

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 21st June 2021

Domestic market summary

Domestic Market Scenario: Cotton sowing is progressing across India for the coming 2021-22 season. Government has increased the MSP of Kharif crops for marketing season 2021-22 to ensure remunerative prices to the growers for their produce. Farmers are getting Rs. 7,600 per quintal rate for kapas and Rs. 4000 per quintal for cotton seed.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 6900-7500/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradeshare likely to hover around Rs.5600-6000/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Cotlook index stood higher (93.20cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 84.95 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee remained close to 73.27 to 74.07 per USD.

Market Highlights:

- Cotton Cultivation area may increase to 5-10 percent in 2021-22 season. Cotton acreages may see a rise of 5-10 percent this Kharif season as a result of high cotton prices in the market for the ongoing 2020-21 season. With assured procurement through Cotton Corporation of India, good monsoon and groundnut cultivation turning costly are some of the other factors that are likely to aid higher coverage under cotton this year.
- Cotton Association of India has reduced its cotton crop estimate for 2020-21 seasons by 4 lakh bales at 356 lakh bales. The total supply from October 2020 May 2021 is estimated at around 473.44 lakh bales which consist of arrivals of 340.19 lakh bales whereas imports were estimated at 8 lakh bales and opening stock at 125 lakh bales at the beginning of the season. Further, the cotton consumption was estimated at around 220 lakh bales, and exports upto 31st May'2021 were estimated to be 58 lakh bales, and stock at the end of May'2021 was estimated at 195.44 lakh bales.
- **Cotton prices have increased in Gujarat.** With strong demand from domestic shipping mills, cotton prices have firmed up to reach a decadal high level. The demand from the international market has further supported the local prices of the natural fiber. The shanker-6 variety has reached Rs. 50,500 to Rs. 51,000 per candy in Gujarat local market this week, which is highest in 10 years.


• Area under Cotton cultivation has fallen in Haryana for the coming season. The area under cotton cultivation has reduced in Haryana by over 90,000 hectares for the coming season because of hampering of field activities during the second wave of the corona virus and shifting of farmers to other crops like groundnut. The crop has been sown in over 6.72 lakh hectares in Haryana against the target of 7.62 lakh hectares. In the previous season, 7.31 lakh hectares of area was sown under cotton crop while the normal area under cotton in Haryana is 6.82 lakh hectares.

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








Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

International Market Scenario

- The US Department of Agriculture has increased the cotton crop estimate by 5 percent for the coming 2021-22 season. According to USDA's,Cotton and Wool Outlook report, global cotton production in 2021-22 is forecastedat 118.9 million bales, 5 percent above the previous year'sbut 2 percent below the 2019-20 production. Larger cotton crops are forecasted for most of the major cotton-producing countries in 2021-22, led by the United States, Brazil, and Australia. For the 2021-22 season, India is expected to produce larger cotton crop accounting for more than 24 percent of the world's production. India's cotton crop is projected at 29.0 million bales and is 500,000 bales above the 2020-21 season. The area under cotton cultivation is forecasted at 13.0 million hectares for 2021-22 and an improvement in yield is expected to 486 kg per hectare.
- In USDA's June 2021 forecast report, for the 2020-21 season, global production and consumption have been raised marginally from May month. Global trade is boosted, led by the robust demand in China, Bangladesh, and Turkey. Exports have also been raised for India, Brazil, and United States in May 2021 and were

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estimated at 5,900 bales, 11,000 bales, and 16,400 bales respectively from previous month 5,500 bales, 10,700 bales and 16,240 bales.


- The cotton Business of Thailand has started to recover as global economy recovers. With improving health condition and global economy the cotton business has started recovering, the cotton imports of the country were 700 thousand 480 lb bales in 2019-20 which have dropped to 550 thousand 480 lb bales in 2020-21 but are now likely to rise by 9.09 percent to 600 thousand lb bales in 2021-22.
- According to the International Advisory Cotton Committee June report, global production has been
 reduced to 24.3 million tonnes. Production estimates for Brazil have been lowered since the starting of the
 season to 2.5 million tonnes. For India, as per the Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption,
 Cotton production for India is estimated at 6.12 million tonnes. With the second wave of corona virus
 currently affecting the country the mill use has been revised down to 5.15 million tonnes. Imports are also
 expected to decrease to 187,000 tonnes. Also, with the reduced supply and growth in exports, stocks in
 India are expected to decrease with the stock to use ratio falling to 0.54.






Pakistan Spot Prices









