

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 12th July 2021

Domestic market summary

• **Domestic Market Scenario:** Cotton sowing is progressing across India for the coming 2021-22 season. Cotton price of Shanker-6 rate crossed Rs.53,000 per candy mark. CCI sold good quantity of cotton with increasing base price. Now CCI unsold stock is nearly 19 lakh bales. Indian cotton arrivals were negligible and due to slow arrivals, stockiest hold the cotton and ask for higher price.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 6900-8500/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradeshare likely to hover around Rs.5600-7500/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Cotlook index stood higher (96.20cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 86.97 cents/lbs.
- Indian basis is stable between +2.5 to +3.5.


- Gujarat cotton acreages may increase by 10 percent for 2021-22 season. Cotton cultivation area under Gujarat is likely to increase by 10 percent this kharif season as farmers are getting high price for the natural fiber last year. As per the State Agriculture Department, the area under cotton cultivation in the state has increased to 16.50 lakh hectares as on 5th July 2021 compared to previous years at 15.72 lakh hectares during the same period last year.
- India's Export shipment at strong pace. The export shipment data has confirmed that the Indian cotton export has been much higher than most expected. The March shipments reached 182,591 tons which was highest since June 2017, the shipments data confirmed that china purchased a much larger volume than many had thought during the steep price discounts of February. China was the largest destination in March at 76,636 tons followed by Bangladesh at 72,428 tons whereas; Indonesia and Vietnam have also increased purchases from India.
- Cotton sowing has been increased in Telangana for the coming 2021-22 kharif season. Encouraged by the monsoon rains and comfortable water levels in various irrigation projects, farmers have increased their Kharif sowing particularly for cotton, paddy and red gram. According to the data released by the Agriculture Department till 23rd June'21, a total of 1801482 acres of area has been sown under kharif cotton.


Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario

Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



Spot Price versus MSP


Average kapas price at Gondal market stood higher at Rs. 7734/q from previous week at Rs. 7692/q.










Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

International Market Scenario

- According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, production is projected to return to pre pandemic levels next year. Global Consumption has also recovered from 2019-20, to post a 12.5 percent increase to 25.59 million tonnes in 2020-21 and is projected to improve further to 25.8 million tonnes. Also, Lower production with higher demand will cause ending stock to decline for the first time in four years at 20.96 million tonnes. For 2021-22 ending stock are forecasted to decline further to 20.77 million tonnes as mill use is expected to exceed production. Exports have also increased by 11.75 percent in 2020-21 compared to 2019-20 season and should remain at the same level in 2021-22.
- Australian cotton exports to china are plummeting. The quality of Australian cotton that passed Chinese customs clearance remained low, while price quotation and purchasing remained sluggish for the commodity as Chinese businesses had become cautions about importing Australian cotton amid the two countries fraught relations. According to the market experts Australian cotton is losing its once favored market status in china as demands soared for domestically produced cotton, particularly produced in northwest china's Xingjian Uyghur autonomous region, which is of good quality.
- Pakistan cotton market witnessed mixed trends. The rate of cotton in Punjab dropped by Rs. 400 per maund. The rate of cotton has increased in the international cotton markets. The rate of cotton in Sindh remained stable, whereas prices in the local market were firm week ago.










