

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 21st Sep 2020

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: CCI sales declined as the mills already have excesss stock due to the lower demand and only limited stock of quality cotton is available. However, Indian spinning mills are getting good overseas demand for yarn and that has supported the domestic market, during last week. In fact, Chinese exporters are complaining that many of their yarn orders were being switched to India and Pakistan. The delay in arrivals could led to only a slight surge in prices, as there is already excess stock with CCI and mills. The Indian cotton exchange front month's prices stood firm, around Rs 37,563 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.36,100 candy during the week.

Weekly Price Outlook : The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4950-5250/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4700-4950/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- The quality of the new arrivals will improve in the coming days and the arrivals from few regions might be delayed due to the heavy rainfall.
- Cotlook index stood firm at 71.28 cents/lbs and the ICE cotton future also stood slightly firm (64.85 cents/lbs) in last week.
- Indian Rupee stood steady between 73.44 and 73.65during this week.

Market Highlights:

- Cotton has been sown across India in around 129.47 lakh ha as of 17th Sep'20 for 2020-21, up by 1% to the total acreage under cotton last year. The yield loss is expected in Punjab and Haryana amid continuous rainfall and whitefly attack on the crop. In Maharashtra, around 42.25 lakh ha and in Gujarat the area under 22.79 lakh ha is covered by cotton sowing, down by -4.6% and -14.6%, respectively compared to last year's total acreage. The area in Andhra Pradesh is still lagging behind by 12% covering 5.64 lakh ha as of 17th Sep'20 and Telangana has reported the maximum surge of 29.7% (24.13 lakh ha) in area this year. The sowing across India has almost finished.
- The hike in raw cotton MSP for the 2020-21 season by the government would eventually result in an increase in the production cost of cotton lint, for the ginning mills. If the ginner sells cotton at higher prices to spinning mills, the cost of yarn production would increase. Hence, the entire chain of the cotton industry would incur a higher cost of production. The demand for cotton and its by-products is already lower in the domestic and

international markets. The higher price of yarn, fabrics and garments would discourage the Indian exports. Also, CCI's cotton selling policy is very uncertain because of no specification in the price and timing of cotton sales in the market. The whole cotton industry is unable to make long-term business commitments regarding exports.


As the advancement of rainfall in Maharashtra, Karnataka, Gujarat (Saurashtra), few areas in Madhya Pradesh & Telangana, and coastal AP is expected by IMD in the coming 2 weeks, therefore, the arrivals from the central & South India likely to be delayed by 10-15 days in Oct'20. Telangana is the CCI's largest procurement destination, and if weather favours, CCI could commence procurement on time in the state then full-fledged arrivals could be expected. CCI expects that the agency would get extra days for exporting more if the arrivals get delayed and could reach to 55 lakh bales in the current season.


Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot was firm at Rs. 5120/q compared to the prior week that traded lower at Rs. 5060/q. The kapas prices could see a surge in coming days due to delay in arrivals in Saurashtra region.






Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



The arrivals in the month of Aug declined being the end of the season. The monthly average price was firm in Aug at Rs. 4916/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4713 per quintal during July'20, and Rs. 6083/quintal during last year in Aug'19. Gujarat's farmers have diverted from cotton to grow groundnut so Gujarat cotton sowing reduced to 5% to stay below 24 lakh hectares.

Spot Price versus MSP


The prices declined during the week ending on 17th Sep'20 in Gondal. Kapas at Gondal market closed at Rs.4984/q, increased from prior week that stood at Rs. 5060/q. Average price in the week stood weak and the difference from MSP narrowed down by around Rs. 565/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q).





Lint price Outlook


The average price remained steady around Rs.3760/maund of lint in Sirsa. The commencement of new arrivals led to decline in prices this week in Punjab due to low quality and high moisture levels. While the average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last week stood steady around Rs.3830 and Rs. 3803/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.

Cotton Fiber price Outlook

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was firm at Rs. 36680/candy from around Rs. 36300/ candy compared to the previous week. The higher stock available with CCI and the upcoming new arrivals might not drag prices to rise. Average prices were around Rs. 41,860 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady in range of Rs. 35500-37500 per candy in the coming week candy.




Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake

Cotton seed oil price showed firm trend across all the centres during the week ending on 17th Sep'20. Weekly average price in Hyderabad stood firm at Rs. 948. In Mumbai the prices ranged around Rs. 945 and Rs.919 per 10 Kg in New Delhi.

Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario


The spot prices in Kadi were down by 1.65% in Kadi to Rs. 1982/q and down by 0.86% in Akola to around Rs. 1928/q. There is good availability of green fodder in the market amid good amount rainfall this year, therefore, weighing on the cottonseed oilcake prices. Although the prices could see some rise by the November month due to the expectation of good demand as the winter season arrives. While NCDEX Cotton seed oil cake futures ended on a weak note on Friday at Rs. 1816/q against Rs. 1894/q in the prior week. NCDEX Cocudakl is now getting support at 1795 and first resistance is now likely to be seen at 1884.

International Market Scenario

Average International ICE cotton prices stood firm at 64.85 cents/lbs, up by 1.19 points from 63.66 cents/lbs during the last week. The weather across US was not conducive to the crop growth. The crops in Florida, southern Alabama and Georgia suffered significant damage amid heavy rains. Cotlook A index weekly average stood slightly firm at 71.99 cents/pound this week, which was at 69.99 cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights:

U.S. Export Sales showed significant high sales compared to last week. Net UPLAND sales of 5,19,600 RB for 2020- 2021 primarily for China (4,40,100 RB including 1,500 RB switched from Taiwan and decreases of 2,300 RB), Mexico (20,000 RB), Pakistan (17,600 RB), Vietnam (11,300 RB, including 1,300 RB switched from South Korea), and Turkey (7,800 RB), and there were reductions in slae for Japan (1,100 RB) and South Korea (500 RB).


- The US retail apparel sales contracted this year according to the news sources, comparatively Chinese apparel sales were more than 93% of the US sales level in the first nine months of 2020. Chinese total retail sales in August was 492.1 billion USD, which is around 90% of the US level in August. August sales were up 5% from a year ago in China. According to one of the consulting agency forecast in US, the retail sales in US would end down 20-30% for the year, and sales in 2021 would remain weak, declining 10% to 25% from 2019 levels. In this view, China can overtake the US apparel market sales by the coming year.
- The Brazilian cotton started flowing in the market and the new crop is expected to fulfill export orders in the Asian markets by late October and November. Both Brazilian and Indian cotton is expected to arrive in the market at the same time. Spinners have recently moved to focus on Brazilian and US for contamination improvement and better contract performance. But the improved quality of the CCI offers in India could compete over Brazil in the interests of Chinese mills.

Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A index was firm in the last week. The Cotlook A Index was at 71.28 cents/lb higher compared to the previous week (69.99 cents/lb).










USA Spot Prices

The net export sales were much higher in the report, released last week. China was the major buyer importing around 4 lakh US bales, accounting for around 82% of new sales. The crop damages were reported in the Mid-South that previously gotten hit with Laura and, while the Southeast had so far not been affected, the crop in some places was 50% or more open and vulnerable.

The local textile mills in Pakistan have increased the cotton imports in the view of lower crop in 2020-21. TThe raw cotton prices in Pakistan during the second week of September increased gradually. He quality of kapas has improved slightly after the rains. According to the statistics released by Pakistan Cotton Ginners Association till September 15, major reduction of 8 lakh bales (44.22%) in cotton production in 2020-21 was witnessed as compared to last year production during this year.




