

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 7<sup>th</sup> Sep 2020

## **Domestic market summary**

Domestic market Scenario: Indian physical market likely to remain range bound. The new kapas arrivals have started in few area in North India at the rate of 400-500 bales per day. The arrivals would pick pace in October'20. The kapas prices should increase from October due to the hike in MSP announced by the government earlier. The weather plays an important role at present; as the excess rains have damaged the crop in the main cotton growing belts in Haryana, Punjab, Telangana and Gujarat that could delay the arrivals in the new season, thus, the prices might surge from the present range. Exporters remained active buyers in domestic market. CCI and the Federation have sold around 58 lakh bales from the purchased cotton stock. The Indian cotton exchange front month's prices stood firm, around Rs 36,994 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.36,100 candy during the week.

**Weekly Price Outlook**: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4800-5150/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4750-5000/g.

## Major Market Highlights:

- Traders are waiting for the new the new arrivals. Strong rupee has slightly affected the exports during the week.
- Cotlook index stood at 70.86 cents/lbs and the ICE cotton future also stood slightly weak (64.23 cents/lbs) in last week.
- Daily all India arrival is now 12,000 to 15,000 bales per day.
- Indian Rupee stood strong between 72.86 and 73.61 during this week.

#### **Market Highlights:**

- Cotton has been sown across India in around 128.41 lakh ha as of 27<sup>th</sup> Aug'20 for 2020-21, very close to the total acreage under cotton last year. The cotton sowing in the northern part of India (Punjab, Haryana & Rajasthan) covered an area of 19.36 lakh ha. In Maharashtra, around 42.02 lakh ha and in Gujarat the area under 22.77 lakh ha is covered by cotton sowing, down by -5.2% and -14.7%, respectively compared to last year's total acreage. The area in Andhra Pradesh is still lagging behind by 15.8% covering 5.39 lakh ha as of 27<sup>th</sup> Aug'20. While Telangana has reported the maximum surge of 28.2% (23.85 lakh ha) in area this year because of state government's support to the farmers.
- The agriculture officials have found the presence of Pink Bollworm (PBW) in cotton in Bhatinda, Punjab on around 100 acres so far. It seems to have originated from the empty cotton bolls that were discarded from the



ginning mills after removing fiber that were in close proximity to the cotton fields. Earlier, PBW has appeared in some parts of Maharashtra in Nanded, Parbhani, Vidarbha and Khandesh and Telangana to some extent. The PBW infestation has not yet crossed ETL levels. The pest infestation was observed in the regions where the farmers opted for early planting. However, estimating the extent of damage will have to wait until a clearer picture emerges when the rain stops.

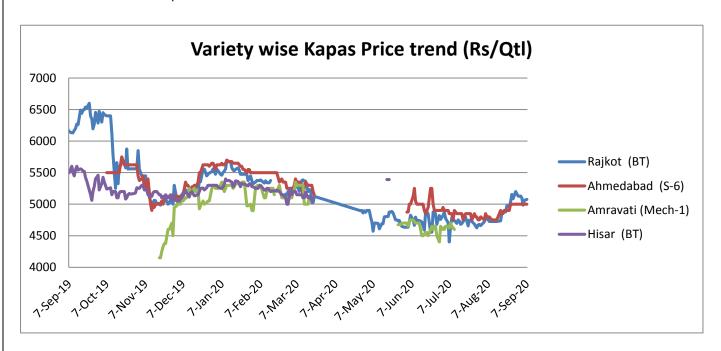
- The cotton belts in Gujarat have received prolonged spell of rain that caused a threat to affect the crop yield.

  Cotton is at the flowering stage and continuous rainfall can cause serious damage in the next stage of the crop growth in boll formation as the crop at this stage needs sunny days. The coming days are very crucial for the good yieldand the continuous rainfall can delay the crop harvesting too.
- The white fly presence on cotton crop was witnessed in Haryana after the spells of rain. Traces have been found initially in Hisar, Sirsa, Fatehabad, Jind and Bhiwani districts in last two weeks of August. According to the market sources, crop in around 15-20 villages in Hisar is likely to get affected by around 10%. Also, the crop damage is witnessed in Sirsa and Fatehabad by around 15% and 20% crop loss, respectively.

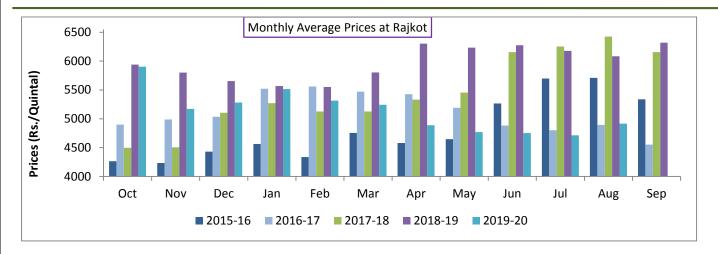
Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

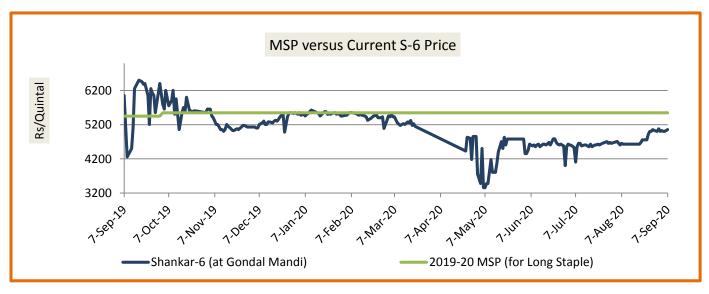
## Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



The arrivals in the month of Aug declined due to the cornering of the season end. The monthly average price was firm in Aug at Rs. 4916/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4713 per quintal during July'20, and Rs. 6083/quintal during last year in Aug'19. Gujarat's farmers have diverted from cotton to grow groundnut so Gujarat cotton sowing reduced to 5% to stay below 23 lakh hectares.

## **Spot Price versus MSP**

The prices slightly increased during the week ending on 3<sup>rd</sup> Sep'20 in Gondal. Kapas at Gondal market closed at Rs.5034/q, increased from prior week that stood at Rs. 4868/q. Average price in the week stood firm by around Rs. 515/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q). The average gap between the spot price and MSP has decreased in the last week.

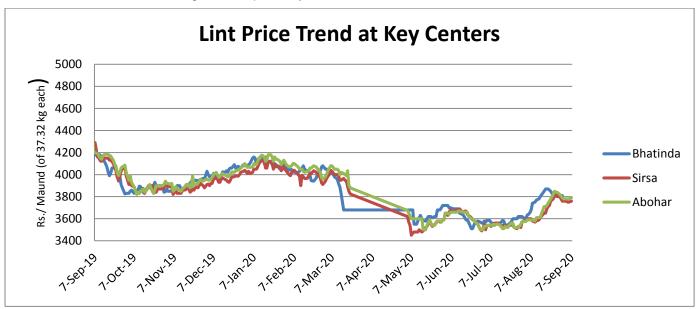

## **Lint price Outlook**

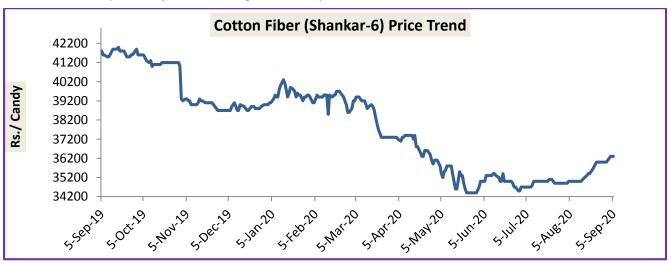
The average price remained steady to low around Rs.3775/maund of lint in Sirsa. The new arrivals of poor quality have started arriving in the market. The average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last week stood firm around Rs.3823 and Rs. 3796/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.

## **Cotton Fiber price Outlook**

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was firm at Rs. 36100 /candy from around Rs. 35920/ candy compared to the previous week. The hike in prices by CCI on cotton sales made the market firm. Average price were around Rs. 42,520 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady in range of Rs. 35000-37500 per candy in the coming week candy.

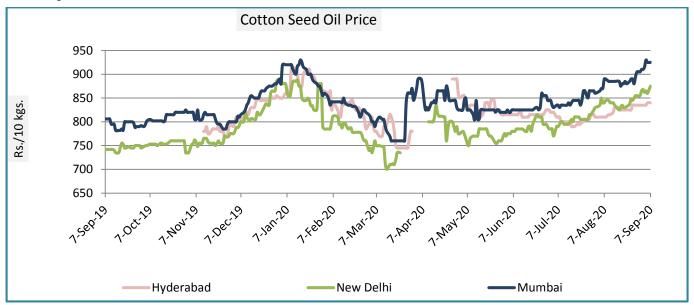

#### Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario

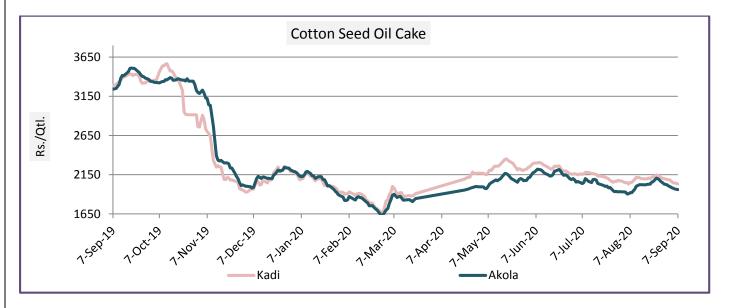
The prices in Kadi were down by 1.92% in Kadi to Rs. 2087/q and down by 3% in Akola to around Rs. 2014/q. The cottonseed oilcake spot prices remained weak in August as the expectation of elevated kapas supplies in the coming season led prices to fall by 1-2% over previous month. Prices may not correct sharply and in fact, are likely to remain under pressure in the near term if the weather remains conducive for the crop. While NCDEX Cotton seed oil cake futures ended on a weak note on Monday at Rs. 1788/q against Rs. 1880/q in the prior week amid the expectations



of higher crop in the coming season. NCDEX Cocudakl is now getting support at 1700 and first resistance is now likely to be seen at 1880.

## **International Market Scenario**

Average International ICE cotton prices stood weak at 64.23 cents/lbs, up by 0.48 points from 64.72 cents/lbs during the last week. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood slightly weaker at 70.86 cents/pound this week, which was at 70.95 cents/pound during last week.

## Major Market Highlights:

• ICE front month futures rose by around 2% in Aug'20 month compared in July'20. The average of ICE July contract stood high around 63.64 cents/lbs in Aug, up by 106 points compared to the average price that stood in July around 62.58 cents/lbs. Hurricane Laura soaked the western half of the Mid-South last week, causing significant crop condition declines in both Louisiana and Arkansas. The market has strengthened based on continued uncertainty about the size of the US crop, good export reports, and increased optimism for US-China trade relations.



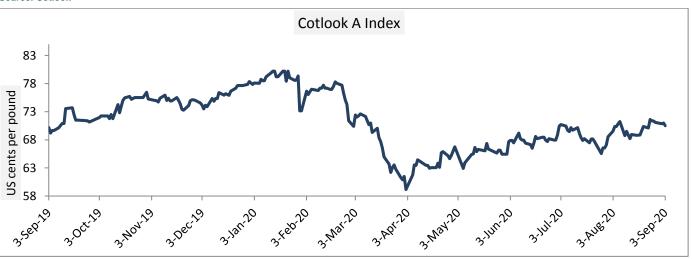
- China cotton yarn imports are estimated to increase by 7.4% to 1.51 LT in Jul'20 compared to the previous month. According to foreign shipment data in June, cotton yarn imports of China from Vietnam in Jul are estimated at 70,400 tonnes followed by India 20,000 tonnes, from Pakistan 25,200 tonnes, Uzbekistan 15,000 tonnes, and from other regions and countries at 20,000 tonnes. It is expected that the demand in August likely to remain stagnant as the operating rate of fabric mills declined. The high inventory and lack of demand may put pressure on yarn prices in the country.
- U.S. Export Sales were good from last week. Net UPLAND sales of 1,31,500 RB for 2020- 2021 primarily for China (61,400 RB, including decreases of 26,400 RB), Vietnam (30,200 RB, including 1,400 RB switched from South Korea, 700 RB switched from Japan, and decreases of 4,900 RB), Turkey (17,000 RB), Pakistan (16,700 RB, including decreases of 200 RB), and Indonesia (3,700 RB, including 3,100 RB switched from Japan), and reductions for Japan (4,000 RB), Taiwan (500 RB), Malaysia (200 RB), and El Salvador (200 RB).

## **Cotlook A Index**

Cotlook A index was firm in the last week. The Cotlook A Index was at 70.95 cents/lb higher compared to the previous week (69.05 cents/lb).

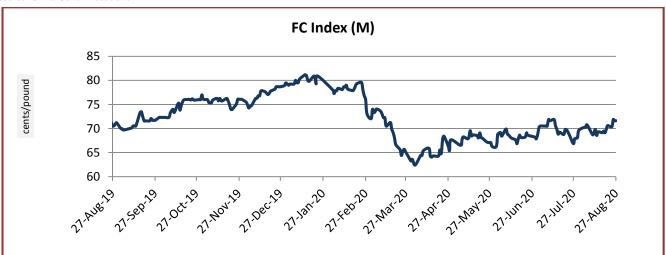

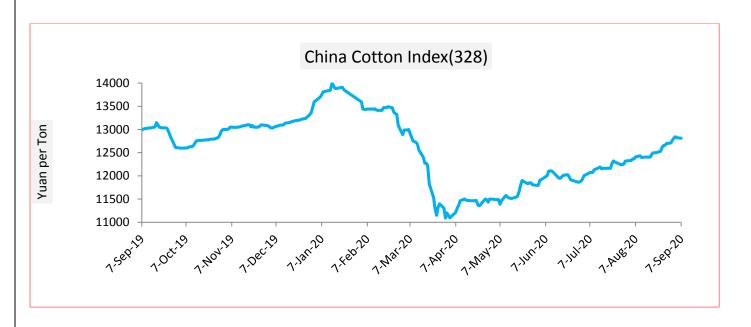

## **USA Spot Prices**

Sales were 174,300 bales including 80,500 bales to Vietnam and a net 49,100 bales to China (232,100 bales in new sales but reductions by 183,000 bales in cancellations). Overall, as of August 30, the crop was 28% poor to very poor and 44% good to excellent. This compares to 25% and 46% respectively for a week earlier. Texas is 42% poor to very poor compared to 37% a week earlier.

## **Pakistan Spot Prices**

The raw cotton prices in Pakistan during the first week of September increased gradually crossing Rs. 9100 per maund (37.32kg). The rain-related disruptions in cotton harvest triggered price hike in the local markets, growers and ginners. The heavy rains declined the supply and the quality of lint declined especially in Sindh. Therefore, the traders shifted their buying from Sindh to Punjab that surged the prices in Punjab. According the Pakistan officials, rainwater affected around 20-22 percent of the standing crops.

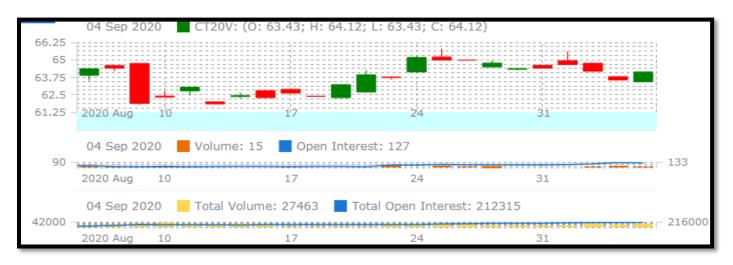

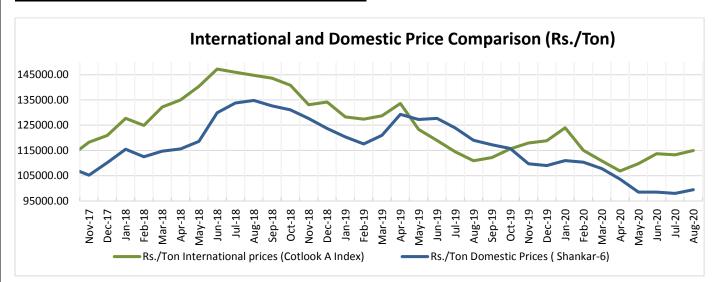
