

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 28<sup>th</sup> Sep 2020

## **Domestic market summary**

**Domestic market Scenario**: The cotton arrivals from Gujarat (Saurashtra), Maharashtra (Vidarbha, Khandesh region), and Telangana are likely to get delayed by 10-15 days due to the continuous rainfall. During the period, the sale of old stock would continue in the market, supporting the prices. The cotton prices recovered to around Rs.36,500-Rs.37,000 per candy from Rs. 31,000 per candy in April. The good demand from the exporters and cotton yarn makers also from the reviving of the domestic mills, have supported the prices. According to All Gujarat Spinner's Association (AGSA), yarn exports rose 10% in the past 2 months and the yarn prices surged to Rs.186 per kg from Rs.160-162 per kg during the lockdown. The Indian cotton exchange front month's prices stood firm, around Rs 37,676 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.36,200 candy during the week.

**Weekly Price Outlook**: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4950-5250/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4650-4900/g.

#### Major Market Highlights:

- Indian cotton yarn is in full demand so now mills are operating closer to optimum capacity.
- Cotlook index stood firm at 70.85 cents/lbs and the ICE cotton future also stood slightly firm (63.89 cents/lbs) in last week.
- Indian Rupee stood steady between 73.47 and 73.89 during this week.

#### Market Highlights:

- The Haryana State government has announced that the cotton procurement would start from 1<sup>st</sup> Oct'20 at MSP through CCI (Cotton Corporation of India). The state announced that the number of procurement centers would be increased to 40 this time while only 20 centers were active last year. Last year, only 30 per cent of the total crop was procured by CCI but during 2020-21, the government assured that 100 per cent of the total arrivals will be procured.
- The arrivals across North India have started with around 6500 bales, which is expected to increase to 12,000 bales, in the coming week. As there is 13-15% moisture content in the raw cotton, the prices are hovering below MSP including in Madhya Pradesh where prices are around Rs.4000-4300/q. CCI is expected to start procurement in the north from 1<sup>st</sup> Oct'20. Similarly, the new arrivals in Gujarat and Maharashtra are sluggish amid heavy rainfall and the arrivals are likely to pick pace only after 2<sup>nd</sup> week of October. The arrivals in South zone (Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu) are slowly arriving in the market and likely to increase from 10<sup>th</sup> October.




- According to the first advance estimate released by the Agriculture Ministry, cotton production is estimated to be at 371.2 lakh bales (of 170kg each), higher by 16.3 lakh bales than the 354.91 lakh bales during 2019-20. The estimated production may fall because of heavy rainfall led crop damage in Punjab, Haryana, Gujarat and Maharashtra.
- According to the sources, the cotton crop in Khandesh region have been affected due to the excess rainfall.
   The crop planted in late May / early June has been most affected. The cotton bolls for first picking in Dhule,
   Jalgaona and Nandurbar (which covers 8.5 lakh ha area under cotton) were reported rotted. Also, in the further pickings, the quality of fibre likely to decline.
- The new cotton has started arriving in the Malwa region (Bhatinda and Mansa) of Punjab. The farmers are getting very low prices at around Rs.4600/q (MSP is Rs. 5825/q). The mandi officers have recommended the farmers to bring cotton from 1<sup>st</sup> Oct'20 when CCI begins the procurement and that they ensure that their produce contains between 8 to 12% moisture content to get remunerative prices.


#### Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

**Weekly Price Review:** Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot was slightly weak at Rs. 5020/q compared to the prior week that traded lower at Rs. 5120/q. The heavy rainfall in the Saurashtra region would likely to delay the arrivals as the cotton needs to be dried before selling the produce in the market for better realization.






#### **Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario**



The arrivals in the month of Aug declined due to the cornering of the season end. The monthly average price was firm in Aug at Rs. 4916/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4713 per quintal during July'20, and Rs. 6083/quintal during last year in Aug'19. Gujarat's farmers have diverted from cotton to grow groundnut so Gujarat cotton sowing reduced to 5% to stay below 24 lakh hectares.

#### **Spot Price versus MSP**

The prices declined during the week ending on 24<sup>th</sup> Sep'20 in Gondal. Average kapas price at Gondal market was Rs.5030/q, increased from prior week that stood at Rs. 4984/q. Average price in the week stood weak and the difference from MSP narrowed down by around Rs. 519/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q).



#### **Lint price Outlook**


The average price stood range bound around Rs.3770/maund of lint in Sirsa. The new arrivals in Punjab and Haryana has started and the prices showed mixed trend due to the arrival of cotton with varying moisture levels. While the average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last week stood steady around Rs.3790 and Rs. 3770/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.

#### **Cotton Fiber price Outlook**

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was firm at Rs. 36850/candy from around Rs. 36680/candy compared to the previous week. The good export demand for Indian cotton supported the market continuously since last two weeks. Average price were around Rs. 41,700 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady in range of Rs. 36000-37200 per candy in the coming week candy.


# **Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake**

#### **Cotton Seed Oil weekly Price Scenario**

Cotton seed oil price showed firm trend across all the centres during the week ending on 24<sup>th</sup> Sep'20. Weekly average price in Hyderabad stood firm at Rs. 976. In Mumbai the prices ranged around Rs. 988 and Rs.948 per 10 Kg in New Delhi.


#### **Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario**

The spot prices in Kadi were down by 3% to Rs. 1908/q while the prices were up by 1.36% in Akola to Rs. 1954/q. The prices in the upcoming season are likely to remain steady to weak during October due to the weak demand and as the old stock is being traded. While the prices are expected to increase slightly as the demand increases during November and December but the expectation of higher crop in 2020-21 would not support the prices to remain firm for long term. While NCDEX Cotton seed oil cake futures ended on a weak note on Friday at Rs. 1808/q against Rs. 1868/q in the prior week. NCDEX Cocudakl is now getting support at 1790 and first resistance is now likely to be seen at 1911.

#### <u>International Market Scenario</u>

Average International ICE cotton prices stood at 63.89 cents/lbs, down by 0.95 points from 64.85 cents/lbs during the last week. The US export sales were significantly down during last week especially the imports by China declined during the same time. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood slightly weaker at 70.85 cents/pound this week, which was at 71.28 cents/pound during last week.

#### **Major Market Highlights:**

- Pakistan is facing shortage of cotton but with the increasing number of cases of coronavirus in India, the international demand is shifting towards Pakistanleading to a rise of 30% in raw cotton import, since July 2020. The pandemic has affected the textile industries in India and Bangladesh, therefore, the Pakistani producers are seeing sudden rise in garment export orders from European and American markets. But the challenge to the country is to combat the shortage of raw material, especially yarn.
- U.S. Export Sales showed lower sales compared to last week. Net UPLAND sales of 92,700 RB for 2020- 2021
   down by 82 per cent from the previous week. The sales were primarily for Vietnam (53,500 RB, including 2,400




RB switched from Japan), China (39,500 RB), Indonesia (26,200 RB, including 3,800 RB switched from Japan), Hong Kong (13,200 RB), and Pakistan (8,900 RB), and reductions were primarily for Mexico (49,200 RB).

#### **Cotlook A Index**

Cotlook A index was weak in the last week. The Cotlook A Index was at 70.85 cents/lb lower compared to the previous week (71.28 cents/lb).








#### **USA Spot Prices**

The crop in the Mid-south US were nearly ready for harvest but received rainfall, which is not positive for either yield or quality. The Mid-south is expected to see more rain in the coming week; Texas, Oklahoma, and Kansas are currently expected to see favourable weather. The crop progress as on 22<sup>nd</sup> Sep'20 was unchanged from the prior week. The crop was 27% poor to very poor and 45% good to excellent. The Texas crop was 41% poor to very poor and 30% good to excellent.

## **Pakistan Spot Prices**

The prices continued to rise due to the significant decline in production. It is expected that around 45 lakh bales of cotton would be imported this year but around cotton of 15 lakh bales has been contracted so far. The rains caused significant damage to the cotton crop, especially in Sindh province due to which quality and quantity both were affected.



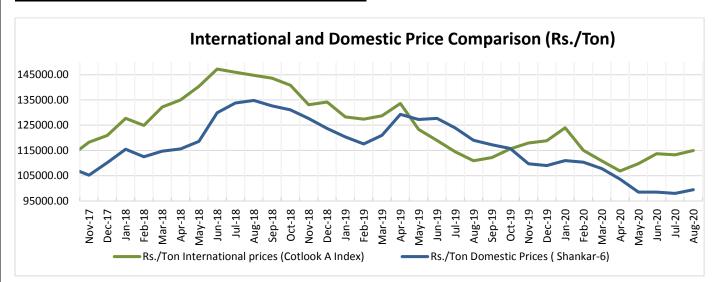
