

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 24th May 2021

Domestic market summary

Domestic Market Scenario: Punjab and Haryana has started sowing cotton for the coming 2021-22 season. Indian cotton is still in demand, despite the rise in prices and very low arrivals. Cotton arrivals in the CCI procurement center are very low due to coronavirus cases and lockdown in many parts of the country.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 5830-6700/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh are likely to hover around Rs.5600-6000/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Cotlook index stood higher (88.00 cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 82.32 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee remained close to 72.83 to 73.21 per USD.

Market Highlights:

- Punjab Agriculture Department is planning to revive cotton in the Moga district of Punjab. To revive cotton cultivation in Moga, the Punjab agriculture department has now started a unique project in the district under which farmers are being encouraged to sow cotton using the 'bed plantation technique' which uses furrow irrigation to save water. Earlier the farmers have slowly weaned away from cotton and were shifted towards a paddy. The cotton sowing season is currently underway in Punjab, According to the department officials, Till now 25 acres have been sown in this particular block in different villages with the same technique as a demonstration to encourage other farmers to adopt cotton cultivation instead of paddy.
- According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee, Supply and Demand estimate report, India's cotton production is estimated at 6.1 million tonnes for the 2020-21 season. Cotton consumption is estimated at around 5.15 million tonnes whereas the imports are estimated at 187,000 tonnes and export around 1.2 million tonnes.
- The AI-Based solution will help India's cotton farmers to fight against pest attacks. According to the Wardhani Institute for Artificial Intelligence, cotton farmers in Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Telangana have seen a reduction in the damage due to pink bollworm attacks and quality improvement in the crop using artificial intelligence. The solution built by the institute works on a simple smart phone and provides real-time localized and accurate pest advisory to the farmers. This AI-Based solution works in 8 different


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
languages and also gives a recommendation for use of pesticides based on the intensity of the pink bollworm attack. The AI Solution is deployed in 4 districts across three states across India.



Spot Price versus MSP

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




Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

With the rising corona virus cases all across the country, the major cotton markets were closed due to lockdown restrictions. This has also affected the demand for both cottonseed oil and cottonseed oilcake in the major markets. The major market of Gujarat for cottonseed oil is closed due to lockdown restrictions but the cottonseed oil prices have increased from the previous week by 2-4 percent in Hyderabad and Mumbai market.

The cottonseed oil prices have increased from the previous week. The average price of cottonseed oilcake in the Kadi market was Rs. 2764 per quintal from Rs. 2746 per quintal and in Akola was at Rs. 2775 per quintal from Rs. 2772 per quintal the previous week.

International Market Scenario

- Myanmar is diverting export orders to Bangladesh. Myanmar's deepening political crisis and India's grave coronavirus situation are prompting international retailers and brands to divert work orders to Bangladesh as due to stability in the coronavirus situation; Bangladesh is witnessing a relatively calm situation than many other countries in the region.
- Zimbabwe cotton marketing season has started amid high expectation from farmers of early payments from the crop upon delivery at the 773 buying points countrywide. Farmers are ready to deliver cotton bales at the buying points while the cotton-picking is also progressing.
- In the latest report released by USDA in May'2021, for the 2020-21 season, global production and consumption have slightly changed from April month. Imports were projected higher in Vietnam(6%), China(13%), and Bangladesh(1%) and more than offset slower demand from Malaysia and Taiwan whereas exports were higher from the U.S(10%) and Brazil(16%) from the previous estimates. Global ending stock was projected down by 2 percent as larger exports from the United States and Brazil lower their stock and more than offset higher stock levels in China.
- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, U.S. cotton
 production for the season 2021-22 is projected to rise 2.4 million bales, but the total supply is projected at
 its lowest in 5 years. Although both exports and ending stock are forecasted lower than in 2020-21 season.
 Production is anticipated at 17.0 million bales, with 12.0 million planted acres as indicated in Prospective
 Plantings, abandonment projected above the average of the past 5 years and average yields. Exports are

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
expected to fall 1.6 million bales, to 14.7 million bales and domestic mill use is projected to rise200,000 bales to 2.5 million bales.








USA Spot Prices


Pakistan Spot Prices

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





