

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 19th July 2021

Domestic market summary

Domestic Market Scenario: Cotton sowing is progressing across India for the coming 2021-22 season.
 Cotton Sowing has fallen by 17 percent across India compared to the previous season. Indian Cotton remained its bullish trend and crossed Rs.54,000 per candy mark.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 6900-8600/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradeshare likely to hover around Rs.5600-7400/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Cotlook index stood higher (96.80cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 88.16 cents/lbs.
- Indian basis remained in positive territory.

Market Highlights:

- Cotton prices fell up to Rs. 700 per maund. Cotton prices have fell by Rs. 400 to Rs. 700 per maund in local markets with the textile and spinning mills reluctant to buy rain affected commodities. According to the traders, monsoon rains in Sindh and Punjab has affected the cotton prices. In Sindh the prices have declined Rs. 400 to Rs. 600 per maund at Rs. 12600 to Rs. 12800 per maund. Seed cotton prices have also dropped by Rs. 300 to Rs. 400 per 40 kg to Rs. 5,200 to Rs. 5,700 per 40 kg. Cotton seed was sold for Rs. 1,700 to Rs. 1,800 per maund in Sindh.
- Cotton sowing reduces in Marathwada. The area under cotton cultivation has decreased during this kharif season as farmers are shifting towards soybean over the traditional cash crop, due to range of factors including lower cultivation cost, shorter harvesting period, and resistance to diseases and pests. As per the latest official data, cotton has been sown on 67% of the estimated area of 6.97 lakh hectares in Aurangabad Division and 65 percent of the estimated area around 3.58 lakh hectares in Latur Division.
- India is planning to sign MOU with Bangladesh to export 10 lakh bales of cotton annually. The Indian government is planning to sign a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with Bangladesh to export 10 lakh bales of cotton every year. Bangladesh is one of the largest buyers of Indian cotton and for its expanding textile industry, particularly garments the Bangladesh government wanted India to ensure an uninterrupted supply of cotton. According to Cotton Corporation of India, the MOU will facilitate a government-to-government transaction and it is expected that the memorandum will be signed soon.




- Cotton cultivation area increases in Gujarat but reduces in other North Indian states. As farmers are opting for other oilseeds and pulses the area under cotton cultivation has decreased in North India. According to the latest data, cotton has been planted on about 18.43 lakh hectares in Gujarat, a marginal increase from 18.25 lakh hectares in the same period a year ago. Over all across India the area is lower by 17 percent as of 9th July 2021 at 86.45 lakh hectare compared with 104.82 lakh hectares a year ago.
- According to the All India Crop Situation Report issued by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's
 Welfare shows a decrease in sowing area this year, around 499.87 lakh hectare of area has been sown
 against 558.11 lakh hectare last year, with area under almost all major crops including moong, soyabean,
 paddy and cotton reported a dip. In the absence of rains, farmers are either shifting to shorter-duration
 crops or waiting for enough soil moisture to commence sowing.


Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario


Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario

Average kapas price at Gondal market stood higher at Rs. 7779/q from previous week at Rs. 7734/q.





Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake






Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

<u>International Market Scenario</u>

- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, export projection for US cotton for the season 2021-22 shows a higher production, exports and ending stock compared with last month. While the 30th June 2021 U.S. cotton acreage report shows 300,000 fewer planted acres for U.S. cotton than NASS's previous survey, a rainfall driven reduction is projected. Texas abandonment means U.S. harvested area is projected 9 percent higher. While the 2021-22 production is estimated 800,000 bales higher, consumption is unchanged and exports and ending stock are each projected 400,000 bales higher.
- Global Consumption has gained 12.5 percent in 2020-21. According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, production is projected to return to pre pandemic levels next year. Global Consumption has also recovered from 2019-20, to post a 12.5 percent increase to 25.59 million tonnes in 2020-21 and is projected to improve further to 25.8 million tonnes. Also, Lower production with higher demand will cause ending stock to decline for the first time in four years at 20.96 million tonnes. For 2021-22 ending stock are forecasted to decline further to 20.77 million tonnes as mill use is expected to exceed production. Exports have also increased by 11.75 percent in 2020-21 compared to 2019-20 season and should remain at the same level in 2021-22.
- According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, production is projected to return to pre pandemic levels next year. 


