

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 5th Sep 2020

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: CCI has started procuring cotton in North India (Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan) from 1st Oct'20while, the arrivals in Central and South India are likely to pick up in second half of October. Due to the hike in MSP, the raw cotton prices are expected to rise and accordingly lint prices also this season (2020-21). However, CCI cotton sales were weaker as the demand declined. The Indian cotton exchange front month's prices stood firm, around Rs 39,498 per candy. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.36,750 candy during the week.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain between Rs. 4950-5250/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4650-4900/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- Indian cotton yarn demand is good so now mills are trying to operate at optimum capacity.
- Cotlook index stood firm at 70.85 cents/lbs and the ICE cotton future also stood slightly firm (63.89 cents/lbs)
 in last week.
- Indian Rupee stood steady between 73.47 and 73.89 during this week.

Market Highlights:

- CCI claims that the agency has sold around 57 lakh bales of cotton from the total of 114 lakh bales cotton procured during 2019-20. The heavy discounts given by CCI earlier during late July and August helped liquidate around 50% stocks. The procurement for 2020-21 season is likely to be delayed, except in North India (Punjab & Haryana) by at least 15 days as the recent rains have caused increase in moisture content in the produce. However, the moisture retained in the soil due to the recent rains would provide good growth in the later cotton pickings.
- The Maharashtra state government has urged the administration to begin the farmer's registration at cotton procurement centres from 1st Oct'20 onwards and the procurement would start from 15th Oct'20. The CCI as well as the Maharashtra Cotton Federations assured that there will be procurement at MSP. Earlier this year, around 40 lakh the farmers were forced to sell their produce to the private traders at lower prices as CCI was non-operational during the lockdown.
- The spinning mills in Andhra Pradesh have been facing shortage of labour as many migrant workers from Odisha have returned to their homes. There are around 72 spinning mills in the state which engage more than




1 lakh labours and the mills are facing around 30% shortage of labour. Andhra Pradesh has reduced the cotton sowing for 2020-21 season due to the weak demand of cotton and yarn in the domestic as well as in the international market that was hit by the pandemic this year. The major importing country, China stopped cotton yarn imports from India; one of the reasons for lack of demand for cotton yarn. However, the yarn demand has increased in the last few days.

• According to the trade sources, India in August'20 would likely to have exported cotton significantly higher at about 7-8 lakh bales. Bangladesh has imported the majority of around 6-7 lakh bales in Aug'20 at an average FOB of \$1.39/kg. China was also a major importing country after Bangladesh buying around 55,000 bales at \$1.33/kg FOB followed by Vietnam (39,000 bales at \$1.29/kg), Oman (9,800 bales at \$1.39/kg) and Turkey (6,300 bales at \$1.36/kg). Indian exports likely to continue with good pace in September due to the increasing yarn and garments demand in China. Bangladesh followed by Vietnam being the hub of garments and fabrics exporters would seek Indian raw material to fulfill the demand.


Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot was slightly weak at Rs. 4977/q compared to the prior week that traded lower at Rs. 5020/q. The heavy rainfall in the Saurashtra region would likely to delay the arrivals as the cotton needs to be dried before selling the produce in the market for better realization.






Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



The arrivals in the month of Sep increased as the new arrivals has started flowing in the market. The monthly average price was firm in Aug at Rs. 5058/q compared to the prices during the corresponding month of the previous season due to the lower demand this year. Monthly average price of Kapas at Rajkot remained Rs. 4916 per quintal during Aug'20, and Rs. 6319/quintal during last year in Sep'19. Gujarat's farmers have diverted from cotton to grow groundnut so Gujarat cotton sowing reduced the acreage under cotton.

Spot Price versus MSP

The prices declined during the week ending 1st Oct'20 in Gondal. Average kapas price at Gondal market was Rs.4967/q, decreased from prior week that stood at Rs. 5030/q. Average price in the week stood weak and the difference from MSP narrowed down by around Rs. 582/q from MSP (Rs.5550/q).



Lint price Outlook


The average price stood range bound around Rs.3831/maund of lint in Sirsa. The new arrivals in Punjab and Haryana has started and the prices showed mixed trend due to the arrival of cotton with varying moisture levels. While the average price in Bhatinda and Abohar in the last week stood firm around Rs.3840 and Rs. 3834/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.

Cotton Fiber price Outlook

The average cotton fiber (Shankar-6) of premium quality prices was firm at Rs. 37200/candy from around Rs. 36850/candy compared to the previous week. The good export demand for Indian cotton has supported the market continuously for last two weeks. Average prices were around Rs. 41,650 per candy last year duing the same time. We expect cotton fiber to remain steady in range of Rs. 36500-38500 per candy in the coming week.


Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake

Cotton Seed Oil weekly Price Scenario

Cotton seed oil price showed weak trend across all the centres during the week ending on 1st Oct'20. Weekly average price in Hyderabad stood firm at Rs. 937. In Mumbai the prices ranged around Rs. 958 and Rs.925 per 10 Kg in New Delhi.


Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly Price Scenario

The spot prices in Kadi were down by 4% to Rs. 1827/q while the prices were up by 1% in Akola to around Rs. 1935/q. The demand for cottonseed oilcake is very weak as there is good availability of green fodder in the market owing to the good monsoon this year, therefore, weighing on the cottonseed oilcake prices. Also, farmers have been stocking the harvested cotton without selling awaiting for Cotton Corporation of India to start the procurement. Under such circumstances, the old cottonseed oilcake stock is being traded in the market, thus, reduction in the old stock.

International Market Scenario

Average International ICE cotton prices stood at 64.41 cents/lbs, down by 0.52 points from 63.89 cents/lbs during the last week. The US export sales were significantly up especially with the increased Chinese yarn demand. Also Cotlook A index weekly average stood slightly weaker at 71.14 cents/pound this week, which was at 70.85 cents/pound during last week.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Chinese State Reserve sales in the last 66 days total to 2,292,098 bales. This series of sales ended on September 30th, with a sales target of about 2,296,500 bales. The largest cotton growing region Xinjiang has started harvesting cotton and large scale arrival is likely to pick up during October. According to the China Agriculture department, the country is expected to have to bumper production in 2020-21 season.
- Pakistan is facing shortage of cotton but the increasing number of cases of coronavirus in India, is shifting the international yarn market towards Pakistan. However, due to the shortage of cotton in Pakistan, there has been a rise in raw cotton import, which has grown by 30 percent on month on month basis since July 2020. The



pandemic has affected the textile industries in India and Bangladesh, therefore, the sudden rise in garment export orders were reported as the neighboring countries are not able to produce and deliver goods to European and American markets on time. But the challenge to the country is to combat the shortage of raw material, especially yarn.


• U.S. Export Sales were noticeably up compared to last week and up 7 percent from the prior 4-week average. Net UPLAND sales of 2,33,800 RB for 2020- 2021. Increases were primarily for Turkey (62,500 RB), China (55,700 RB), Vietnam (41,100 RB), Mexico (24,300 RB), and Indonesia (13,400 RB, including decreases of 4,300 RB). For 2021-2022, net sales of 20,600 RB were for Mexico (16,300 RB) and Indonesia (4,300 RB).

Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A index was weak in the last week. The Cotlook A Index was at 71.14 cents/lb lower compared to the previous week (70.85 cents/lb).





Pakistan Spot Prices

According to Pakistan Cotton Ginners Association, 19 lakh bales were produced in the country until October 1, which was 10.26 lakh bales less as compared to last year's production of 29 lakh bales. This year fewer ginning factories have started ginning as compared to last season. It is expected that around 45 lakh bales of cotton would be imported this year but only around cotton of 17 lakh bales has been contracted so far. The rains caused significant damage to the cotton crop, especially in Sindh province due to which quality and quantity both were affected.




