

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 17th Aug 2020

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: According to CCI, the agency had witnessed good sales and sold around 35 lakh bales of cotton out the total purchased cotton since 2018-19 (113 lakh bales). The millers, exporters, MNCs, and mediators were the major buyers in the CCI sales. Current arrivals have lessened, due to which the prices stood slightly firm. According to the market sources, it is expected that around 9-10 lakh bales would arrived till July end across India reducing the arrivals to around 28,000 bales per day by the end of the July month. Where, a cumulative total from the beginning of the season is 91 lakh bales that arrived in Gujarat at an average of 16,800 bales per day in July. The India cotton exchange front month's prices stood steady, around Rs 34,208 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices in Cotton Association of India stood steady around Rs.33,633 candy during the week.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4700-4900/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4350-4750/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotlook index stood strong (69.71 cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood weaker (62.82 cents/lbs).
- All India arrivals have reached around 10,000 bales per day.
- Indian Rupee stood steady between 74.77 and 74.9 during this week.

Market Highlights:

- Cotton area across India covered around 125.479 lakh ha as on 13th Aug'20 for 2020-21, down by around 1.7% compared to the total acreage under cotton last year. The cotton sowing in the northern part of India (Punjab, Haryana & Rajasthan) covered an area of 19.11 lakh ha. In Maharashtra the acreage increased to 41.45 lakh ha while in Gujarat the area is 22.7 lakh ha, down by -12% compared to corresponding time last year. In AP and Telangana, a surge in acreage is reported in both the states covering 4.99 lakh ha (+1.8%) and 23.47 lakh ha (+36.1%), respectively.
- The cotton area sown in Telangana surpassed last year's area by around 6.2 lakh ha, up by 36% compared to the previous year as on 12th Aug' 20. While, the area of around 4.99 lakh ha has been covered during the same time and increased by 2% compared to the corresponding period previous year. The crop in AP and Telangana are in vegetative phase with progressive sowing in other areas. Since June after the commencement of monsoon, there has been excess rainfall in AP and normal rainfall in Telangana.

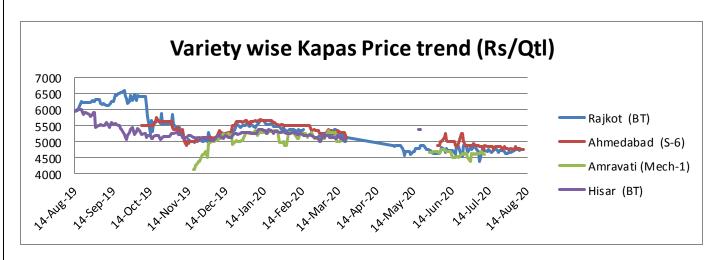


- Considering the favourable weather in India and increased area, USDA has increased the India's production estimates to 38.04 million bales (170kg per bale) in 2020-21, up by 4% from previous month's estimates. While the import trade has been reduced to 1.28 million bales from 1.41 million bales in the previous month. As the recovery in revival of the cotton industry has been sluggish, the domestic use was also declined to 28.8 million bales in Aug' 20 estimates from 29.46 million bales (Jul' 20 estimates). Therefore, the assumptions are made that there would be higher ending stock 28.83 million bales compared to previous month's estimates (27.29 million bales) as well as from 2019-20 (24.60 million bales).
- The continuous heavy rainfall in Punjab and Haryana left the cotton fields under submerged condition. Crop on nearly 50,000 acres in Haryana has been reported under 2 feet stagnant water condition for 2-3 days. Cotton crop on 5,000 to 6,000 acres had got destroyed in Hisar district as reported by the state official. The other districts: Bhiwani and Jind are also likely to have affected due to rains. Also, the presence of sucking pest has been reported in some parts of Mansa, and Fazilka district of Punjab.
- The cotton farmers in Jalgaon district of Maharashtra are also worried as signs of Pink Bollworm (PBW) infestation have been reported in 30-40% of the planted crop. The 70-80% crop is now in the flowering stage, the most vulnerable stage for bollworm attack. According to Cotton Association of India, cotton was sown on 5.25 lakh hectare in the region and PBW infestation has been reported on nearly 1.25-1.50 lakh hectare. Also, the early signs of pink bollworm infestation was noticed in the fields of Marathwada and Vidarbha regionearlier in the month.

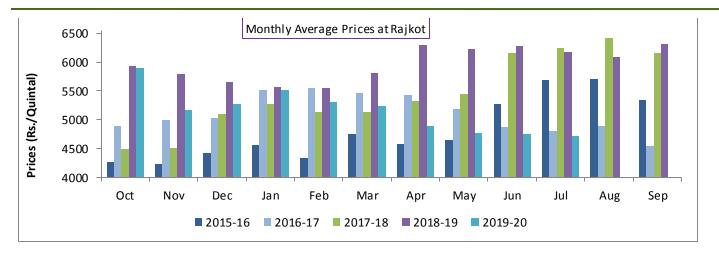
Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot was firm at Rs. 4738/q compared to the prior week that traded slightly lower around Rs. 4724/q. The Gujarat was closed for around 4 days on the occasion of Janmashtmi.





Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



The arrivals in the month of July increased slightly. The monthly average price was ruling steady to low in July at Rs. 4713/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4754 per quintal during June, and Rs. 6177/quintal during last year in July'19. We expect Kapas prices to remain steady in August due to the lower demand across the country as well as because of increased acreage under cotton amid good rainfall.

Spot Price versus MSP

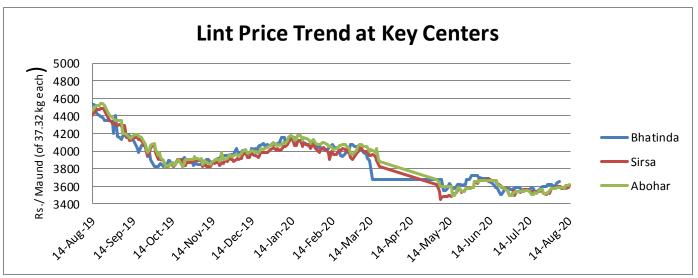
The prices slightly decreased during the week ending on 13th Aug'20 in Gondal. Kapas at Gondal market closed at Rs.4643/q, decreased from prior week that stood at Rs. 4656/q. Average price in the week stood low by around Rs. 907/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q). The average gap between the spot price and MSP has decreased in the last week.





Lint price Outlook

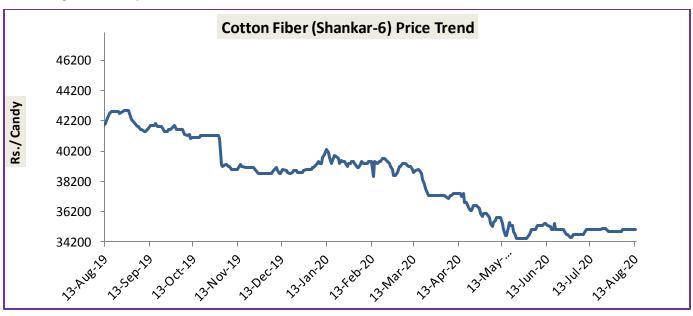
The average price stood around Rs.3584/maund of lint in Sirsa. The new arrivals are expected to commence after 2nd week of September this year. The average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last week stood steady around Rs.3621 and Rs. 3596/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.

Cotton Fiber price Outlook

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was firm at Rs. 35000 /candy from around Rs. 34960/ candy compared to the previous week. The demand was steady in the international market for Indian cotton but due to the lower arrivals in the domestic market, the market was supported. Average prices were around Rs. 44,000 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain firm in range of Rs. 34000-36500 per candy in the coming week candy.

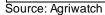


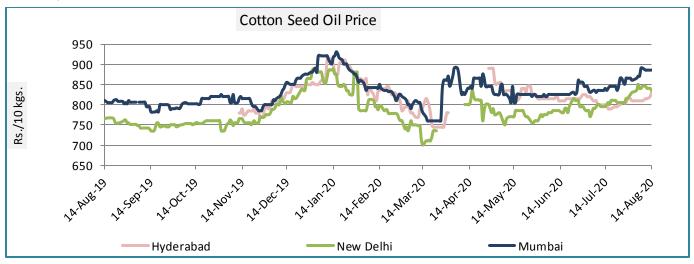

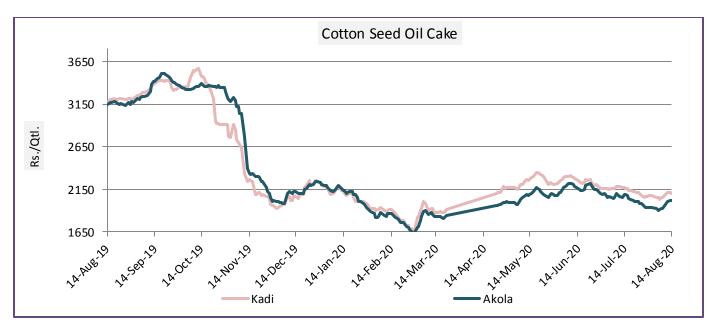
Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario

The cottonseed oilcake prices were weaker during the last week. The prices in Kadi & Akola stood around Rs. 2085/q and Rs. 1967/q, respectively. The prices were supported with respect to the slight improvement in cotton prices. NCDEX Cotton seed oil cake futures ended on a firm note on Friday at Rs. 1887/q against Rs. 1780/q in the prior week. NCDEX Cocudakl is now getting support at 1816 and below same could see a test of 1720 levels, and first resistance is now likely to be seen at 1957.

<u>International Market Scenario</u>

Average International ICE cotton prices stood weaker at 62.42 cents/lbs, up by 89 points at 63.71 cents/lbs during the last week. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood firm at 69.43 cents/pound this week, which was at 69.93 cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights:

• According to USDA in Aug'20 estimates, the world production and ending stocks were higher but lower beginning stocks, consumption & trade compared to the previous month's estimates. World production is estimated at 1.3 million bales after the production in India, US and Australia were revised higher. Expected 2020-21 world consumption is 1.2 million bales lower this month, with declines in India, China, Pakistan, Brazil, and Indonesia while increased the consumption numbers for Bangladesh and Turkey. Imports were projected lower in Pakistan, Indonesia and India, and higher in Bangladesh, Turkey, and Malaysia. This month, 2020-21 world ending stocks were projected 2.1 million bales higher than the previous month and 4.4 million bales higher than in 2019-20.



- On the basis of the NASS production forecast survey, indicates lower harvested area and higher cotton yield compared with last month's expectations. Therefore, in the latest report released by USDA, increased the production from 22.41 million bales (170kg per bale) in 2020-21 to 23.16 million bales, +3% compared to the previous estimates. Along with the 1% increase in beginning stocks, the total supply has increased to 32.38 million bales, up by 2.7% compared to the previous months' estimates (m-o-m). While, the total demand in the country is expected to decline by 0.7% to 22.64 million bales due to the estimated fall in consumption to 3.46 million bales (-3.5%) m-o-m.
- The cotton imports by Bangladesh is expected to increase in 2020-21 season to 9.35 million bales (170kg per bale) from 8.96 million bales in 2019-20. Annual cotton consumption in Bangladesh is 8.5 million-9 million bales of which the country imports around 1.5-2 million bales from India each year. A significant drop in demand in garments & apparel amid the global coronavirus pandemic lead to the lower imports in 2019-20. Most spinning and weaving mills were also shuttered during the March-June period due to the lockdown. The imports are significant source to run the significantly established garment & apparel as the country can supply only 3% of the country's demand. Although the demand has improved from past 1.5 months and thus the imports might rise in the coming season 2020-21.
- China is likely to produce 33.92 million bales (170kg per bale) in 2020-21, down by 2.4% year-on-year (y-o-y) as the national cotton acreage decreased by 4.15%. According to China Cotton Association (CCA), the national cotton yield in 2020-21 is expected to increase slightly y-o-y. According to CCA forecast, the national cotton imports in 2019 will drop to 8.53 million bales, down 1.41 million bales from the previous period and USDA estimates an increase of more than 25% in 2020-21 on the account of lower domestic production. The country's ending stock is estimated to increase in 2019-20 to 47.04 million bales according to USDA amid coronavirus hit the domestic and global demand.

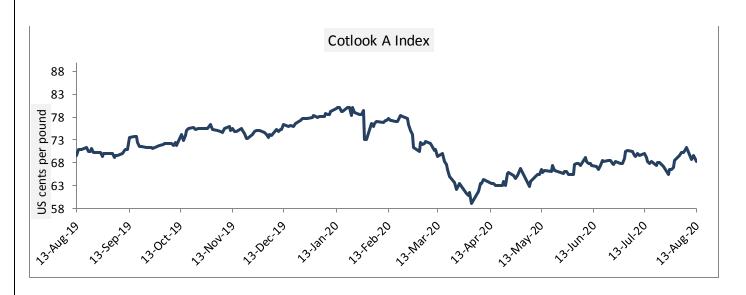
Cotlook A Index

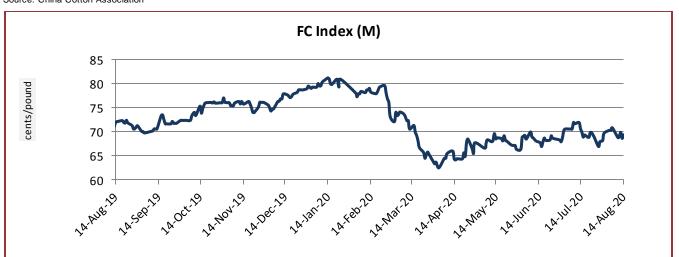

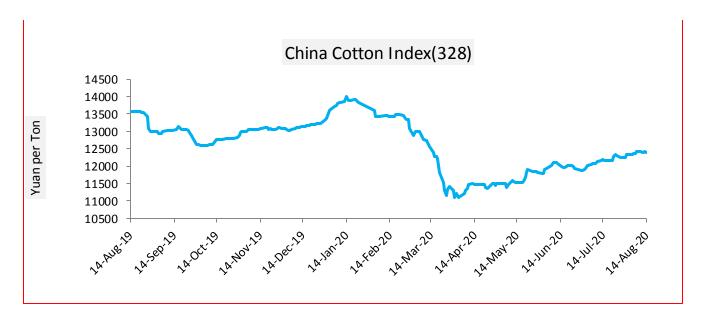

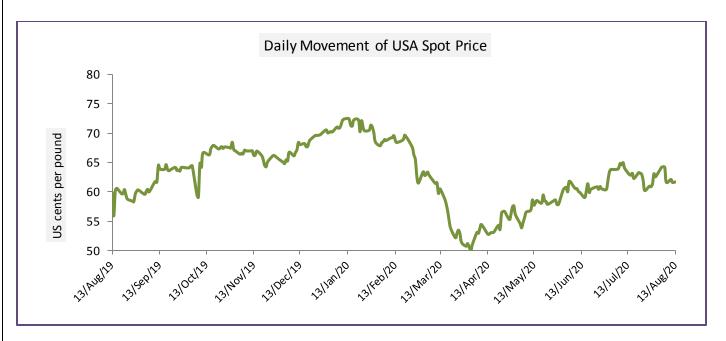


USA Spot Prices

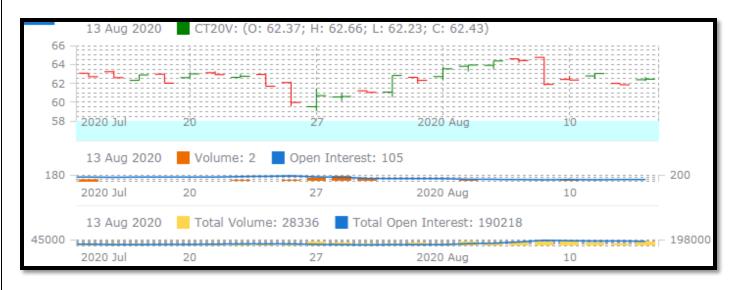

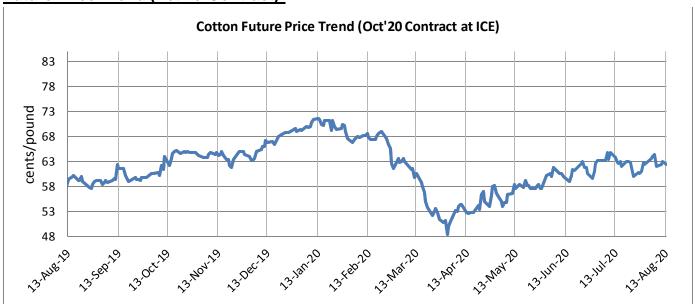

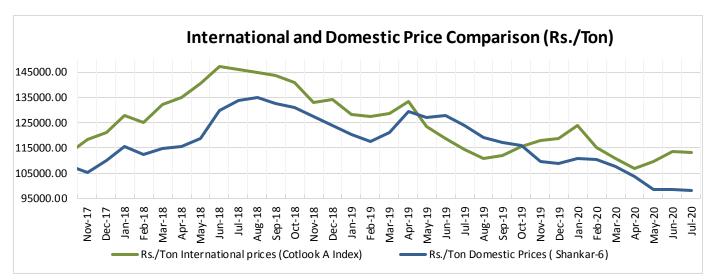
