

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 17th Feb 2020

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: All India daily cotton arrivals per day are reported with minimum 60,000 bales/ day in South India to 1,10,000 bales/day in Central India this week according to trade sources. Maximum arrivals are from Gujarat, MP and Maharashtra with around 6.6 lakh bales. CCI procured around 58 lakh bales so far which is around 27% of the total arrivals so far till 10th Feb'20. Average price of Lint at Sirsa during the week was Rs.4002 per maund (of 37.32 Kg each), higher from the previous week price of Rs. 4020 due to the good quality of cotton. Average price for Shankar-6 (29mm) was Rs.39460 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week stood low, which was Rs. 39317 per candy previous week.

Weekly Price Outlook: In the coming week we expect Kapas price to remain steady to weak with the price band of Rs. 5200-5500 per guintal in the Rajkot market. Lint price at Sirsa is likely to be in range of Rs. 3900-4100 per maund.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotton prices have showed mixed trend in the domestic market. As the export market has been affected and likely to decline further if the outbreak of virus is not controlled in the next 7-10 days.
- Indian cotton prices decreased slightly (70.73 cents/lbs) compared to previous week and still lower than Cotlook index (77.17 cents/lbs), thus Indian cotton still has the attractive price for exporting.
- Gujarat 29 mm Cotton sold between 39,100 to 39,300 Rs./Candy.
- All India Daily Arrivals remained steady in between 1,89,900 to 2,00,000 bales.
- Indian Rupee remained stronger between 71.28 and 71.48 during this week.

Market Highlights:

- Cotton prices likely to remain steady to low with sluggish demand in the domestic market as well as from the international market especially from China. The halt in exports to China has affected the domestic market also. At this point of time only CCI's procurement can support the prices in coming days.
- CCI's activity slightly remained sluggish in last 10-15 days due to the decline in arrivals across India. In Gujarat, Maharashtra and MP, final pickings have been started while the loss has been reported in the 3rd picking from Andhra Pradesh that overall resulted in the decline in domestic prices across India. CCI procured around 58 lakh bales so far which is around 27% of the total arrivals so far till 10th Feb'20. CCI made the maximum purchases from Telangana that procured 32.45 lakh bales (56% of the total CCI's procurement) followed by Maharashtra and Gujarat buying 10.8 lakh bales and 3.37 lakh bales respectively.



• Cotton output to rise in Telangana in 2019-20due to favourable weather conditions that led to higher acreage and yields. The cotton yield is likely to increase by 7-9% this year leading to the total rise in cotton production to around 40-43 lakh bales this year. Whereas the state has released its 2nd advance estimate recently this week projecting to increase in production around 48 lakh bales up by 13 lakh bales compared to the previous year's production.

As per the latest estimates by Agriwatch, cotton output in country during the season 2018-19 would be around 321.05 lakh bales (of 170 kg each) whereas 351.61 lakh bales is expected in 2019-20.

Following lower production, imports will rose marginally to 32 lakh bales and around 24 lakh bales is expected to import in the new season.

Due to lower opening stock but estimation of higher production of cotton would increase the availability the new season at 400.2 lakh bales.

Total domestic consumption (Including mill, small mill and non-mill consumption) in 2019-20 is likely to be around 305.96 lakh bales compared to 311.5 lakh bales during the previous season due to lower demand from textile industries.


Cotton exports are expected to remain slightly higher as that of previous year. It is expected that country would export around 45.7 lakh bales of cotton in the season 2019-20 due to slightly higher crop compared to 2018-19. Ending stocks are expected to be around 48.54 lakh bales, it is higher compared to the ending stocks of previous season.




Domestic Cotton Prices Scenario

Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot remained steady to low by only Rs.3 at Rs 5358/quintal this week compared to the previous week which stood at Rs. 5360/q. Kapas prices would remain steady to low in Gujarat in the coming week as far as the demand remains weak. The expected range for Kapas at Rajkot would be between Rs. 5400-5600 per quintal for the coming week. Whereas the arrivals of Desi cotton in Bhiwani finished since last week while BT continues to arrive in the market.



Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario






Kapas(seed cotton) prices in country noticed firm during the Jan when compared to the previous month, but the same is ruling slightly lower compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand with higher production this season.

Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs.5514 per quintal during Jan, which was Rs 5281/quintal during previous month and Rs.5568 per quintal during the corresponding month last year. We expect Kapas prices to remain steady to weak further in the coming month due to declining arrivals with decrease in demand.


Spot Price versus MSP

The Kapas average price at Gondal market this week ended slight higher at Rs. 5515/q compared to the weekly average of Rs. 5492/q last week. Average price in the week is slightly down by around Rs.35/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q). The average gap between the spot price and MSP has slightly improved, but due to weaker sentiments in the international market would affect the domestic price.




Lint price Outlook

Lint prices stood weak during this week compared to previous week because of weaker demand. Weekly average price of Lint at Sirsa stood down by Rs.18/q lower at Rs. 4002 per maund of 37.32 kg each, as compared to the previous week price of Rs. 4020 per maund. The arrivals compared to the previous week in Bhatinda the major belt of Punjab has declined by 6800 quintals to 34000 quintals this week followed by Abohar with 4930 quintals and around 5400 quintals in Bhiwani, Haryana.



Cotton Fiber price Outlook

Cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices slightly improved compared to previous week because of the hope in the improvement of corona virus in the globals prices on the back of lack of trade caused after the outbreak of corona virus in China. Average price was Rs. 39460 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week, which was Rs. 39317 per candy previous week. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady to weak in range of Rs 38000-42000 per candy in the coming week candy.






Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake


Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario

Cotton seed oil cake price remained steady to firm compared to the last week amid a rising demand from cattle feed makers mainly influenced cottonseed oil cake prices. With growing animal feed prices in the country, animal feed manufacturers have called on the state-run CCI to release cotton seed stock in the market. The releasing of cotton seed stock can ease the cotton oil prices as well as animal feed prices in the country, as animal feed manufacturers will get additional raw material for producing animal feed. The prices are lower compared to the previous year due to the shortage of crop in the previous year. Weekly average price in Akola was Rs. 1854 per quintal, lower compared to the weekly average price of Rs. 1853 per quintal in the previous week.

International Market Scenario

International US cotton spot prices stood firm at 69.10 cents/lbs during the week. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood slightly firm at 77.21 cents/pound this week, which was 75.88 at cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotton futures posted 23 to 34 point losses by Friday's close, Mar 20 Cotton closed at 67.41, down 34 points. The 02/13 Cotlook A index was 50 points higher to 77.70 cents/lb. The FAS Adjusted World Price for cotton is 58.82 cents/lb.
- Cotton production was reported unchanged at 20.1 million bales in Feb'20 forecast compared to the previous month by USDA. Domestic cotton ending supply was also steady, leaving U.S. ending stocks at 5.40 mln bales. USDA also remained the U.S. cotton exports at 16.50m bales, although the Feb revision increased Brazil's cotton export estimate to 8.90m bales while Indian cotton exports reduced to 3.6 mln bales from 3.8 mln bales. Australian export estimates were lowered 5 lakh bales to 1.3 million bales due to the drought



ravaged country. World ending stocks of cotton were increased by 2.53 mln bales to 82.12 mln bales. World demand for cotton was 1.21 million bales lower against the Jan forecast with World use at 119.01m bales. Australian and Indian exports were lowered. USDA's Cotton Ginning's Report showed that cotton ginned through 1st Feb'20 was 18.934 mln Running Bales, which is 14% more than 2018-19's pace.


- Cotton prices in China have fallen by 3-4% from 13,833 RMB/Ton to 13,437 RMB/Ton since 23rd Jan'20 to 7th Feb'20 while the Indian domestic prices also fallen (-1 to 2%) to Rs.39,500/ candy from Rs.40,000/candy due to the uncertainty after the outbreak of coronavirus in China. Prices are expected to remain volatile in the short-term before a clear picture emerges. Usually, India's 25% of its annual export of cotton and cotton yarn is to China. The halt in exports are the result in decline in domestic prices apart from exports to China, there is no increase in export demand from Vietnam and Bangladesh.
- The US Export Sales report from USDA showed 350,900 RB of 2019-20 upland cotton sold in the week ending 6th Feb'20 were up by 6% compared to previous week. Increases primarily for Vietnam (152,000 MT, including 2,600 RB switched from South Korea), Turkey (74,000 RB), Pakistan (49,300 RB), Bangladesh (44,200 RB), and Indonesia (20,500 RB, including 1,200 RB switched from Japan), were offset by reductions primarily for China (48,400 RB). For 2020/2021, net sales of 57,300 RB were for Bangladesh (26,200 RB), Pakistan (18,500 RB), Malaysia (6,600 RB), Indonesia (5,300 RB), and Ecuador (700 RB). Exports of 400,500 RB were down 4 percent from the previous week, but up 20 percent from the prior 4-week average.

Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A index noticed slightly firm after a fall in last week. The Cotlook A Index was down 77.21 cents/lb than previous week (75.88 cents/lb).





USA Spot Prices

The prices moved lower in US after thespread of Corona virus from China that disturbed the global trade between the two countries right after both signed a trade deal. It may be that the market sees a big shipment number of Chinese cotton previously bought. U.S. ginning records show some 18.9 million bales of cotton have been ginned to date, slightly ahead of the prior year's pace. However, ginning was very active in February and into March in 2019. Such is not the case this season. The US Export Sales report from USDA showed 350,900 RB of 2019-20 upland cotton sold in the week ending 6th Feb'20 were up by 6% compared to previous week. However, China did buy 92, 500 bales, but had cancellations of 140,800 bales.

Pakistan Spot Prices

The average cotton price remained steady to firm compared to the last week. The production in Pakistan stood at its lowest levels this year. The lower yield in the country this year has created a panic in the market and it is the main cause for increasing cotton imports. According to the data released by Pakistan Cotton Ginner's Association (PCGA), total of 8.33 million bales of cotton have been arrived on 15th Jan'20 in 2019-20 season. The arrivals were down by 20.26 per cent which were over 10.45 million bales during the corresponding period of last season.






