

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 10th May 2021

Domestic market summary

Domestic Market Scenario: Cotton farmers from various states are planning to increase area under cotton cultivation in the coming 2021-22 kharif season. Indian Textile mills have reduced production due to lower domestic demand and labour shortage. Although, government has allowed mills to operate but markets are closed so mills are facing cash crunch. Textile mills dealing in exports are still going strong as Indian yarn prices are attractive. Cotton arrivals are very low due to corona virus cases and lockdown in many parts of the country.

Weekly Price Outlook :The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 5830-6700/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh is likely to hover around Rs.5600-6000/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- Cotlook index stood higher(91.90cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 87.21 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee remained close to 73.51 to 73.91 per USD.

Market Highlights:

- According to the Cotton Textile Export Promotion Council Cotton Textile and Apparel export are 13 percent lower from the previous year. The Textile and Apparel Export are 13 percent lower from previous season; the exports are worth \$29 billion last year as against \$34 billion in 2019-20. Exports of readymade garment have also declined 20.78 percent last fiscal year compared with the previous year, while exports for man-made textile items fell 21.20 percent. Export of cotton textile had declined 2.12 percent; it is mainly because of COVID spread.
- Cotton Consumption may drop by 8 percent due to second wave of corona virus. According to the Union Ministry of Textile Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption has reduced cotton consumption for the season 2020-21 at 303 lakh bales from 330 lakh bales earlier, owing to the current lockdown as the extreme second wave of corona virus. Although total demand is expected to be 373 lakh bales, with 303 lakh bales consumed domestically and 70 lakh bales exported.
- Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption has reduced cotton crop estimate for 2020-21 season. According to the meeting held by Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption, cotton production is estimated at 360 lakh bales lower from its previous estimate of 371 lakh bales where as


imports were maintained at 11 lakh bales and exports were reduced from 75 lakh bales to 70 lakh bales. Due to current lockdown situation cotton consumption was also reduced from 330 lakh bales to 303 lakh bales.



Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



Spot Price versus MSP










Cotton Seed Oil Cake weeklyPrice Scenario

With the rising coronavirus cases all across the country, the major cotton markets were closed due to lockdown restrictions. This has also affected the demand for both cottonseed oil and cottonseed oilcake in the major markets. However, except for Gujarat, the various other states are facing a shortage of cottonseed oilcake and cottonseed oil. On the other side, Gujarat has immense stock available to meet the demands of other states also. The demand is expected to increase after the lockdown is over.

The cottonseed oil prices have decreased from the previous week by 2 percent and the cottonseed oilcake prices have decreased by 3-4 percent. The average price of cottonseed oilcake in the Kadi market was Rs. 2680 per quintal from Rs. 2803 per quintal and in Akola was at Rs. 2731 per quintal from Rs. 2826 per quintal the previous week.

International Market Scenario

- According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee, Global production is estimated at 24.6 million tonnes this month.India has lead global production at an estimated 6.3 million tonnes for 2020-21 season. China is expected to be the second largest producer with 5.9 million tonnes. The West Africa cotton producing countries together are estimated to produce over 1 million tonnes this year. The United States and Brazil are expected to produce 3.2 and 2.5 million tonnes respectively. These two countries have textile industries relatively small compared to the domestic supply and will export the overwhelming majority of their production.
- Kenya aims to increase its commercial production of GMO cotton by 10 times next year. The target of kenyan government is to involve over 200,000 farmers to boost production from 20,000 bales currently to 200,000 bales by 2022. Controlled farming of GMO cotton was approved by the Kenyan government in 2019 after successful field trials, and it identified 1,000 farmers last year to receive the first GMO cotton seeds. Overall the country has a demand of 38,000 tonnes of cotton lint, but produces only 5,300 tonnes. Besides Kenya, African countries like Sudan, South Africa, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Malawi and Eswatini also produce GMO cotton.
- China will soon launch its own version of Better Cotton Intiative (BCI) standards. This cotton program will mainly focus on improving production effecieny through digitalization, a fully tracable cotton production process, low carbon production and high quality cotton farming.






USA Spot Prices




