets mostly noticed firm during the week. Average price of Lint at Sirsa during the week was Rs. 4773 per maund (of 37.32 Kg each), compared to the previous week price of Rs 4633. Cotton fiber (Shankar-6) prices noticed firm tone this week Average price was Rs 46180 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week, which was Rs 44716 per candy previous week.

Weekly Price Outlook: In the coming week we expect Kapas price to remain range bound to firm with the price band of Rs 5500-6500per quintal in the Rajkot market. Lint price at Sirsa is likely to be in range of Rs 4000-5000 per maund.

Major Market Highlights:

With steady decline in arrivals of cotton amid strong domestic and export demand, cotton prices in the state have further firmed up to a six-year high. The price of Shankar-6 cotton variety jumped to Rs 48,500 per candy (a candy weighs about 356 kg) by end of the week, which was ruling at Rs 44,000 per candy last month.

With closing stocks of Cotton anticipated to be at a six-year low for the current season, ending September, prices of the fiber crop have started firming up as the new crop harvest entries are expected from mid-October onwards, which is as yet three-four months away. According to the Cotton Association of India (CAI), Cotton carry-over stock from the 2017-18 season is estimated to be 16 lakh bales (each of 170 kg), which is said to be the lowest since 2011-12.

Fear of infestation by the pink bollworm may hit sowing of the cotton crop in Gujarat. Another impediment that could come in the way is the acute scarcity of water. According to a trade official, even in Maharashtra and central Indian states like Rajasthan, the situation could be similar to Gujarat. Their major worry is the monsoon, which got delayed after its initial arrival, especially in Maharashtra.

India's cotton shortage is likely to be higher than earlier estimates. The reason for this is that export can reach level of 75 million bales, whereas earlier it was estimated to be 65 lakh only. There was an estimated 20 lakh bales of imports, which has now been reduced to 10 to 12 lakh bales. According to CAI.

Gujarat cotton prices of 29 mm remained between 45,050 to 47000/candy. A month ago the price of cotton was 43000 candy.

According to the Cotton Association of India (CAI), better prices for cash crops like soybean and paddy may distract the farmers from cotton sowing and in result, cotton sowing area is expected to decline by 10-12 percent to 10.7 million hectare this year in comparison of 12.2 million hectare last year as distressed farmers in Punjab, Maharashtra, Telangana and Andhra Pradesh have evinced weak interest in this cash crop.



The domestic cotton crop output is expected to moderate to 35 million bales in Cotton Year (CY) 2019 (refers to year ending September 2019) after a reasonably good CY2018, owing to a decline in domestic cotton acreage to 114 lakh hectares for CY2019 vis-à-vis 122 lakh hectares estimated for CY2018, according to ICRA.

According to Joint Director, Agriculture Department of Punjab, state registering a figure of 2.84 lakh hectares till May 28, the area under cotton cultivation in the state may barely touch 3 lakh hectares as compared to 3.83 lakh hectares last year and much below the agriculture department's target of 4 lakh hectares.

Balance Sheet Highlight (2017-18):

As per the latest estimates by CAI, cotton output in country during the season 2017-18 would be around 362 lakh bales (of 170 kg each) which is higher compared to production of last season.

Following higher production, cotton imports will rose marginally to 22 lakh bales compared to 27 lakh bales in previous season.

Due to lower opening stock, imports, and higher production of cotton availability would be standing higher this season at 414 lakh bales compared to 400 lakh bales during the previous season.

Total domestic consumption (Including mill, small mill and non-mill consumption) would be around 320 lakh bales compared to 307 lakh bales during the previous season.

Cotton exports are expected to remain higher as that of previous year. It is expected that country would export around 70 lakh bales of cotton in the season 2017-18.


Ending stocks are expected to be around 24 lakh bales, it is lower compared to the ending stocks of previous season.

Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario




Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot rose from Rs 6290/quintal this week.

According to latest report of USDA attaché, India's 2017/18 cotton production forecast is 30.00 million 480 lb. bales on higher acreage of 12.20 million hectares. Higher yields are expected through a combination of better crop, pest, and weed management practices and assuming a normal monsoon

Monthly Price Outlook: Kapas prices are expected to remain range-bound to firm in coming days. The expected range for Kapas at Rajkot is Rs 5500-6500 per quintal for the coming month.

Kapas Monthly Y-o-Y Price Scenario




Kapas(seed cotton) prices in country noticed firm tone during the May month when compared to the previous month, and the same is ruling higher compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season.

Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs.5445 per quintal during May, which was Rs. 5331 during previous month and Rs. 5191

per quintal during the corresponding month last year. We expect Kapas prices to remain range –bound to firm in the coming month. The expected price range for June month is likely to be Rs 5000-5700 per quintal.




Spot Price versus MSP

Lint price Outlook






Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake



International Market Scenario

International cotton prices remained firm during the week. Cotlook A index monthly average stood at 101.26cents/pound this month, which was 99.51 cents/pound during last month.

Major Market Highlights:

According to top industry sources, China has signed contracts for 5,00,000 bales of cotton from Indian traders for the new season. With the country also announcing an additional quota for 48 lakh bales, which it may begin procuring from July1, India stands to gain at least 10-15% of the given quantity.

China will import 1.4 million tonnes of cotton in 2018-19 crop year, its agriculture minister said on last week. China new crop is going to be about 10% lower. Expected crop is 4.50 million tons. Consumption is above 8.5 million tons.

The most active cotton contract on ICE Futures U.S., the third-month December contract, settled up 2.24 cent, or 2.47 percent, at 92.79 cents per lb.

Pakistan has missed cotton sowing targets, largely in Sindh, due to acute water shortage amid climate change. The situation may lead to low cotton production compared to the target of 14 million bales in the next season (2018-19) as well. Farmers have so far sown cotton seeds over 2.31 million hectares in the country that is around 22% short of the target of 2.95 million hectares as on June 1, according to government statistics.



According China Cotton Association survey, China cotton plantings are seen falling by 4% in 2018-19 to 2.8 million hectares as farmers respond lower prices of last year.

China is set to boost its imports of cotton by issuing additional import quotas to mills, said the China Cotton Association on last week, a move seen by the market as another step toward meeting the demands of top exporter the United States.

In 2017/18, world cotton production is estimated at 26.6 million tonnes while world mill use is projected at 25.5 million tonnes, which represents the third consecutive season of growth in demand for cotton.

As a result, world ending stocks are forecasted to decrease to 18.3 million tonnes representing the fourth consecutive season of diminishing global reserves.

The decline occurs within China where stocks at the end the 2017/18 season are projected down to 8 million tonnes. Stocks held outside of China are projected up to 10.3 million tonnes, a continuous increase over the past four consecutive seasons.

At International front there is expected fall in acreages in Pakistan this season. Further the crop development is also not satisfactory which is indicating y-o-y lower crop from Pakistan. In Uzbekistan another leading cotton producer has witnessed cool and drier conditions which has depressed the cotton production estimates. In US too persistent drought has resulted in market speculations of the y-o-y lower crop.

Thus early estimates of lower global production for the coming marketing year is expected to remain supportive for prices in coming months.


The China Cotton Association sought to calm market volatility on Monday, telling investors supplies were sufficient and revealing government plans to allow for more imports in the near future. The comments from the association, which lobbies the government on behalf of cotton farmers and processors, follow a rally that has driven domestic cotton futures up nearly 18 percent since early April.

China Cotton Index and Foreign Cotton Index


According to the National Bureau of Statistics, cotton production in China declined by 4.6 per cent in 2017 to 5.34 million tons compared to the previous year. Production has declined amid decline in acreage and yields. Acreage has declined by 11.1 per cent to 3.38 million hectares. Yields of cotton declined by 260,000 tons to 5.34 million tons. In 2017, China's cotton yarn import declined by 30 per cent y-o-y to 960 mkg worth US\$2430 million. According to report released by www.yarnsandfibers.com (YarnsandFibers), imports from India declined by 49 per cent to US\$560 million for 231 mkg. Price-wise, Pakistan was the cheapest supplier of cotton yarn for China, followed by India and then by Vietnam.




