

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 14th Sep 2020

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: All India daily arrivals increased to around 6,000 bales by the end of second week of Sep'20. If the weather ensures harvesting on time in north zone of India and CCI starts its procurement by the first week of Oct'20, then arrivals by the first week of October should increase to around 20,000 to 30,000 bales per day, otherwise the arrivals would be around 10,000 to 15,000 bales. As rainfall is expected to continue, by IMD in the coming fortnight, especially in Maharashtra, Karnataka, Gujarat (Saurashtra), parts of Madhya Pradesh & Telangana, and coastal AP, the arrivals from the central & South India likely to be delayed by 10-15 days. Telangana is the CCI's largest procurement destination, and if weather favours, CCI will commence procurement on time in the state and then full fledged arrivals could be expected there.. CCI expects that the agency may get a few extra days for exporting more if the arrivals get delayed and could reach to 55 lakh bales in the current season. The Indian cotton exchange front month's prices stood firm, around Rs 36,805 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.36,300 candy during the week.

Weekly Price Outlook : The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4900-5200/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4700-4950/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- Traders are focused on the north zone of the cotton market for new arrivals, as the arrivals are expected to increase from mid- Sep'20.
- Cotlook index stood at 69.99 cents/lbs and the ICE cotton future also stood slightly weak (63.66 cents/lbs) in last week.
- Indian Rupee stood steady between 73.34 and 73.59 during this week.

Market Highlights:

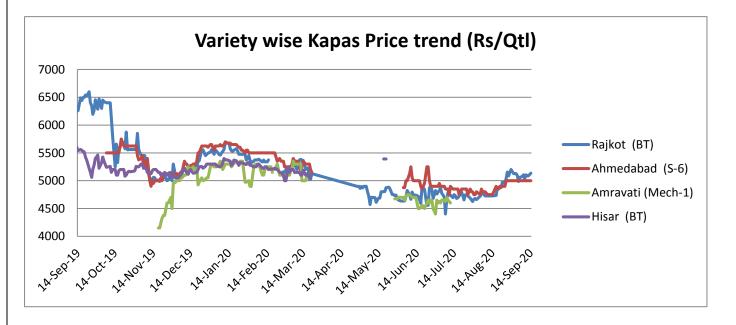
• Cotton has been sown across India in around 129.29 lakh ha as of 10th Aug'20 for 2020-21, up by 0.9% over the acreage under cotton last year. The cotton sowing in the northern part of India (Punjab, Haryana & Rajasthan) covered an area of 19.06 lakh ha. The yield loss is expected in Punjab and Haryana amid continuous rainfall and whitefly attack on the crop. In Maharashtra, around 42.24 lakh ha and in Gujarat the area under 22.79 lakh ha is covered by cotton sowing, down by -4.7% and -14.6%, respectively compared to last year's total acreage. The area in Andhra Pradesh is still lagging behind by 11.9% covering 5.64 lakh ha as of 10th Sep'20 and Telangana has reported the maximum surge of 29.7% (24.13 lakh ha) in area this year.

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- The continuous rains in Abohar, Punjab has damaged around 17,000 ha area under cotton. The standing crop
 is under stagnant water since last week. While the farmers in Haryana's Hisar, Bhiwani, Dadri, Fatehabad, Sirsa
 and Jind districts are worried about white fly attack on the crop, since they were expecting good yields this
 season. According to the market sources, 10% crop loss is expected in around 15-20 villages in Hisar and in Sirsa
 and Fatehabad by around 15% and 20%, respectively. The Haryana government has assured compensation to
 cotton growers in the state who suffer losses by whiteflies or wilting.
- The area under cotton in Gujarat was expected to decline, at the beginning of kharif sowing (in June'20) as
 the farmers were expected to shift to groundnut. Also, it is estimated that the Gujarat ginners have around 11.5 lakh bales of unsold cotton and around 70-75 thousand bales unsold raw cotton is with the farmers. This
 year, area is not likely to cross 24 lakh ha against 26 lakh ha last year. Also, around 50,000-60,000 ha of area in
 Amreli of Saurashtra region, which covers around 15% of total cotton area in the state, was damaged followed
 by 10-15% crop loss in other districts (Jamnagar, Morbi, Surendernagar, Kutch & Sabarkantha).
- Telangana government has assured the farmers that the procurement centers, would be ready by converting
 325 ginning mills by 10th Oct'20 to speed up the procurement process. Government has purchased around
 Rs.11,656 crore worth fiber crop through Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) last year and this year the CCI was advised to be ready to procure more.

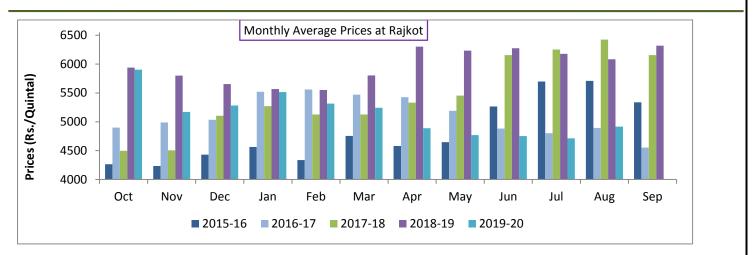
Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot was firm at Rs. 5138/q compared to the prior week that traded lower at Rs. 5014/q. The kapas prices could see a surge in coming days due to delay in arrivals.





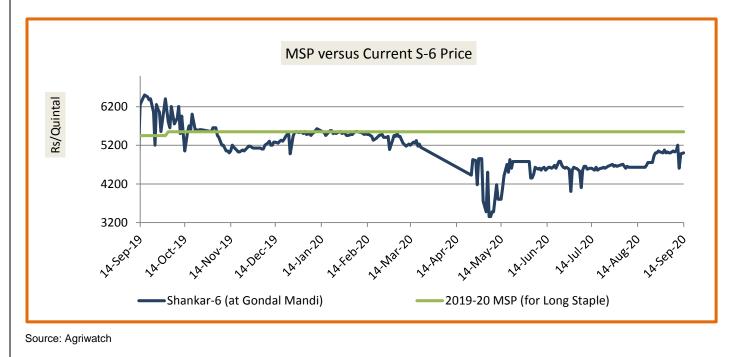
Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



The arrivals in the month of Aug declined due to the cornering of the season end. The monthly average price was firm in Aug at Rs. 4916/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4713 per quintal during July'20, and Rs. 6083/quintal during last year in Aug'19. Gujarat's farmers have diverted from cotton to grow groundnut so Gujarat cotton sowing reduced to 5% to stay below 24 lakh hectares.

Spot Price versus MSP

The prices slightly increased during the week ending on 10th Sep'20 in Gondal. Kapas at Gondal market closed at Rs.5060/q, increased from prior week that stood at Rs. 5035/q. Average price in the week stood firm and the difference from MSP narrowed down by around Rs. 490/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q).

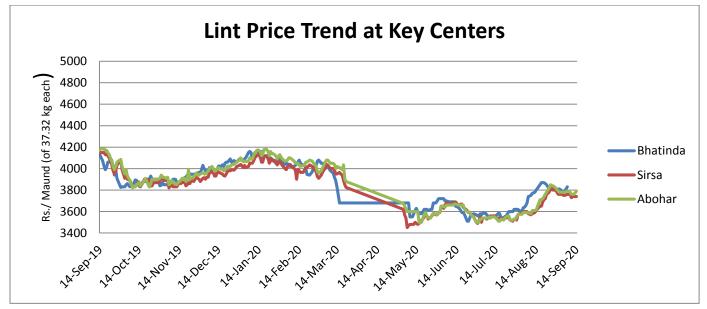




Lint price Outlook

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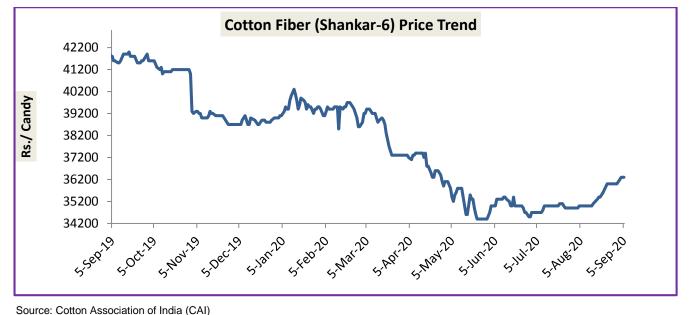
The average price remained steady to low around Rs.3752/maund of lint in Sirsa. The new arrivals of poor quality have started arriving in the market. The average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last week stood firm around Rs.3802 and Rs. 3780/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.

Cotton Fiber price Outlook

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was firm at Rs. 36300 /candy from around Rs. 35920/ candy compared to the previous week amid affect of increase in CCI's sales price. The hike in prices by CCI on cotton sales made the market firm. Average price were around Rs. 41,633 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady in range of Rs. 35000-37500 per candy in the coming week candy.

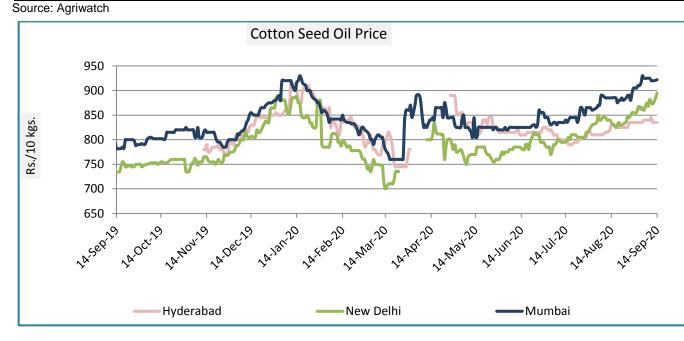


Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake

Cotton seed oil price showed firm trend across all the centres during the week ending on 10th Sep'20. Weekly average price in Hyderabad stood firm at Rs. 842. In Mumbai the prices ranged around Rs. 922 and Rs.872 per 10 Kg in New Delhi.

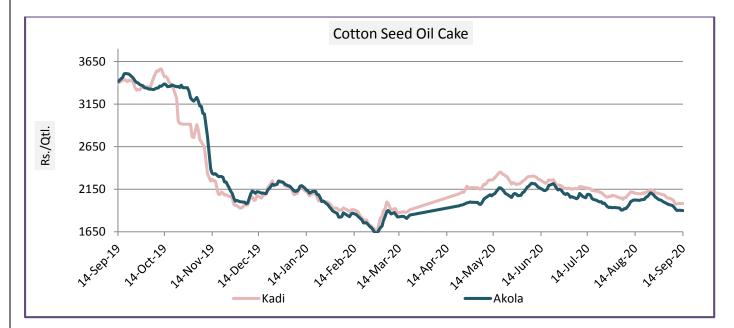


Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario

The prices in Kadi were down by 3.45% in Kadi to Rs. 2015/q and down by 3.46% in Akola to around Rs. 1945/q. The cottonseed oilcake spot prices remained weak in August as the expectation of elevated kapas supplies in the coming season led prices to fall by 1-2% over previous month. Prices may not correct sharply and in fact, are likely to remain under pressure in the near term if the weather remains conducive for the crop. While NCDEX Cotton seed oil cake futures ended on a firm note on Monday at Rs. 1882/q against Rs. 1832/q in the prior week. NCDEX Cocudakl is now getting support at 1860 and first resistance is now likely to be seen at 1911.

International Market Scenario

Average International ICE cotton prices stood weak at 63.66 cents/lbs, up by 0.56 points from 64.22 cents/lbs during the last week given the accelerating tensions between US and China. US has decided to block cotton textile products and tomato imports from Xinjiang over forced labour issues. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood slightly weaker at 69.99 cents/pound this week, which was at 70.86 cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights:

In the latest report released by USDA in Sep'20, decreased the production estimates from 23.14 million bales (170kg per bale) in 2020-21 to 21.84 million bales, -6% compared to the previous estimates reflecting the poor crop health in the cotton belts after storms hit the areas amid hurricane. Along with the 0.7% increase in beginning stocks, the total supply declined to 31.12 million bales, down by 3.8% compared to the previous months' estimates (m-o-m). While, the total demand in the country is expected to decline by 3.3% to 21.91 million bales due to the estimated significant fall in consumption to 3.2 million bales from 3.46 million bales moo-m.

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- China Cotton Association indicated that good weather conditions and adequate rainfall have facilitated plant growth and boll bearing. In most Xinjiang cotton areas, indicated good weather conditions and improved cotton growth compared to last year as of mid-Aug. Favorable temperatures and adequate rainfall in most Xinjiang cotton areas have facilitated plant growth. Although the total planted area reported is 3.12 million ha compared to 3.3 million ha last year but the yield in Xinjiang region is expected to be higher compared in 2019-20. The production is forecasted higher at 34.88 million bales in 2020-21 from 33.99 million bales in Aug'20 estimates, and steady compared to an estimated 34.88 million bales crop in 2019-20 MY. The Chinese State Reserve held the 53rd domestic auction in the 3-month series and all cotton offered each day has been purchased. The 53 days total stands at 462,181 tonnes (around 2,122,800 bales).
- U.S. Export Sales were slightly lower against last week. Net UPLAND sales of 1,26,700 RB for 2020- 2021 primarily for China a (79,100 RB), Vietnam (20,300 RB, including decreases of 600 RB), Thailand (8,700 RB, including 1,300 RB switched from Indonesia), Turkey (8,700 RB, including decreases of 200 RB), and Pakistan (7,300 RB, including decreases of 100 RB), were offset by reductions primarily for Colombia (5,300 RB) and Honduras (3,500 RB).

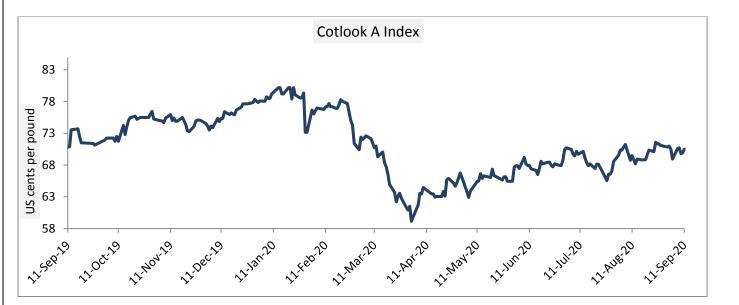
Cotlook A Index

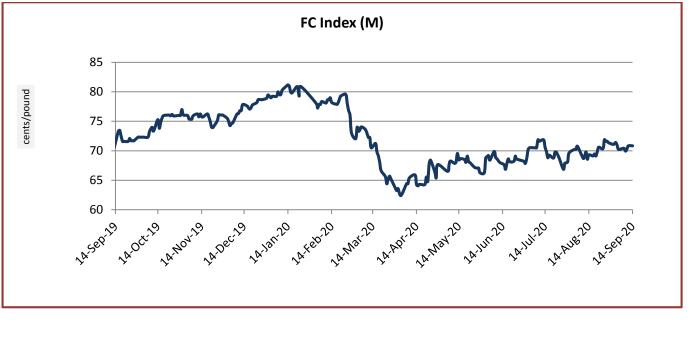

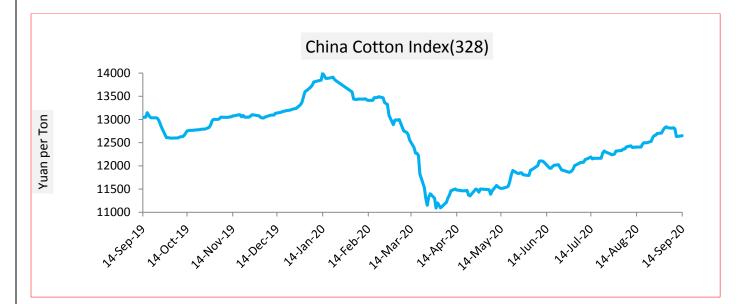

USA Spot Prices

The 2020-21 U.S. cotton production estimates were lowered 1.0 million bales to 17.1 million bales in Sep'20 report, with a lower projection for every region. Exports and ending stocks are also 400,000 bales lower due to reduced U.S. supply and stronger global competition. Ending stocks in 2020-21 were projected at 7.2 million bales. The sales by Brazil to other countries are increasing. Thus, U.S is facing a decline in its share of the world cotton trade.

Pakistan Spot Prices

The raw cotton prices in Pakistan during the second week of September increased gradually. The trading activity has improved after the rains abated and the supply of kapas improved. Picking had also been affected due to rains. The millers have started importing cotton because of the high prices of the local cotton. Also, the sources said that the crop is now prone to whitefly attack as last year major crop was affected by the pests.

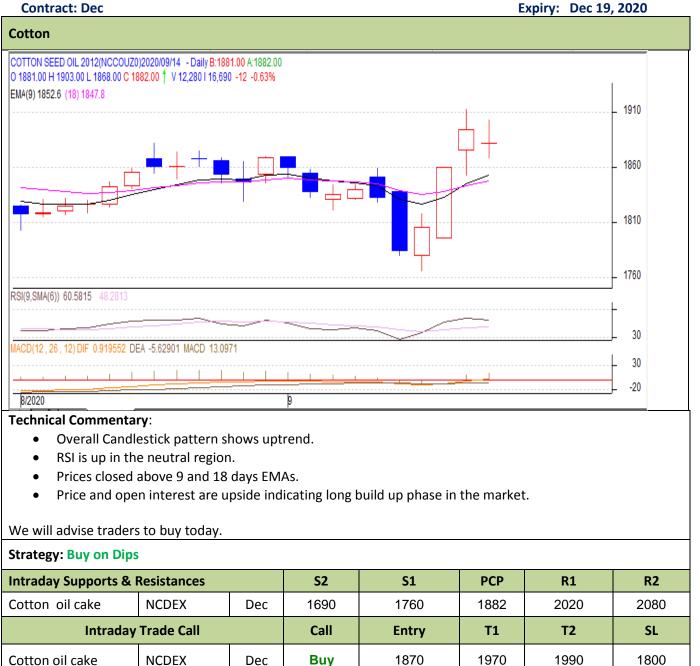

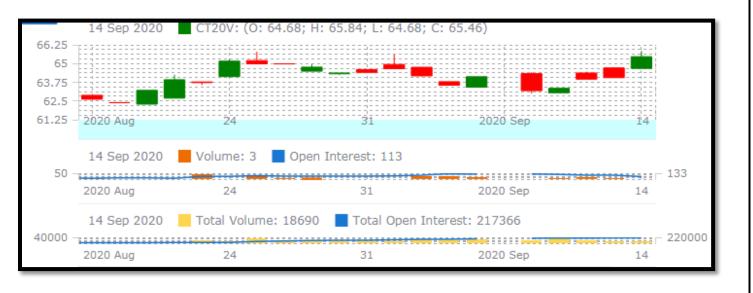

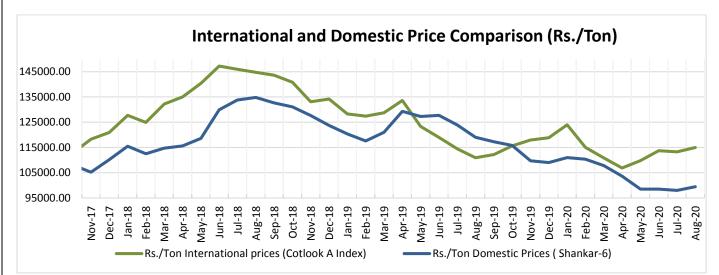
