

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 20<sup>th</sup> Jul 2020

# **Domestic market summary**

**Domestic market Scenario**: The cotton market showed mixed trend. The progress in cotton sowing is suppressing Indian cotton prices. According to the ICRA's forecast, revenue of India's cotton spinning sector will decline by 25-30% during 2020-21 due to the virus, and recovery will be slow. The reason behind it is that the demand has been sluggish after the pandemic affected the global economy. Also, the reduced offtake of cotton yarn and fibre exports reduced as a result of the China and India dispute. The Indian cotton sowing progress showed 35% higher acreage so far till 10<sup>th</sup> July'20. The India Cotton Exchange near month's prices stood low, around Rs 33,593 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices in Cotton Association of India stood around Rs.34,600/ candy during the week.

**Weekly Price Outlook**: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4700-4900/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4150-4550/q.

### **Major Market Highlights:**

- The cotton sowing this year is ahead of the last year's pace by around 17%. It is expected that around 5-8% increase in area could be seen for the next season. Therefore, the production might increase and the higher cotton stock available with CCI in the current season could affect the prices in the 2020-21.
- Cotlook index remained weak (69.06 cents/lbs) higher compared to the ICE cotton future stood steady (63.32 cents/lbs).
- All India arrivals have reached between 15,000 to 25,000 bales per day.
- Indian Rupee remained steady between 75.14 and 75.21 during this week.

#### Market Highlights:

- With the good amount of rainfall across India, around 113 lakh ha area has been sown under cotton till 16<sup>th</sup>

  July'20 for 2020-21 marketing year, up by around 17% during the same period of time last year. The cotton sowing in the northern part of India (Punjab, Haryana & Rajasthan) has been almost completed (covering 18.96 lakh ha). In Maharashtra the acreage increased to 39.83 lakh ha while there has been a reduction in area in Gujarat by around 1% to 20.33 lakh ha.
- Telangana covered an area of around 20.4 lakh ha so far till 15<sup>th</sup> Jul'20, up by 76%. The government targets to cover another 4.5 lakh ha in the coming days which will be higher by around 30% compared to the previous year. The crop is in vegetative phase and few sucking pests were reported in few areas in Adilabad and Nagarkurnool district but no harm to the crop so far. The area covered by cotton in Andhra Pradesh is 2.74 lakh



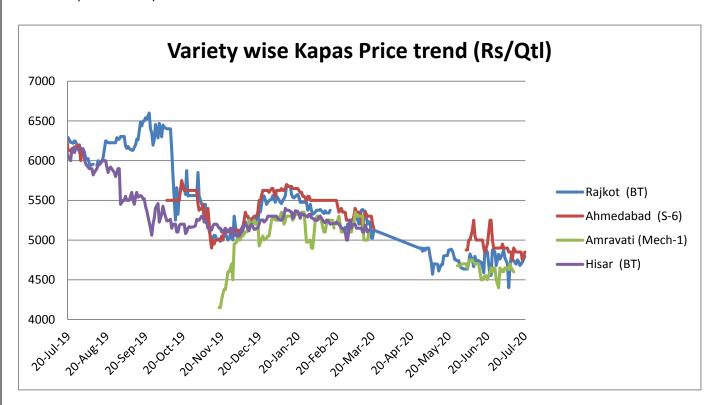
ha till 15<sup>th</sup> July'20 higher by 122% compared to the previous year during the same time. Sucking pests in about 20 ha was reported in Kadapa district but treated with pesticides on time.

• The arrivals in North India including Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan reached around 66 lakh bales in the 2019-20 season. The current season arrivals are around 8-10% higher compared to the corresponding period last season. According to the trade sources, the arrivals of 9.53 lakh bales, 24.26 lakh bales and 33.11 lakh bales in Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan was reported till June end.

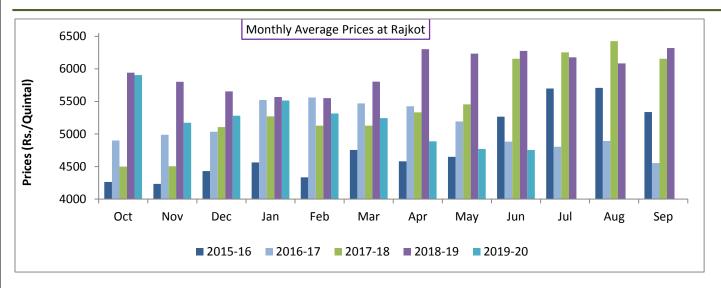
Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

**Weekly Price Review:** Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot increased slightly to Rs. 4722/q. The prices stood at Rs. 4670/quintal in the previous week.





### Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



The arrivals in the month of June declined. The monthly average price was ruling steady to low in June at Rs. 4754/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4769 per quintal during May, which was Rs. 6275/quintal during the corresponding month last year in Jun'19. We expect Kapas prices to remain steady to low further in July due to the lower demand across the country as well as because of increase in sowing area.

### **Spot Price versus MSP**

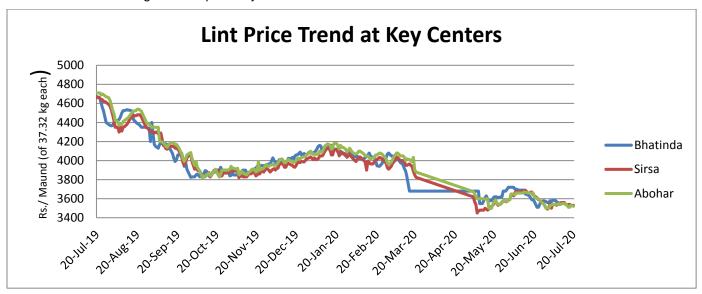
The arrivals increased during the week ending on 16<sup>th</sup> July'20 in Gondal. Kapas average price at Gondal market was closed at Rs.4597/q lower than MSP and higher from the prices that were in the prior week that stood at Rs. 4508/q. Average price in the week stood low by around Rs. 953/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q). The average gap between the spot price and MSP has decreased in the last week.





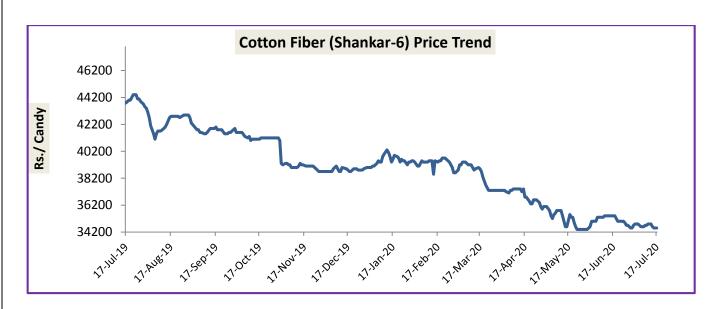
### **Lint price Outlook**

The average price stood around Rs.3548/maund of lint in Sirsa, up by Rs. 15/q though, there were no new arrivals in the Haryana and Punjab. The average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last stood around Rs.3568 and Rs. 3536/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.



### **Cotton Fiber price Outlook**

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was slightly weak at Rs. 34683/candy from around Rs. 34650/ candy compared to the previous week. The demand has not improved and remained stagnant in last week in domestic as well as in the international market. Average price were around Rs. 43,817 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain in range of Rs. 33000-35500 per candy in the coming week candy.



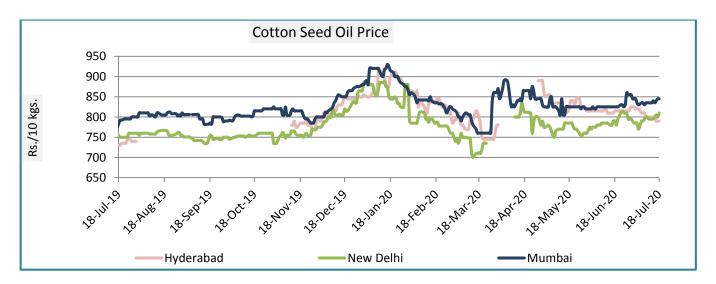


# **Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake**

### **Cotton Seed Oil weekly Price Scenario**

Cotton seed oil price showed positive trend across all the centres during the week ending on 16<sup>th</sup> July'20. Weekly average price in Hyderabad stood firm at Rs. 798. In Mumbai the prices ranged around Rs. 842 and Rs.798 per 10 Kg in New Delhi.

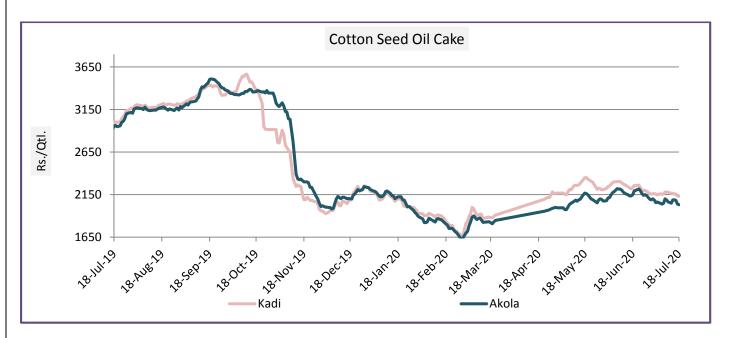


#### **Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario**

The cottonseed oilcake prices were steady during last week. The prices in Kadi & Akola stood around Rs. 2167/q and Rs. 2077/q, respectively. Telangana government is likely to target an area of around 24.8 lakh ha, up by around 30% compared to the previous year. The CCI cotton sales were slow due to lack of demand from the textile mills. Amid the expectation of higher acreage under cotton in India, the cotton seed prices are under pressure. NCDEX Cotton seed oil cake futures ended on a weaker note on Friday at Rs.1929/q against Rs. 1951/q in the prior week. NCDEX COCUDAKL is now getting support at 1889 and below same could see a test of 1810 levels, and first resistance is now likely to be seen at 2120.

# **International Market Scenario**

Average International ICE cotton prices stood weaker at 63.32 cents/lbs, down by 63 points during the last week. Also Cotlook A Index weekly average stood weaker at 69.06 cents/pound this week, which was at 70.09 cents/pound during last week.

### Major Market Highlights:

- In the Crop Progress report released by USDA, showed 50% planted U.S. cotton was in good condition in the week ending on 19<sup>th</sup> July'20, , up by 3% since last week. Cotton was 73% squared, which is 2% point lagging of the 5-yr average and increased from 63% in the prior week, up by 10% points.
- U.S. Export Sales was poor but shipments was good. Net upland sales reductions of 17,500 RB for 2019-2020 were down from the previous week and from the prior 4-week average. Increases primarily for Vietnam (26,500 RB), Pakistan (6,400 RB), and Indonesia (2,100 RB), were more than offset by reductions primarily for China



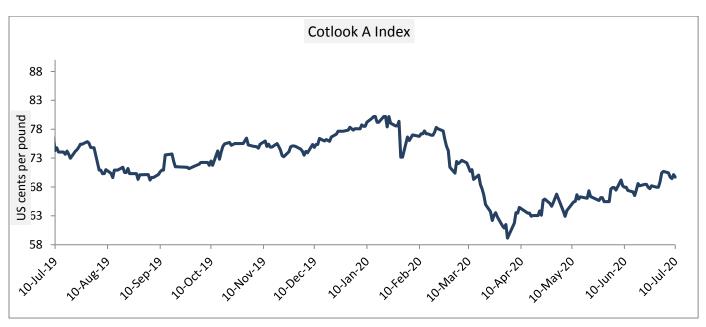
(38,600 RB), El Salvador (4,000 RB), Peru (3,600 RB), Thailand (2,900 RB), and Bangladesh (1,300 RB). China's renewed buying of U.S. cotton gave the perception consumption in last week's report.

- Pakistan Textile and Apparel industry showed major recovery. Exports reached 959.13 million USD, which was
  down only 5.3% from a year ago. A sharp increase in PPE exports are believed to be part of the success. According
  to the market sources, several have reported an increase in orders from Europe.
- The demand at the Chinese Reserve auctions has remained good, with sales now exceeding 100,000 tons since the auctions began in early July, which implies increased mill use. A survey shows Chinese spinners were operating at more than 60% of capacity. Cotton use has recovered slightly and is steady, but the yarn and fabric sector are still suffering from weak apparel exports due to which the cotton yarn prices are weak.

## **Cotlook A Index**

Cotlook A index noticed slightly firm in last week. The Cotlook A Index was at 70.09 cents/lb higher than the previous week (68.68 cents/lb) and a hike of 2% is witnessed compared to the previous month.

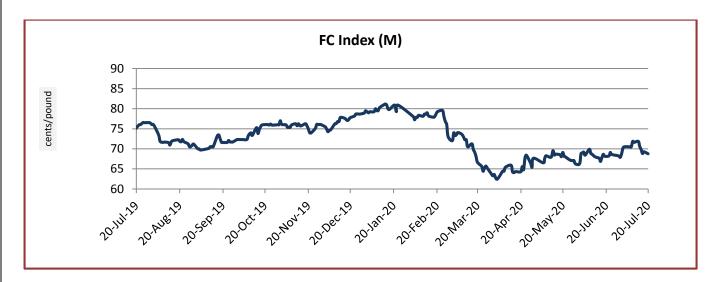

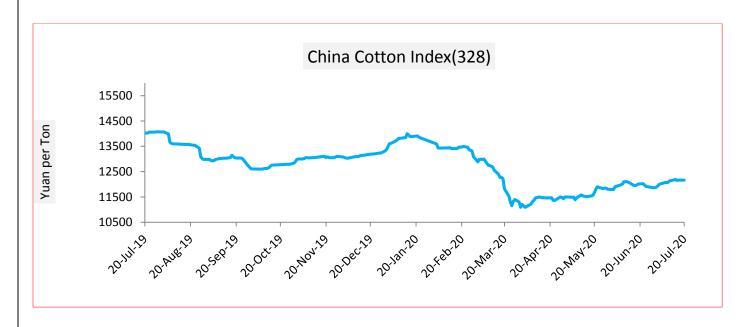

# **USA Spot Prices**

Spot cotton trading was slow as the demand was light. Supplies and producer offerings were moderate. In Kansas (South-west region), frequent showers brought beneficial rainfall to the fields that needed moisture. Stands are squaring and setting bolls. The dryland and irrigated benefitted from recent rainfall. In South-central region, the crop made good progress under hot and humid growing conditions. And weather forecast revelas that, rainfall is expected in near future, which should provide beneficial moisture to dry fields in places that receive some precipitation.

# **Pakistan Spot Prices**

The prices stood slightly firm compared to the previous week. The kapas supply has increased in the market. The supply of Kapas was coming from the lower areas of Sindh while it has been also started in limited amounts from some areas of Punjab. The kapas in Sindh was affected due to the rains in some cotton producing areas a week ago. A new spell of rains in many cotton producing areas of Sindh may affect the quality and picking of the cotton. However, rains are beneficial for the crop at this stage, but if there will be more rains, water accumulated in the fields may damage the crop.

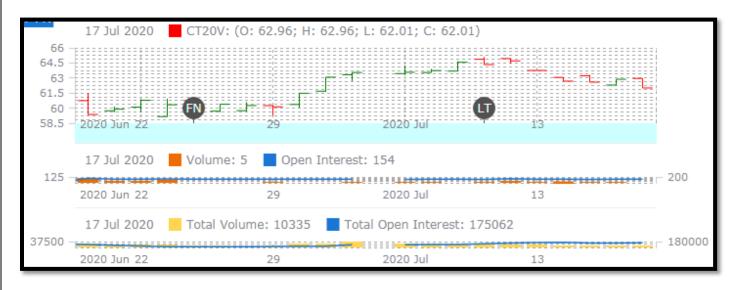

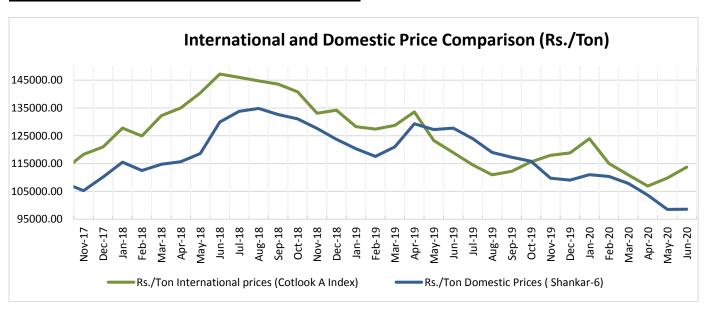
