

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 31st Aug 2020

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: The prices in the domestic market improved due to regular increase in CCI offer rate. Traders also quoted higher rate with increasing CCI floor prices. Due to the hike in domestic prices, the Indian basis narrowed with rupee appreciation and higher International cotton prices. New arrivals have started from few regions in Haryana and Maharashtra. Some damage was reported due to heavy rainfall. Some white fly infestation was also reported in north due to the humidity. Over all till now Indian crops is progress is good and healthy. The Indian cotton exchange front month's prices stood firm, around Rs 35'818 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.35,942 candy during the week.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4800-5350/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4750-4510/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotton sowing area in India crossed last year's total sowing area and reached 128 lakh hectares.
- Cotlook index stood firm (70.95 cents/lbs) and the ICE cotton future also stood slightly firm (64.72 cents/lbs) in last week.
- Daily all India arrival is now 12,000 to 15,000 bales per day.
- Indian Rupee stood strong between 73.38 and 74.32 during this week.

Market Highlights:

- Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has increased the its sales floor price by Rs.500-600/candy in all grades of cotton to a maximum price at Rs.38700/ candy (30mm) after one week of increased sales. CCI has sold around 50 lakh bales so far till 23rd Aug'20. Mills have purchased around 23 lakh bales, followed by MNCs purchasing 19 lakh bales, 12 lakh bales stock by mediators and only 3 lakh bales were purchased by the exporters. The functioning of the spinning mills has improved to 80% capacity. The hike in domestic prices during last week can be attributed to weather risk and stocking of cotton by the MNCs and traders.
- The white fly presence on cotton crop was witnessed in Haryana after the spells of rain. Traces have been found in Hisar, Fatehabad, Jind and Bhiwani districts in last two weeks. The next 10 to 12 days are very crucial for this crop. If it rains, the crop would be saved, otherwise the pest may damage up to 50% of cotton or would result in lower yields.




- Cotton harvesting in Punjab especially in Malwa region is likely to be delayed by 15 days from normal schedule
 due to the shortage of farm labour this year. A few areas were affected with excess rains earlier in this month
 and still few regions are struggling to drain out extra water. Farmers have to bring cotton in the mandis with 812% moisture for the best prices, as per specifications of Cotton Corporation of India (CCI).
- According to trade sources, the Indian cotton exports for the July'20 were reported higher by around 5 lakh bales, compared to the prior month as the prices were competitive. Although exports to China declined to around 48,500 bales, Bangladesh remained the largest importer of Indian cotton purchasing around 2.72 lakh bales at an average FOB of \$1.37/kg. Exports to Vietnam (61,600 bales at \$1.22/kg), Turkey (27,800 bales at \$1.19/kg) and Indonesia (24,400 bales at \$1.29/kg) also increased during the month. The other export destinations of India were Oman, Taiwan, and Thailand.


Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot was firm at Rs. 5014/q compared to the prior week that traded lower at Rs. 4846/q.





Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



The arrivals in the month of July increased slightly. The monthly average price was ruling steady to low in July at Rs. 4713/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4754 per quintal during June, and Rs. 6177/quintal during last year in July'19. We expect Kapas prices to remain steady in August due to the lower demand across the country as well as because of increased acreage under cotton amid good rainfall.

Spot Price versus MSP

The prices slightly increased during the week ending on 27th Aug'20 in Gondal. Kapas at Gondal market closed at Rs.4868/q, increased from prior week that stood at Rs. 4718/q. Average price in the week stood low by around Rs. 682.5/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q). The average gap between the spot price and MSP has decreased in the last week.



Lint price Outlook


The average price stood around Rs.3773/maund of lint in Sirsa. The new arrivals of poor quality have started arriving in the market. The average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last week stood firm around Rs.3830 and Rs. 3804/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.

Cotton Fiber price Outlook

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was firm at Rs. 35920 /candy from around Rs. 35340/ candy compared to the previous week. The hike in prices by CCI on cotton sales made the market firm. Average price were around Rs. 42,817 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain firm in range of Rs. 35000-37500 per candy in the coming week candy.





Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake


Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario

The cottonseed oilcake prices were firm during the week ending on 27th Aug'20. The prices in Kadi & Akola stood around Rs. 2128/q and Rs. 2078/q, respectively. The prices were supported due to the demand in the physical market against the lower arrivals. At the same time, there is a very slight improvement in demand for cotton cake last week with respect to the lower arrivals. While NCDEX Cotton seed oil cake futures ended on a weak note on Friday at Rs. 1860/q against Rs. 1991/q in the prior week amid the expectations of higher crop in the coming season. NCDEX Cocudakl is now getting support at 1850 and below same could see a test of 1800 levels, and first resistance is now likely to be seen at 1970.

International Market Scenario

Average International ICE cotton prices stood firm at 64.59 cents/lbs, up by 168 points at 63.04 cents/lbs during the last week. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood strong at 70.95 cents/pound this week, which was at 69.43 cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights:

- U.S. Export Sales were satisfactory from last week. Net UPLAND sales of 1,56,600 RB for 2020-2021 primarily for Vietnam (75,500 RB), China (46,800 RB, including decreases of 1,77,700 RB), Turkey (11,200 RB), Pakistan (7,000 RB, including decreases of 200 RB), and Indonesia (4,800 RB, including 100 RB switched from Japan), and reductions were from Japan (1,100 RB) and Ecuador (400 RB). For 2021-2022, total net UPLAND sales of 7,900 RB were for China.
- Cotton picking in Pakistan is likely to get delayed due to the damage caused to the crop by the rainfall where the initial picking starts during August and September. The current spell of rainfall is estimated to damage around 10% or 2.5-3 lakh cotton bales in Sindh. Actual loss may be calculated after a week or 10 days. According the Pakistani officials, the blowing of wind is a must for the next couple of days to dry the cotton flower. Suffocation may prove to be damaging for the crop, even if it does not rain more.




• Coronavirus has hit hard on the global cotton textile industry. According to the statistics from Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry, the country's yarn exports declined 20.9 per cent from January to July 2020. Fabric exports decreased 40% while export of processed textiles dropped 12.1%. And the Vietnamese textile exports are likely to decline further by 14% in the second half of 2020. The Indian raw cotton exports to Vietnam in the first half of the year (Jan'20- June'20) declined by 33.6% compare to the same period last year.

Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A index was firm in the last week. The Cotlook A Index was at 70.95 cents/lb higher compared to the previous week (69.05 cents/lb).





USA Spot Prices

The cotton spot prices in US has increased to around 63 cents/lbs, up by 2.3% compared to last week. The heavy rainfall associated with the storm tropical storm Marco and Laura did little damage to crop but still needed to be assessed. For the week ending Aug 23, the US crop was rated in 46% good or better condition, up one percentage point compared to the previous week's report. Although, China cancelled some old US cotton but purchased new contract in weekly export sales.

Pakistan Spot Prices

The cotton prices stood firm in Pakistan during last week by around 2% amid lower quality arrivals that was affected with monsoon rains. The picking was also affected with rains. The heavy rainfall has increased the risk of crop damage in the country. Farmers have claimed that around 25% cotton crop is damaged from rains in Sindh. The sowing was already poor as compared to the expectations because of low quality seeds. The rate of cotton in Pakistan stood between Rs. 8680 to Rs. 8780.






