

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 03rd May 2021

Domestic market summary

Domestic MarketScenario:Cotton farmers from various states are planning to increase area under cotton cultivation in the coming 2021-22kharif season. Also, almost 90 percent of the cotton in the current season 2020-21 has already arrived in the market till last month. Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption has estimated cotton production at 360 lakh bales from its previous estimate of 371 lakh bales.

Weekly Price Outlook :The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 5830-6700/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh is likely to hover around Rs.5600-6000/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotlook index stood higher(94.70cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 87.86 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee remained close to 74.04 to 74.71 per USD.

Market Highlights:

- Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption has reduced cotton crop estimate for 2020-21 season. According to the meeting held by Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption, cotton production is estimated at 360 lakh bales lower from its previous estimate of 371 lakh bales where as imports were maintained at 11 lakh bales and exports were reduced from 75 lakh bales to 70 lakh bales. Due to current lockdown situation cotton consumption was also reduced from 330 lakh bales to 303 lakh bales.
- Cotton cultivation delays in Malwa region of Punjab. Cotton farmers in the malwa region are worried as the cotton cultivation for the coming season has been delayed due to acute shortage of water. The sirhind canal and kotla canal of the region have been running dry for over a month now. These two canal supply water for irrigation to majority of Malwa districts.
- Punjab has decreased the cotton cultivation target for 2021-22 seasons. Despite of high cotton prices in the current season, the cotton cultivation target has decreased for the coming season 2021-22 to 3.25 lakh hectares. Whereas in the 2020-21 seasons the Punjab government had claimed that they have increased the area under cotton cultivation to 5 lakh hectares. Although, now the government has said that the last

year's area was inflated by almost two times, in revenue assessment in 2020-21 the area is found to be 2.51 lakh hectares and not 5 lakh hectares.


• Cotton Yarn prices have dropped as second wave of corona hits the demand. Cotton yarn prices have dropped from the peak seen at the beginning of this year and could decline further from May when a revision in rates is due to slack demand. Prices of almost of all counts of yarn have dropped by at least Rs.10 a kg as demand is low due to second wave of corona virus. Production in textile mills has dropped and it is impacting yarn off take where as the last six months were good period for Indian spinning mills because there was a huge shortage of cotton yarn due to last year's lockdown and huge demand for yarn came from domestic and International market as a result mill during that period performed well. But again with the second wave of corona virus many states have announced lockdowns and production in textile mills have slowed down.

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



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
Lint price Outlook






Cotton Seed Oil Cake weeklyPrice Scenario

The cotton seed oil and cottonseed oilcake prices are likely to remain range bound till June' 2021 and prices are expected to increase after June, whereas, the raw cotton prices are still increasing in the market. Currently, Cottonseed oilcake prices are prevailing around Rs. 3200- 3600 per quintal in the market. Cottonseed oil prices are around Rs. 3800- 4000 per quintal in Maharashtra, it is expected that the prices may increase to Rs. 4500 per quintal. But the demand for cotton seed oil in Maharashtra and Gujarat is likely to fall with the rising temperature and Corona cases. According to the market experts it is difficult to predict the market situation right now. The average price of cotton seed oilcake has increased in Kadi at Rs. 2803 per quintal from Rs. 2824 per quintal and in Akola were at Rs. 2826 per quintal from Rs. 2798 per quintal previous week.

International Market Scenario

- Kenya aims to increase its commercial production of GMO cotton by 10 times next year. The target of kenyan government is to involve over 200,000 farmers to boost production from 20,000 bales currently to 200,000 bales by 2022. Controlled farming of GMO cotton was approved by the Kenyan government in 2019 after successful field trials, and it identified 1,000 farmers last year to receive the first GMO cotton seeds. Overall the country has a demand of 38,000 tonnes of cotton lint, but produces only 5,300 tonnes. Besides Kenya, African countries like Sudan, South Africa, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Malawi and Eswatini also produce GMO cotton.
- China will soon launch its own version of Better Cotton Intiative (BCI) standards. This cotton program will mainly focus on improving production effecieny through digitalization, a fully tracable cotton production process, low carbon production and high quality cotton farming.
- Bangladesh apparel export improved year-on-year in March 2021, to2.450 billion USD, up by 8.8 percent from same month previous year. However, the exports have slowed down by 6.5% from the previous

month. During January to March, Bangladesh apparel export has reached 7.94 billion USD which was down by 1.7 percent year on year; whereasthe cumulative export volume was 299 million USD.

The global 2020-21 cotton supply and demand estimates show lower stocks and production. The April 2020-21 forecast shows marginal increase in consumption in Bangladesh and Mexico compared to March 2021.Global trade has been boosted by greater import demand from China and Bangladesh. Also, higher exports are expected from Brazil, United States and Egypt.






Pakistan Spot Prices

The Pakistan government is considering an option to import cotton from Uzbekistan via land route after it took back a decision of its import from India, as textile exporters want government to take decisive steps amid 40 percent drop in the crop output.






