

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 7<sup>th</sup> Dec 2020

#### **Domestic market summary**

• **Domestic marketScenario**:CCI procurement operations are going on at MSP in various states and has purchased around 34 lakh bales of cotton, so far.Indian exports remained slow duringlast week. Gujarat Shankar-6 variety cotton spot prices stood firm around Rs.41,250 per candy during the week.

**Weekly Price Outlook** :The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 5736-6010/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh likely to hover around Rs.4550-5000/q.

#### Major Market Highlights:

- All India daily arrivals have reached around 2,50,000 to 3,00,000 bales per day.
- Cotlook index stood higher(79.80cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 72.15 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee remained stronger between 73.68to 74.05 against USD compared to last week.

#### Market Highlights:

- Cotton prices increased after cyclonic rains in Guntur district of Andhra Pradesh.Due to floods and cyclones in recent months, the demand for quality cotton has increased in the market. The exporters and traders are offering better price for cotton in the open market. Cotton prices in the open market have jumped to Rs 5,250 per quintal from Rs 4,500 per quintal. With increase in prices in the open market, farmers are now started selling their cotton stock in the open market.
- Cotton exports are likely to jump 40% in 2020-21 to 7 million bales, which is the highest in seven years, as depreciation of the rupee and a rally in global prices have allowed exporters to clinch contracts. India did export around 50 lakh bales in the previous season but yarn exports however declined, as India faced duty challenges in export market. Countries like Pakistan and Bangladesh levy higher rates of duty on Indian yarn, while they enjoy duty free or concessional duty access in India and developed countries.
- The government has transferred Rs 6,314 crore to farmers after procuring Cotton valued at over Rs 7,500 crore, thereby benefiting 5 Lakh farmers, under CCI recently approved Production linked incentives to the textile sector.
- The Regional Agricultural Research Station, Warangal has advised cotton farmers to go for early harvest to avoid crop infestation by pink bollworm, which has become prevalent in certain parts of the state due to ongoing cold weather. The farmers have been advised to use insecticides if the infestation is moderate and destruction of the stubble if the chemicals fail to yield expected results.





According to Cotton Corporation of India, CottonSeed prices have increased about Rs 50 per quintal in Haryana butcotton seed oil cake prices have remained stable. Due to decrease in cotton production in the current season in Gujarat,Maharashtra and Telangana, the CottonSeedOil prices are likely to increase to about Rs 4000 per quintal by the end of this season, Current prices for cotton seed hover around Rs. 2650 per quintal and the prices are likely to decline in the short term, due to accumulation of stock in the CCI godowns as there are limited buyers.The demand for cotton oil cake will remain stable in the coming month. The average price in Kadiwas Rs. 2106/q and forAkola was Rs. 2117/q.


**U.S. Bans cotton imports from china.** U.S has expanded economic pressure on china's western region of Xinjiang by banning imports of cotton and cotton productsfrom xPCC, a powerful Chinese quasi- military organization. The move, known as Withhold Release Order (WRO), covers cotton from XPCC, its subordinates and affiliated entites, as well as products derived from XPCC processed cotton.

**Mexico's cotton production could disappear in 2021.** Cotton cultivation in mexicocould disappear as the prohibition of SEMARNAT to use transgenic seed. There is an urgency of new genetically modified seeds of better quality for the next planting cycle, ithas led the organization to request a hearing to expose the problem.








#### **USA Spot Prices**

U.S. Export Sales was lower but shipments were better.Net upland sales of 1,15,600 RB for 2020- 2021 were down 60 percent from the previous week and 42 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases primarily for China, Pakistan (25,200 RB), Turkey (22,500 RB), South Korea (16,600 RB), and Guatemala (15,900 RB), and the major reductions were primarily from Bangladesh (44,100 RB) and Mexico (10,100 RB).



#### **Technical Commentary:**

- Cotton broke through a trendline resistance two weeks ago and started diverging lower gradually last week.
- On the daily chart, RSI has shown two instances of negative divergences over the last two weeks.
- After the breach of the trendline, the prices were being supported at 18-day EMA until recently, but yesterday that support also got breached. The market closed at 19840 while the 18-day EMA was at 19869.
- Further fall is expected in cotton. We had recommended short positions, 50% of the exposure at 19840 and balance 50% if market rises to 20350. Hence our short positions at 19840 are currently open. Further short positions can be taken at 20350. Stoploss must be maintained at 20450.


#### **Technical Commentary:**

- Cottonseed Oilcake broke above a trendline resistance two weeks ago.
- During last three sessions, the price re-tested the trendline but stayed above it. Our buy calls at 2075-2085 have been initiated.
- On the weekly chart, EMA-9 had crossed above EMA-18 four weeks ago, and has also crossed above EMA-50 last week. Also, EMA-18 is converging with EMA-50.
- Long positions have been carried forward from previous two days. New entrants can still enter longs in the range of 2075 to 2080. Stoplossfor all positions must be maintained at 2050. Targets of 2200 and 2240 may be expected in about a week.




