

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 9th Dec 2019

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: The cotton market across India showed mixed trend as prices took correction in in Gujarat, Maharashtra and MP as CCI has started procurement in most of the center whereas in Punjab and Haryana, the arrivals tend to decline as the wheat sowing has started in these states with lower demand for Kapas from mills declined the prices Average price of Lint at Sirsa during the week was Rs.3904 per maund (of 37.32 Kg each), higher from the previous week price of Rs. 3893 due to the good quality of cotton. Average price for Shankar-6 (29mm) was Rs.38700 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week stood low , which was Rs. 38880 per candy previous week.

Weekly Price Outlook : In the coming week we expect Kapas price to remain steady with the price band of Rs. 5000-5350 per quintal in the Rajkot market. Lint price at Sirsa is likely to be in range of Rs. 3800-4100 per maund.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotton prices have remained steady to firm in domestic market. CCI has started procuring cotton from the farmers in large quantity only from Telangana whereas the farmers from Punjab and Haryana are dealing with lower prices due to lower demand from the mills.
- Indian cotton prices (69.43 cents/lbs) lower than Cotlook index (74.08 cents/lbs), thus Indian cotton still has the opportunity to book export contracts.
- Gujarat 29 mm Cotton sold between 38,500 to 39,000 Rs./Candy.
- All India Daily Arrivals remained steady in between 1,00,000 to 1,10,000 bales.
- Indian Rupee remained stronger between 71.19 and 71.67 during this week.

Market Highlights:

- According to the trade sources, total arrivals stood around 53.94 lakh bales so far till 7th Dec'19. And a total of 12.54 lakh bales have arrived in this week ending on 7th Dec'19 steady compared 10.53 lakh bales last week. Of this, 6.15 lakh bales were from Central India, followed by 4.23 lakh bales from South India in this week. The arrivals from North India (in Haryana, Punjab & Rajasthan) have started so the arrivals stood around 2.12 lakh bales this week.
- World Trade Organization (WTO) panel has determined that India's export subsidies are inconsistent with WTO requirements based on the complaint lodged by US. India has appealed against the decision. The panel decision against the Indian subsidy measures, in particular, the Merchandise Exports from India Scheme (MEIS). Government has announced two initiatives to incentivize producers and exporters in India so as to smoother the exports as the Indian cotton prices are higher than other in the competitive countries.

- As on 3rd Dec'19, CCI procured 7.50 lakh bales in total across India, buying the large quantity of 4.65 lakh bales from Telangana followed by 1.21 lakh bales from Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan. Around 74,000 bales were procured from Maharashtra, 37,000 bales from Gujarat and the minimum purchases of 9,500 bales were reported from Andhra Pradesh. According to the trade sources, around 45.5 lakh bales have been arrived in the Indian markets so far as on 3rd Dec'19.
- The CCI procurement commenced after a long wait in Dabwali, Haryana. CCI started buying from today because of which the prices stood higher at Rs.5450/q against Rs.5000/q before the procurement started because it was bought by the private traders. As in Punjab and Haryana, CCI is procuring for the first time this year, therefore, the procurement is sluggish in the North India.
- According to the latest data released by the textile industry, the Indian cotton yarn exports declined drastically by 33.3% till Oct'19 from the starting of the financial year in April'19. India exported 753 million kg in 2018 while only 502 million kg in 2019 during April to October. The top importers of cotton yarn (including raw cotton) were China (-53%), Bangladesh (-37.9%) and Egypt (-0.73%) so far in 2019 although the exports to these countries were lesser compared to the previous year (2018) because of imparity between domestic and international cotton prices. Decline in raw cotton exports from Bangladesh (-42%), Vietnam (-80.7%), China (-88.6%), and Taiwan (-63.2%) due to lower demand while the exports increased to Iran (837%), Oman and Nepal (22.9%).
- According to the trade sources, the Indian cotton exports for the Oct'19 were reported at 1.33 lakh bales against 71,403 bales in the previous month. In Oct'19, Bangladesh was the largest importer, importing 1.24 lakh Indian bales with an average FOB of 1.75 \$/Kg lower compared to 1.82 \$/kg previous month followed by Vietnam importing 2711 bales at 1.67 \$/Kg, Indonesia at an average of 1.58\$/kg for 2353 bales. China also has started importing cotton from India but in small quantities. India exported around 1316 bales at an average FOB of 1.67\$/kg in the new season in October'19.
- According to the latest estimates of released by CAB, the crop size estimate for the season 2019-20 is
 retained at 360 lakh bales against 330 lakh bales in 2018-19. As per CAB estimates, cotton sowing for the
 2019-20 year is about 1 per cent down at 125.84 lakh hectares. Also, CAB indicated that India's domestic
 cotton consumption may rise 4-5 per cent during 2019-20 as it expects the consumption of the fiber to remain
 at around 331 lakh bales for the year, against 316.5 lakh bales estimated for 2018-19.

As per the latest estimates by Agriwatch, cotton output in country during the season 2018-19 would be around 321.05 lakh bales (of 170 kg each) whereas 351.61 lakh bales is expected in 2019-20.

Following lower production, imports will rose marginally to 26 lakh bales and around 20 lakh bales is expected to import in the new season.

Due to lower opening stock but estimation of higher production of cotton would increase the availability the new season at 384.48 lakh bales.

Total domestic consumption (Including mill, small mill and non-mill consumption) in 2019-20 would be around 305.69 lakh bales compared to 311.5 lakh bales during the previous season due to lower demand from textile industries.

Cotton exports are expected to remain higher as that of previous year. It is expected that country would export around 52 lakh bales of cotton in the season 2019-20 due to slightly higher crop compared to 2018-19.


Ending stocks are expected to be around 26.77 lakh bales, it is higher compared to the ending stocks of previous season.

Domestic Cotton Prices Scenario


Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot stood firm at Rs 5097/quintal this week as the recently arrived cotton has lower moisture content compared to the kapas arrived in the month of Nov and the prices in the previous week which stood at Rs. 5044/q. Kapas prices would remain steady to firm in Gujarat in the coming week if the CCI buys in bulk quantity covering all the districts. The expected range for Kapas at Rajkot would be between Rs. 5000-5300 per quintal for the coming week whereas the prices in Bhiwani with new arrivals are hovering around Rs.5208/q stood steady compared to last week due to lower demand with lower arrivals.

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Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario




Kapas(seed cotton) prices in country noticed weak during the Nov when compared to the previous month, but the same is ruling lower compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower arrivals.

Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 5172 per quintal during Nov, which was Rs 5905/quintal during previous month and Rs.5802 per quintal during the corresponding month last year. We expect Kapas prices to remain steady to firm further in the coming month due to the new arrivals which is expected to be of good quality.


Spot Price versus MSP

The Kapas average price at Gondal market this week ended steady at Rs. 5123/q compared to the weekly average of Rs. 5130/q last week. Average prices moved down by around Rs.426/q this week from MSP (Rs.5550/q). The average gap between the prices likely to take correction after 2nd week of December'19.




Lint price Outlook

Lint prices stood firm during this week compared to previous week because of good quality kapas as per the demand. Weekly average price of Lint at Sirsa lower to Rs. 3904 per maund of 37.32 kg each, as compared to the previous week price of Rs. 3893 per maund. The arrivals have increased in all the states compared to the previous week in Bhatinda the major belt of Punjab arrived 47600 quintals this week followed by Abohar with 10200 quintals last week and around 18000 quintals in Bhiwani, Haryana.



Cotton Fiber price Outlook

Cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality noticed weaker compared to previous week due to the slow supply as the quality deteriorated by the rains as well as due to the lower demand. Average price was Rs. 38700 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week, which was Rs. 38880 per candy previous week. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady weaker in range of Rs 38000-41000 per candy in the coming week candy due to lower demand of lower quality cotton which is not upto the standards for exports.




Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake



Cotton Seed Oil Cake weeklyPrice Scenario

Cotton seed oil cake price declined significantly from previous week. Consumption has also increased due to the fall in the prices of the cake and due to the cheapness in Rajasthan, Punjab, Haryana. As the cotton prices are under pressure because of higher moisture content with the expectation of higher crop this year. Weekly average price in Akola was Rs. 2005.5 per quintal, higher compared to the weekly average price of Rs. 2152 per quintal in the previous week.

International Market Scenario

International US cotton spot prices stood weaker at 65.23 cents/lbs during the week. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood slightly steady at 74.27 cents/pound this week, which was 74.5 at cents/pound during last week.


Major Market Highlights:

- Cotton futures were up triple digits, DEC 19 Cotton closed at 64.06, up 55 points. The 12/05 Cotlook A Index was regained all 65 points back up to 74.15. The weekly AWP was reduced to 55.97 cents/lb. on Thursday, effective through December 12.
- The US Export Sales report from USDA showed 163,700 RB of 2019-20 upland cotton sold in the week ending 28th Nov'19 were down by 42% compared to previous week. With major buyers including Bangladesh (65,100RB), Vietnam (34,500RB), Pakistan (12,800RB), and Turkey (10,500 RB). Reductions were from Hong Kong (900RB). For 2020-21, net upland sales of 2,200 RB were primarily for Honduras (1,800RB). Net Upland Shipment for exports of 166,700 RB were down 10 percent from the previous week, but up 15 percent from the prior 4-week average.
- According to the data released by Pakistan Cotton Ginner's Association (PCGA), total of 7.44 million bales
 of cotton have been arrived on 1st Dec'19 in 2019-20 season. The arrivals were down by 20.49 per cent over
 arrival of 9.336 million bales during the corresponding period of last season. Total cotton arrivals decreased by
 24.06 per cent year-on-year to 4.141 million bales in the major state Punjab. While in Sindh province, cotton
 arrivals decreased 15.52 per cent to 3.306 million bales as on 1st Dec during the ongoing cotton season 2019-20.
 The textile mills in Pakistan consumed 5.974 million bales, while another 50,430 bales of cotton were sold to
 exporters.
- The USDA's weekly crop progress report showed cotton harvest crest above 83% complete in the week
 ending 1st December against only 74% in same period last year. Precipitation slowed harvest in some areas
 in Texas. The average pace of harvesting is 81%, with Texas has completed 74% harvest, Georgia has harvested
 89% of their crop followed by Kanas harvesting 71% of the crop and Missouri harvesting 95% of the crop.

Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A index noticed slightly weaker during the week. The Cotlook A Index was slightly up 74.27 cents/lb than previous week (74.5 cents/lb).



USA Spot Prices

November USDA estimates across the Texas High Plains, as yields continue to disappoint and quality falls short of expectations. The US Export Sales report from USDA showed 163,700 RB of 2019-20 upland cotton sold in the week ending 28th Nov'19 were down by 42% compared to previous week. ICE cotton managed to move higher, despite weakening US export data, on generally positive sentiment regarding US – China trade talks, very strong US economic data, an expectation for lower carryout in the Dec WASDE report and a modest weakening in US currency. The USDA in its earlier November forecast had estimated lower crop in US 2019-20 cotton production at 20.8 million bales instead of 21.7 million bales as estimated in October.

Pakistan Spot Prices

According to the market sources, Pakistan is expecting a shorter crop less than 8.5 million bales in the current year. The government must provide basic facilities to the cotton growers to get desired cotton production target in future. There were reports that many leading spinners have already booked substantial quantity of cotton for imports and yet they are active in local market because shipments would take longer time to arrive.

Untimely rains in some parts of country damaged the cotton crop, keeping ginners under pressure owing to huge losses. Total arrivals of Pakistan reached 68.57 lakh of cotton bales till November 18, 2019 lower compared to previous years' production of 86.76 lakh bales (-20.92%) on the corresponding period last year. Of total, 36.92 lakh bales arrived from the Punjab and 31.65 lakh bales from Sindh, according to the report released by the Pakistan Cotton Ginners Association (PCGA).






