

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT
16th Mar 2020**Domestic market summary**

Domestic market Scenario: The domestic cotton prices have showed mixed trend in the major markets due to lack of demand from the buyers globally due to the outbreak of coronavirus in China. Maximum arrivals are from Gujarat, MP and Maharashtra with around 4 lakh bales. Average price of Lint at Sirsa during the week was Rs.4002 per maund (of 37.32 Kg each), higher from the previous week price of Rs. 3957. Average price for Shankar-6 (29mm) was Rs.38967 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week stood low, which was Rs. 39360 per candy previous week.

Weekly Price Outlook : In the coming week we expect Kapas price to remain steady to weak with the price band of Rs. 5100-5550 per quintal in the Rajkot market. Lint price at Sirsa is likely to be in range of Rs. 3750-4150 per maund.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Indian domestic cotton market remained weaker after the disturbances causing due to the coronavirus. The exports are on halt and the traders are looking in for alternative sources to reduce their dependence on China.
- Indian cotton prices decreased slightly (66.7 cents/lbs) compared to previous week and still lower than Cotlook index (71.61 cents/lbs) but Indian prices are trending firm compared to the ICE cotton future (61.41 cents/lbs).
- Gujarat 29 mm Cotton sold between 38,300 to 38,500 Rs./Candy.
- All India Daily Arrivals remained steady in between 1,40,000 to 1,60,000 bales.
- Indian Rupee remained stronger between 73.57 and 74.63 during this week.

Market Highlights:

- **The total cotton production in India reached around 254 lakh bales till 29th Feb'20** i.e., around 72% of the cotton have arrived in the market against the target. The maximum arrivals are reported in Gujarat producing 58.5 lakh bales followed by 55 lakh bales in Maharashtra and 45.38 lakh bales in Telangana. Agriwatch estimates the total cotton production of 351.8 lakh bales this year with an average yield of 466.62 kg/ha up by 4% year on year basis. Whereas, Cotton Association of India projected the cotton production same of around 354 lakh bales. The production is expected to decline in Andhra Pradesh due to decline in yield from 4-5q/ha to 2-3q/ha in Guntur district majorly where so far 12 lakh bales of cotton has arrived. Overall 10-12% increase in production is expected this year in India.
- **As per the latest report, total stock with Government organization (CCI) has crossed 90 lakh bales as CCI procured around 75 lakh bales** from the current season (2019-20) along with around 11 lakh bales procured by Maharashtra federation. Also, CCI is having the stock of around 9 lakh bales procured in the previous season (2018-19). Around 35% of the total arrival have been procured by CCI. The arrivals in Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan likely to finish in the end of March. Although the arrivals declined compared to the previous month across India.

- **CAI has estimated cotton consumption during the months of October 2019 to February 2020 at 133 lakh bales with the opening stock of 32 lakh bales** in the beginning of the season. While the export shipment of cotton estimated by the CAI upto 29th Feb'20 is 27.50 lakh bales and the total imports till 29th Feb'20 reached around 12 lakh bales. Till 29th Feb'20, the consumption is estimated around 133 lakh bales and the stock with CCI, MNCs & Ginners is expected around 97.93 lakh bales so far.

As per the latest estimates by Agriwatch, cotton output in country during the season 2018-19 would be around 321.05 lakh bales (of 170 kg each) whereas 351.61 lakh bales is expected in 2019-20.

Following lower production, imports will rise marginally to 32 lakh bales and around 24 lakh bales is expected to import in the new season.

Due to lower opening stock but estimation of higher production of cotton would increase the availability the new season at 400.2 lakh bales.

Total domestic consumption (Including mill, small mill and non-mill consumption) in 2019-20 is likely to be around 305.96 lakh bales compared to 311.5 lakh bales during the previous season due to lower demand from textile industries.

Cotton exports are expected to remain slightly higher as that of previous year. It is expected that country would export around 45.7 lakh bales of cotton in the season 2019-20 due to slightly higher crop compared to 2018-19.

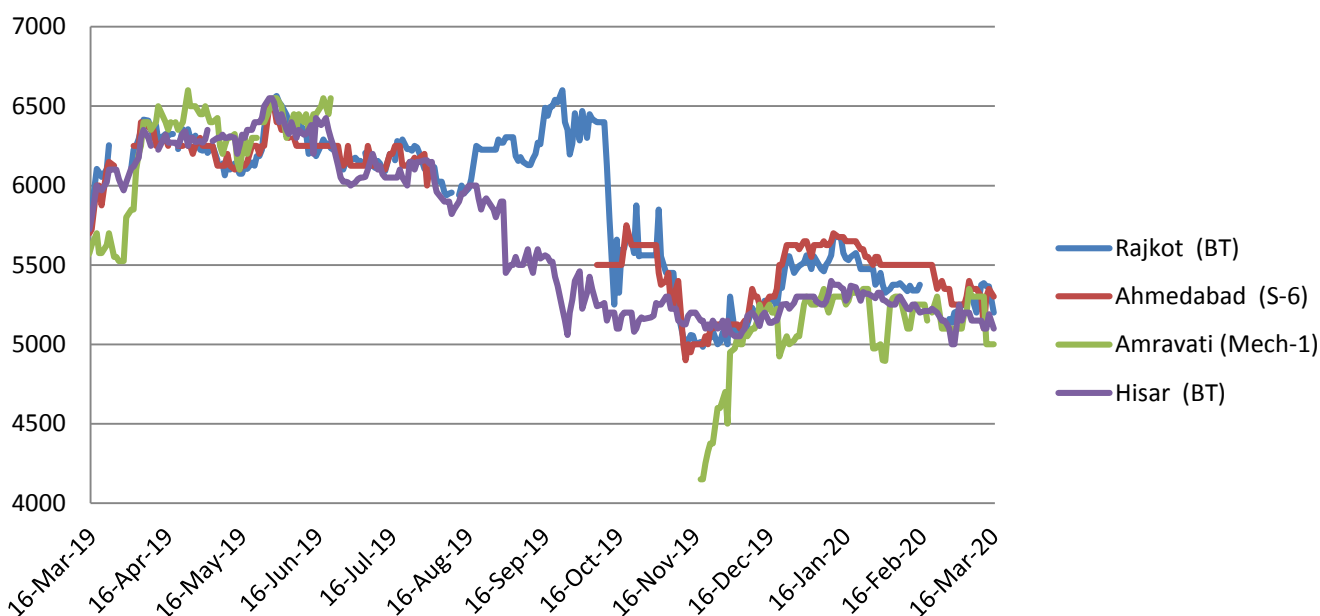
Ending stocks are expected to be around 48.54 lakh bales, it is higher compared to the ending stocks of previous season.

Domestic Cotton Prices Scenario

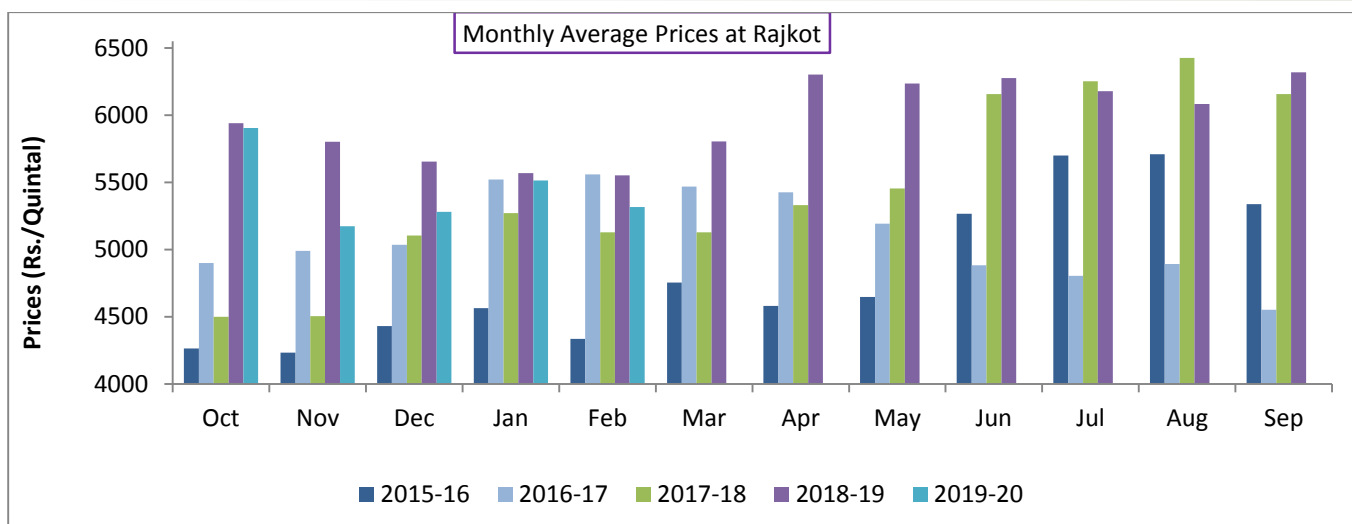
Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot remained firm at Rs 5323/quintal this week compared to the previous week. While the prices in other markets remained weaker due to the demand remained weak and operations of ginning likely to remain slow. The expected range for Kapas at Rajkot would be between Rs. 5150-5500 per quintal for the coming week. The arrivals in Gujarat and Maharashtra remained slow due to the last picking stages.

Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario

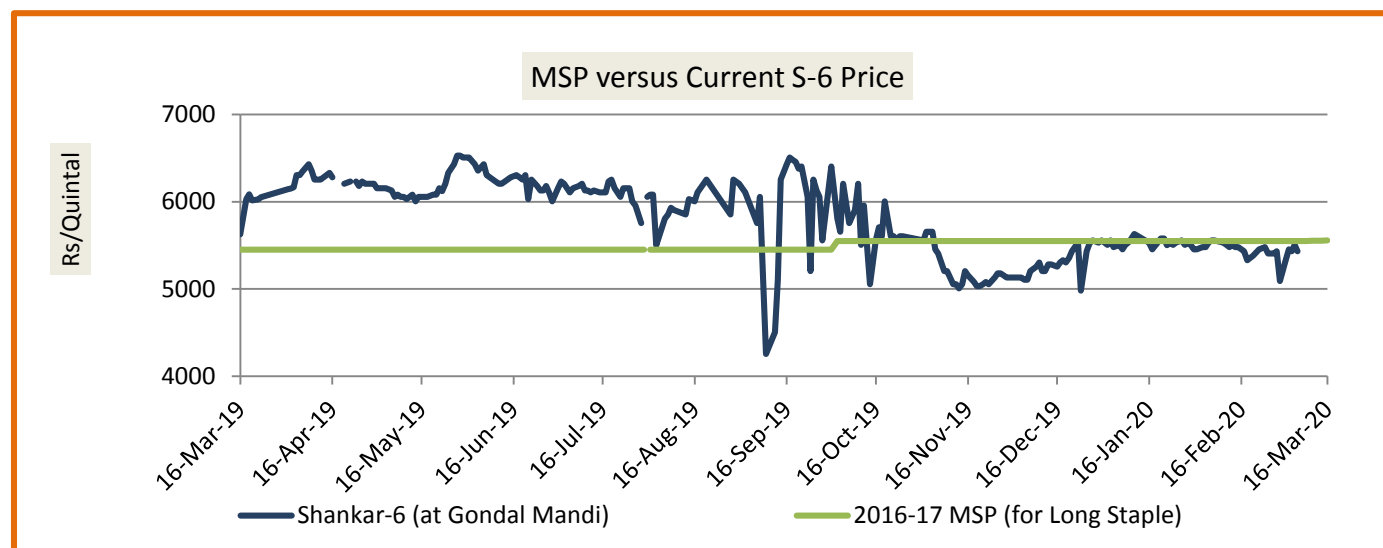


Kapas(seed cotton) prices in country noticed weak during the Feb when compared to the previous month, but the same is ruling lower compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year.

Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 5315 per quintal during Jan, which was Rs 5515/quintal during previous month and Rs.5551 per quintal during the corresponding month last year. We expect Kapas prices to remain steady to low further in the coming month due to the lower demand across the country as well as in international market.

Spot Price versus MSP

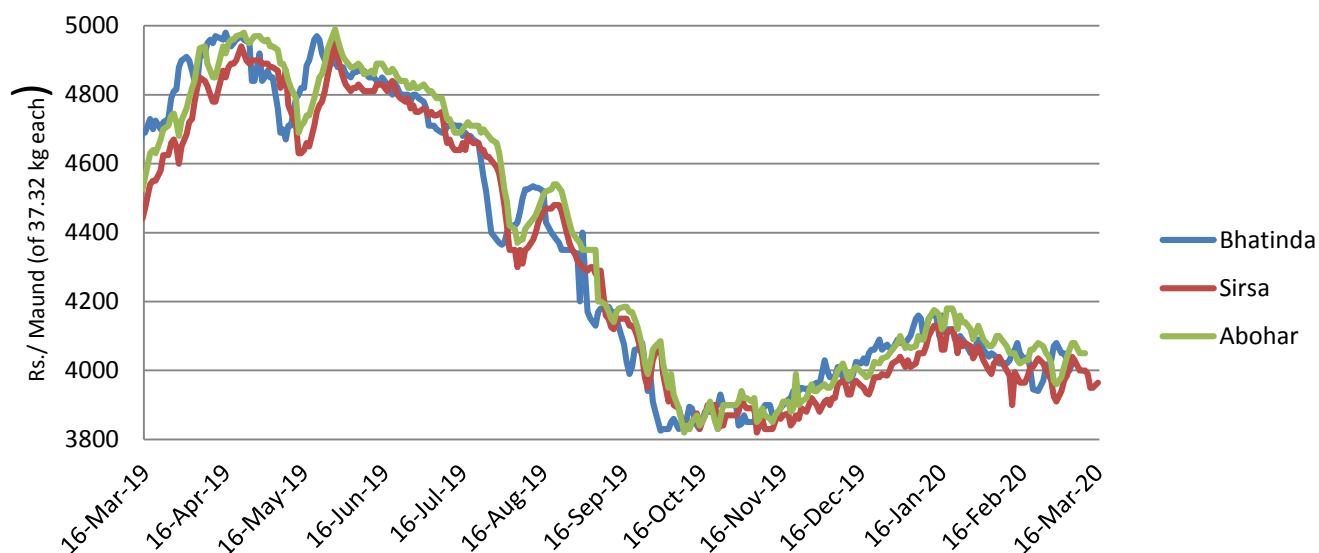
The Kapas average price at Gondal market this week ended at weaker tone at Rs. 5300/q compared to the weekly average of Rs. 5373/q last week. Average price in the week stood further down by around Rs.251/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q). The average gap between the spot price and MSP has slightly declined again, but due to weaker sentiments in the international market would affect the domestic price.



Lint price Outlook

Lint prices stood slightly firm during this week compared to previous week because of moderate demand with lower arrivals. Weekly average price of Lint at Sirsa stood down by Rs.33/q lower at Rs. 4002 per maund of 37.32 kg each, as compared to the previous week price of Rs. 3957 per maund. The arrivals compared to the previous week in Bhatinda the major belt of Punjab has declined from 40800 quintals to 17000 quintals this week followed by Abohar with 3570 quintals and around 5700 quintals in Bhiwani, Haryana.

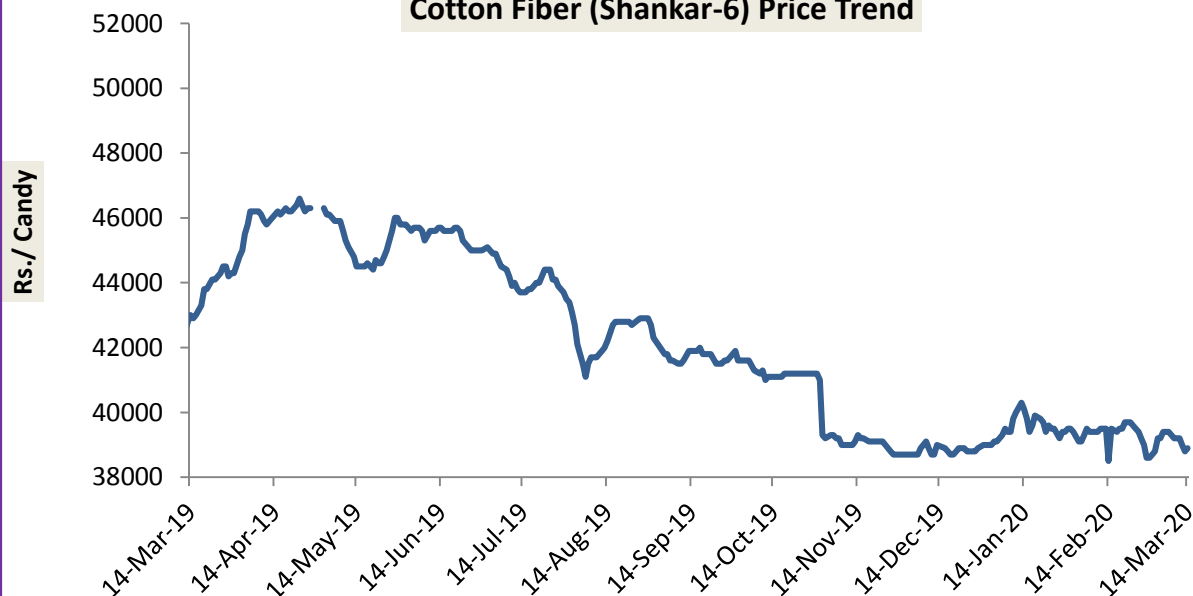
Lint Price Trend at Key Centers



Cotton Fiber price Outlook

Cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices remained slightly firm compared to previous week because of the hope in the improvement of corona virus in the global prices on the back of lack of trade caused after the outbreak of corona virus in China. Average price was Rs. 39167 per candy (of 355.6 kg each) during the week, which was Rs. 38967 per candy previous week while the prices were hovering around Rs. 42366/candy. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady to weak in range of Rs 38500-42000 per candy in the coming week candy.

Cotton Fiber (Shankar-6) Price Trend

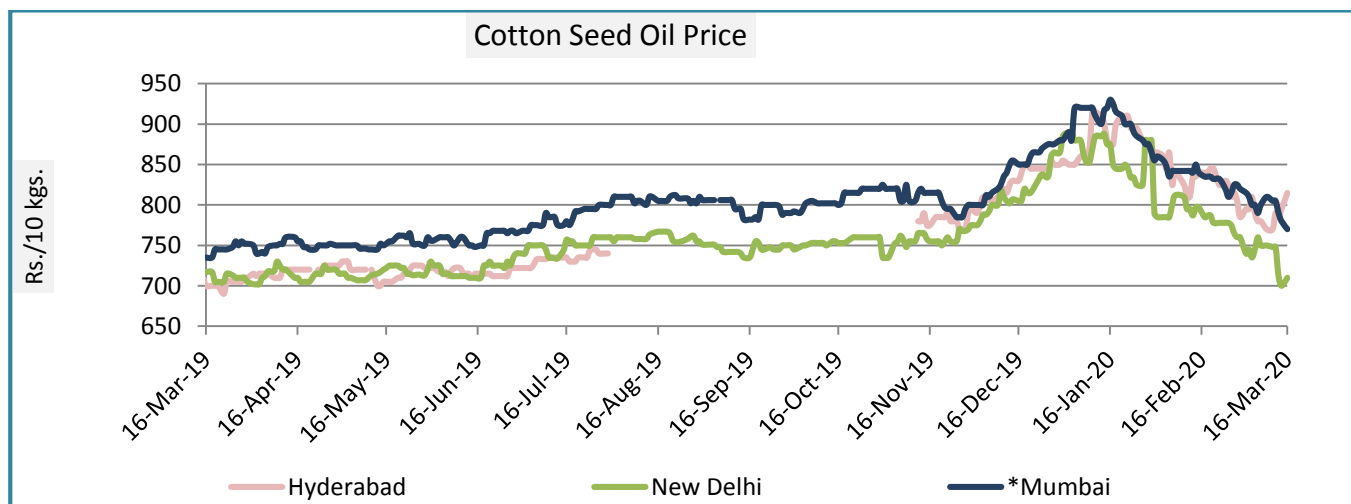


Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake

Cotton seed oil price marginally showed weak trend across all centres during the week. Weekly average price in New Delhi declined to Rs. 735 from Rs. 748 per 10 Kg last week.

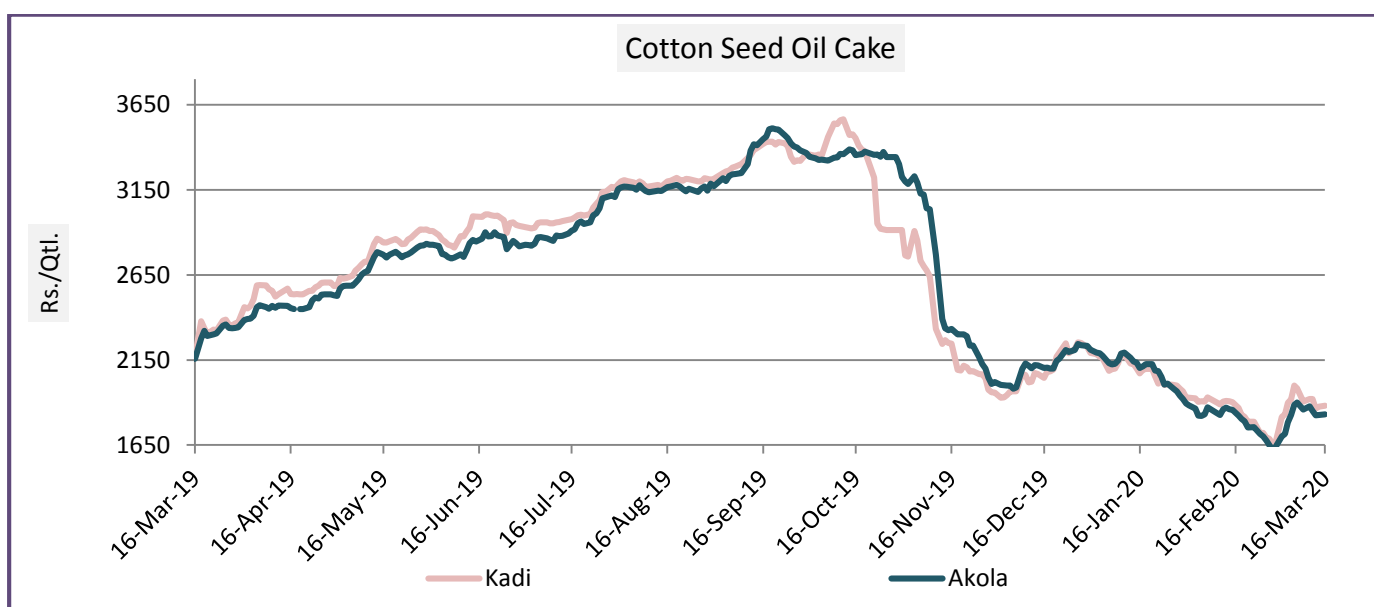


Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario

Cotton seed oil cake price remained firm compared to the last week as support seen after update that due to heavy moisture and sluggish demand of cotton cake, nearly 60% cotton seed crushing units were closed since November in Gujarat. Of 1,000 cotton seed crushing units, nearly 400 mills were currently functional in the state as it is unviable to crush cotton seed in absence of cotton cake demand. The prices are lower compared to the previous year due to the shortage of crop in the previous year. Weekly average price in Akola was Rs. 1866 per quintal, lower compared to the weekly average price of Rs. 1715 per quintal in the previous week.

International Market Scenario

International US cotton spot prices stood weaker at 61.19 cents/lbs during the week. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood weaker at 71.15 cents/pound this week, which was 71.71 at cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotton futures fell 52 to 57 points on Friday, Mar 20 Cotton closed at 62.97, down 56 points.** The Cotlook A index was 25 points higher to 72.30 c/lb on 03/06. The AWP for cotton for the week is 53.36 c/lb.
- According to the latest report released by USDA, the cotton forecast for 2019-20 showed lower production which reduced by 3,00,000 bales to 19.8 million bales** of production in US compared to the Feb'20 estimates. While the consumption and exports remained the same and ending stocks are lowered to 5.1 million bales. The global cotton production is up by 2.6 lakh bales as larger crop expected from Brazil. While the production estimates from other states remained unchanged compared to the previous month's estimates reported by USDA. Due to the outbreak of coronavirus in China, the trade has been disrupted and the imports of around 2.5 lakh

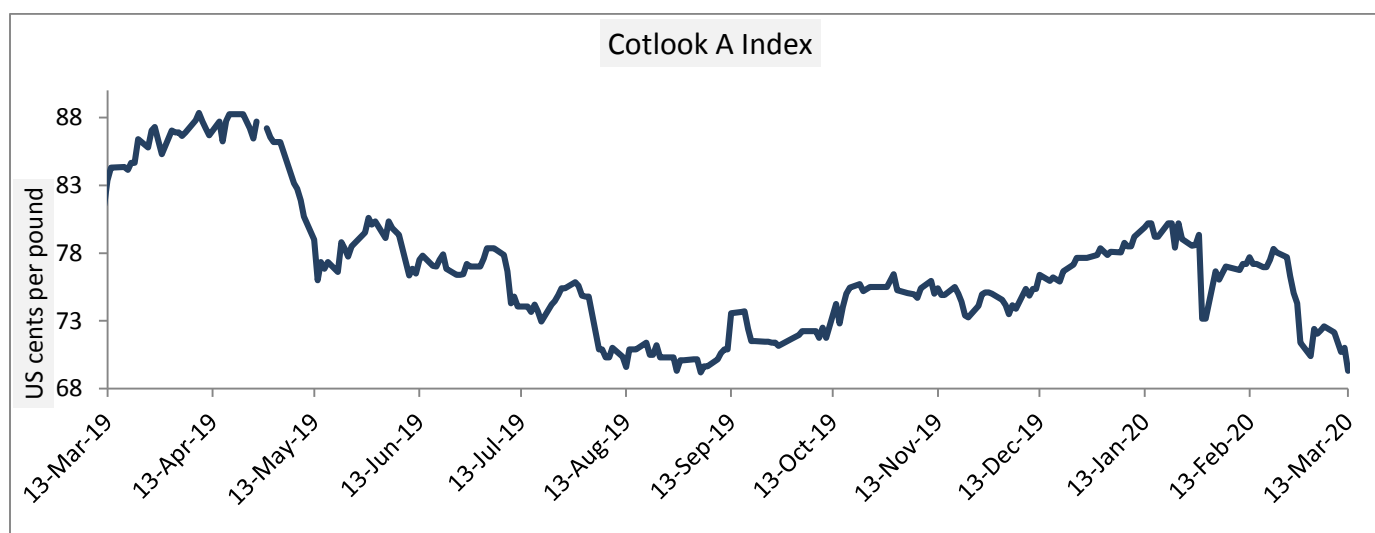
bales are lowered so far following in the reduction in demand by 1 million bales in the February estimates. While Turkey likely to import more cotton to 4.3 million bales up by 8 lakh bales from year on year comparison.

- U.S. upland cotton ginnings continue to run ahead of the 2018 pace because of a bigger crop. According to USDA as of 1st Mar'20**, ginnings are 193.06 lakh bales compared to 174.72 lakh bales which is 14% more than 2018-19's pace. Texas is in the lead at 63.73 lakh bales ginned, more than 3.65 million ahead of second place Georgia (27.16 lakh bales). Also, Missouri ginned 1,539,700 bales, compared to 1,399,150 bales last year followed by Arkansas ginning 1,497,900 bales, compared to 1,249,500 year on year and North Carolina that ginned 1,061,750 bales, compared to 703,500 a year ago.
- The US Export Sales report from USDA showed 484,200 RB of 2019-20 upland cotton sold in the week ending 05th Mar'20 were up by 22%** compared to previous week. Increases primarily for Pakistan (161,600 RB), China (90,900 RB), Turkey (84,100 RB), Vietnam (47,400 RB), Bangladesh (32,800 RB) were offset by reductions primarily for Japan (3,900 RB) and Thailand (1,200 RB). For 2020/2021, net upland sales of 160,400 RB were for Mexico (91,600 RB), Turkey (20,100 RB), China (15,900 RB), Pakistan (11,400 RB). Net Upland Shipment for exports of 424,600 RB were down 11 percent from the previous week, Exports were primarily to Vietnam (94,600 RB), Pakistan (86,200 RB), Turkey (60,400 RB), China (55,100 RB), Bangladesh 34,800 RB).

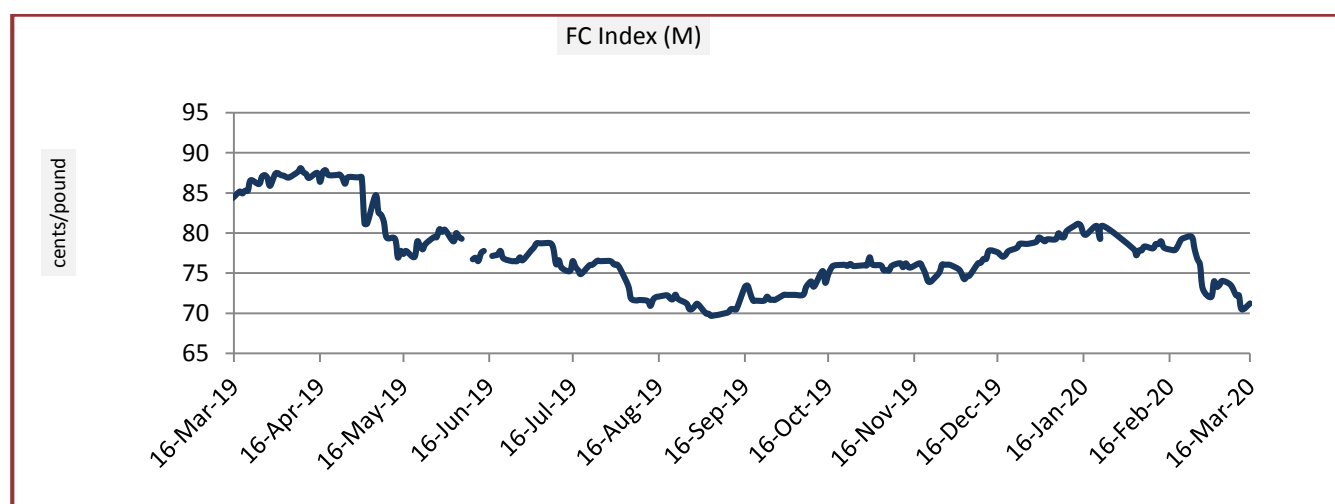
Cotlook A index noticed slightly down in last week. The Cotlook A Index was down 71.15 cents/lb than previous week (71.71 cents/lb).

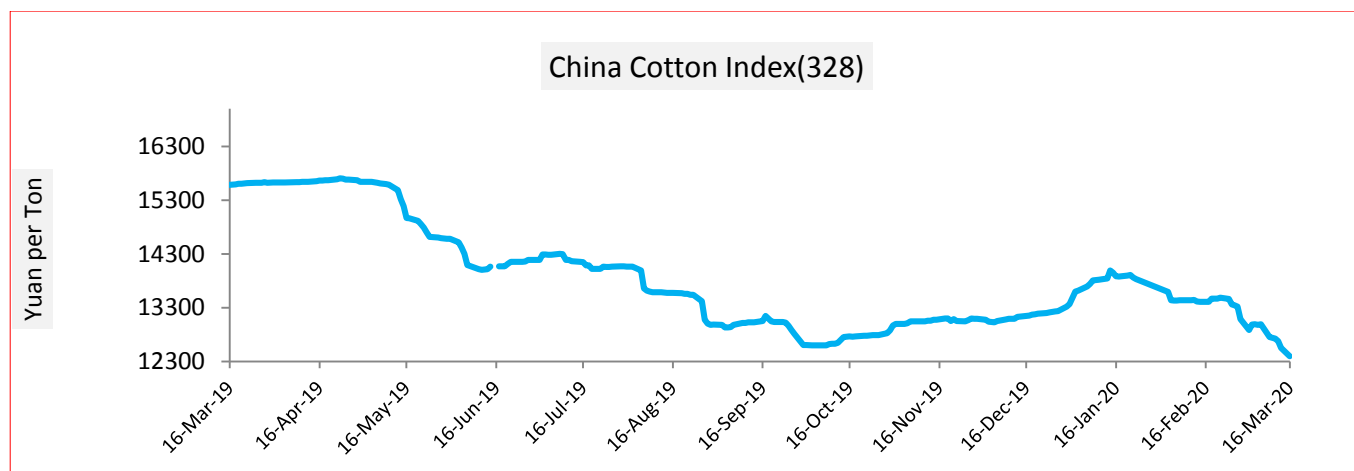


China Cotton Index and Foreign Cotton Index

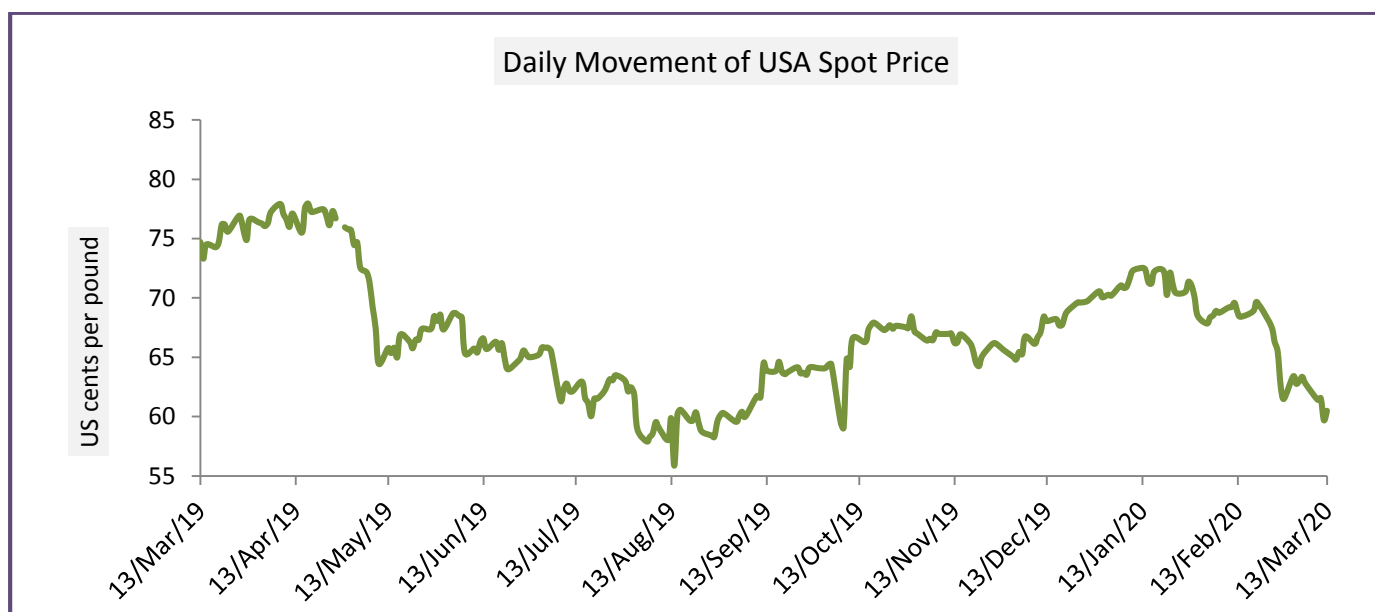

USA Spot Prices

US cotton dipped significantly compared to the previous even after good sales report. U.S. Export Sales was excellent and the highest during the year. Chinese buying was more than one million bales. The 2019 US crop was cut another 300,000 bales due to a 12 pound per acre reduction in the US average yield. With the reduction in Use in China, China's need for imports was also trimmed by 250,000 bales. But this was offset by increased imports for Turkey and Bangladesh. News of spread of corona virus in Europe and USA dominated all markets. Sharp fall in stock markets across the world also dragged all commodity markets down.

Pakistan Spot Prices

Steady to bearish trend was witnessed in Pakistan cotton market. The local textile and cotton industry which is moving in positive direction is badly affected by Corona virus. There were many challenges in the way of increasing the production of cotton. Ginners are suffering due to the non-interest of millers in the purchase of cotton. Although, ginners had the limited stock of 4 lakh bales out of which only 25 percent cotton is of good quality. It is expected that due to the negative impact of Corona virus in China Pakistani exports is likely to increase as Americans and European importers will take interest in the buying of Pakistani textile products.

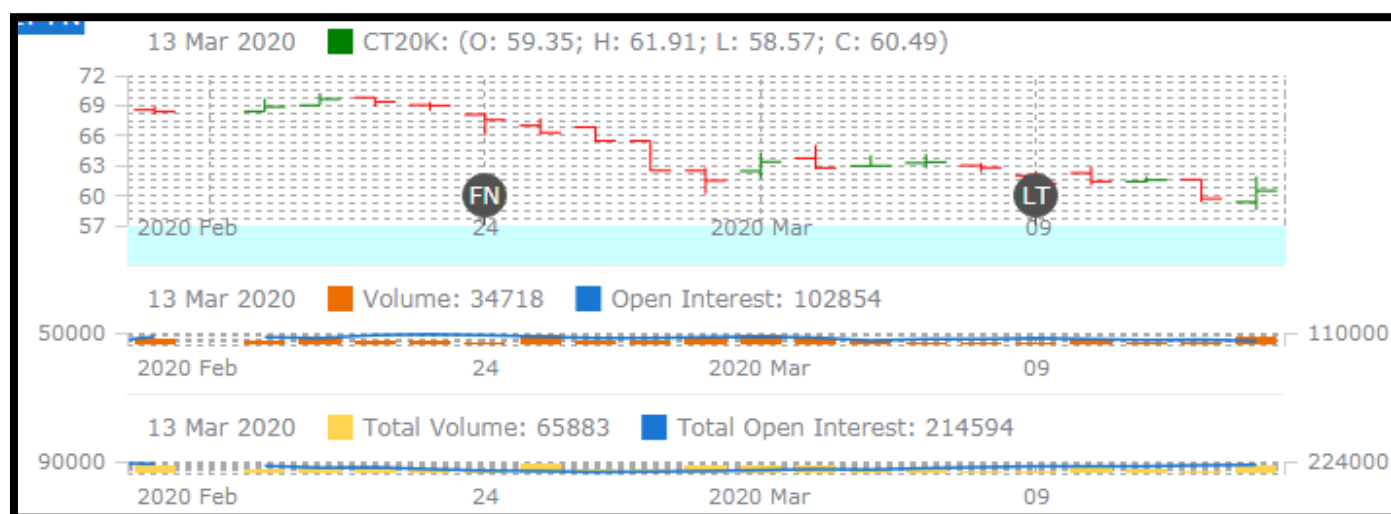

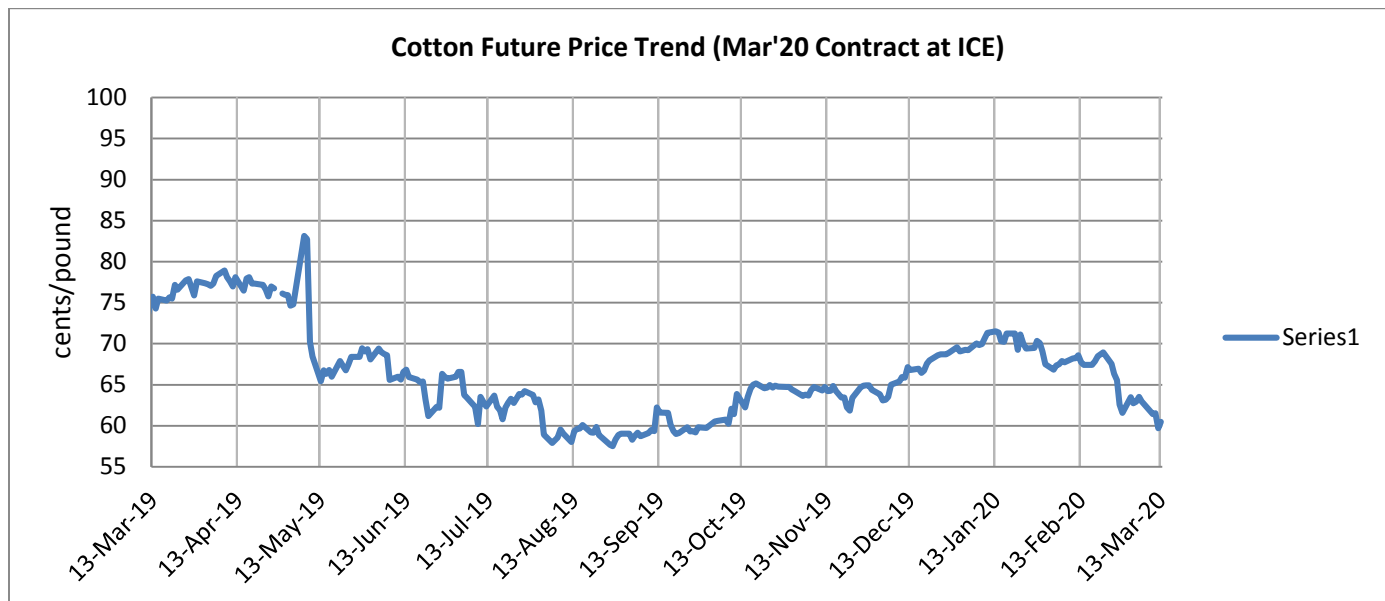

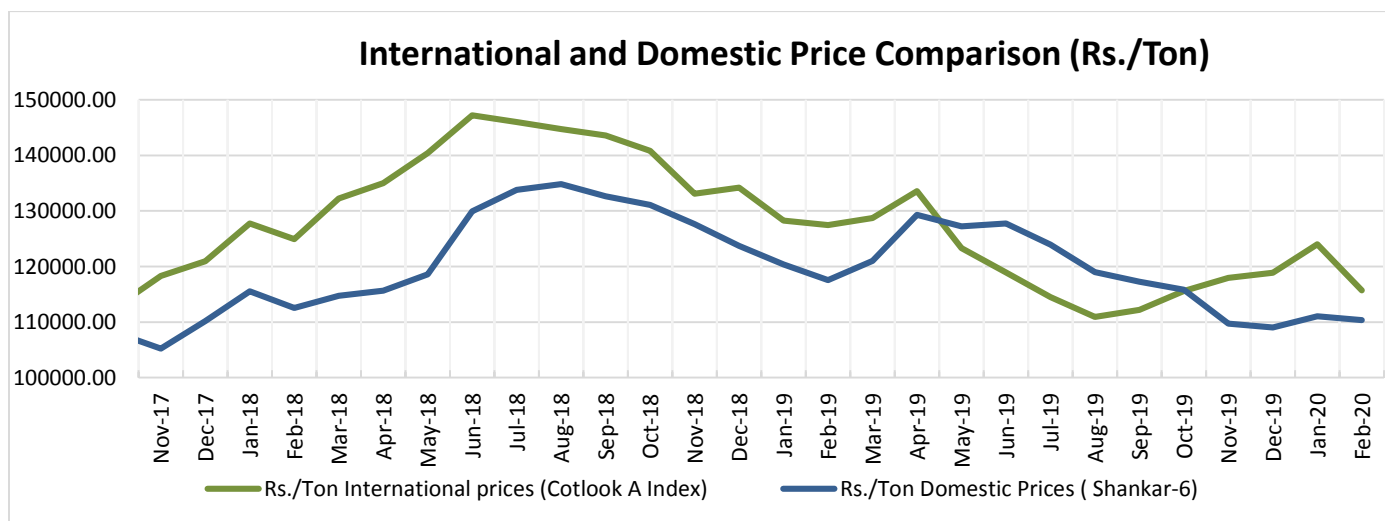
