

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 30thNov 2020

Domestic market summary

Domestic market Scenario: CCI procurement operations of seed cotton under MSP are going smoothly in the states of Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and Karnataka. Indian kapas rate are now near to MSP. Till date CCI has procured nearly 26 lakh bales. About 293 new ginning and spinning mills have started operating in Telangana. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.41,250per candy during the week.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 5850-6010/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4530-5000/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- All India daily arrivals have reached around 2,70,000 to 3,00,000 bales per day.
- Cotlook index stood higher (78.95cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 74.06 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee remained stronger between 73.88 to 74.10 against USD compared to last week.

Market Highlights:


- According to Cotton Association of India, the raw cotton prices have increased about 25% to Rs 5,000-6,000 per quintal in last 2 months. The daily arrivals have also increased to about 310,000 bales, which is the highest in a decade. Total arrivals in the market have reached about 7 million bales.CCI has also been procuring at MSP in 10 states, which has led to an increase in cotton seed prices.
- Cotton farmers in Adilabad suffer losses due to Pink bollworm attack and are removing or burning their damaged cotton crop Farmers are requesting the state government to conduct a survey, assess crop damage and pay compensation to them as not all farmers have received their insurance money for their damaged crop earlier.
- Due to heavy rains in October month, the staple size of cotton is less than norma, leading to lower prices. The unprecedented rains have adversely affected the cotton cultivation. Earlier CCI was offering Rs 5,825 per quintal for BunnyBrahma mode staple size cotton between 29.5 30.5 mm. Due to heavy rains the staple size remained below 29.5 mm, the farmers are now expecting prices around Rs 5,775 per quintal.
- Cyclonic rains submerge 13,000 ha of standing crop. Cotton and various other crops are damaged due to the rains caused by cyclone Nivar in Guntur district. If the rains continue for more days the yield will be affected. The farmers will have to face heavy loss due to the crop damage.





Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



Spot Price versus MSP


Average kapas price at Gondal market was Rs.5930/q,higher from prior week when it stood at Rs. 5825/q.

Lint price Outlook

The average price stood firm at Rs.4384/maund of lint in Abohar. The procurement by CCI has increased and it has been purchasing the raw cotton at MSP from the farmers. While the average price in Bhatinda and Sirsa in the last week stood firm around Rs.4382 and Rs. 4304/maund of 37.32 kg each respectively.


Price Scenario






Cotton Seed Oil Cake weeklyPrice Scenario

Due to decrease in cotton production for current season in gujarat,maharashtra and telangana,the cotton seed oil prices are likely to increase about Rs 4000 per quintal till the end of this season,current market price for cotton seed is Rs 2650 per quintal, where else cotton seed oil cake prices will increase about Rs 3500 per quintal from Rs 2500 per quintal. The demand for cotton oil cake will remain stable in the coming week. According to cotton corporation of India cotton seed prices have increased about Rs 50 per quintal in Haryana where else cotton seed oil cake prices remained stable. The average price in Kadi and Akola remained firm at Rs. 2063/q.

International Market Scenario

Major Market Highlights:


- According to USDA October report,2020-21 world cotton supply and demand report shows lower production ,higher consumption and trade, and lower ending stocks compared with last month production is lowered more than 1 million bale(1 bale equivalent to170 kgs) with decline in Mali, Pakistan and Greece offsetting a large expected crop in Uzbekistan and Nigeria. Consumption is 1.95 million bales higher, after revision for China and India. World ending stock in 2020-21 is now projected 3.47 million bales lower than in September at 129.45 million bales.
- Major cotton growing districts in south Punjab of Pakistan are facing critical decline in production as more than 50% crop has been damaged. According to the estimates released by the Cotton Crop Assessment Committee meeting in Pakistan, the cotton production during the current season will be at 8.59 million bales against the target of 10.89 million bales. Also, the textile sector has urged the government to allow duty-free cotton yarn to reduce the cost of production and could help in surge in the country's exports.

Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A index was higher in the last week. The Cotlook A Index was at 79.13 cents/lb higher compared to the previous week (77.50 cents/lb).








USA Spot Prices

U.S. Export Sales was lower but shipments were better. Net upland sales of 1,15,600 RB for 2020- 2021 were down 60 percent from the previous week and 42 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases primarily for China, Pakistan (25,200 RB), Turkey (22,500 RB), South Korea (16,600 RB), and Guatemala (15,900 RB), and the major reductions were primarily from Bangladesh (44,100 RB) and Mexico (10,100 RB). Till 8th November, 61% of the cotton have been harvested in US, up by 2% points compared to last year during the same time and higher by 4% points from 5- year average.




Pakistan Spot Prices

We will advise traders to wait.






