

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 23rd Aug 2021

Domestic market summary

Domestic Market Scenario: Cotton sowing is progressing across India for the coming 2021-22 season. Till 13th Aug 2021 cotton sowing across India has reached 116.172 lakh hectares compared to previous season sowing at 116.38 lakh hectares during the same time. The center has announced the new rate under the Rebate on Duties and Taxes on export Products (RoDTEP) scheme this week. No major quantity was sold by CCI during this week.

Weekly Price Outlook: The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 6900-8600/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh are likely to hover around Rs.5600-7900/q.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Cotlook index stood higher (102.75cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 94.31 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee remained stable with in small range against USD.

Market Highlights:

- Cotton Corporation of India may not require procuring more than 30 lakh bales in 2021-22 season. Cotton Corporation of India has procured around 92 lakh bales of cotton during the ongoing 2020-21 season. CCI may be required to procure minimal amount of cotton in the 2021-22 season, as kapas prices are likely to rule above the minimum support price (MSP) for a better part of the season. Cotton procurement may be required during the peak season if the prices drop below the MSP.
- Gujarat textile sector expects boost in cotton exports. With the center announcing the new rate under the Rebate on Duties and Taxes on export Products (RoDTEP) scheme, textile exporter are expecting a boost in order volumes backed by better cost competitiveness. As per the new rates, RoDTEP extends incentives of 2.5% to 4.5% on the export of yarn and fabric of different kinds.
- Cotton has been purchased at Rs. 6,500 per quintal in Mansa. Cotton arrivals have started coming in Mansa and has been purchased at a price of Rs. 6,500 per quintal against the minimum selling price of Rs. 6,025 per quintal. As per the market sources, the rise in prices is due to the competitive bidding amongst the private players including the cotton traders and factories which are placing bids and quoting higher price to purchase the produce.


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- The Cotton Textile Export Promotion Council (TEXPROCIL) has welcomed the issuance of government notification on the continuation of scheme for Refunding State and Central Taxes and Levies (RoSCTL) for the garments and madeup sectors.
- According to the Ministry of Agriculture advance estimate for 2020-21 season. Total food grain production in the country is estimated at 308.65 million tonnes which is higher by 11.14 million tonnes than the 2019-20 season. The production during 2020-21 is higher by 29.77 million tonnes than the previous five years' (2015-16 to 2019-20) average production of foodgrains. As per the 4th adavance estimate the estimated production for cotton is around 35.38 million bales higher by 3.49 million bales than the average cotton production.


Weekly Price Review: Weekly kapas average price at Rajkot was low at Rs. 8587/q and in Hisar were prices were at Rs. 7345/qt.



Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario




Spot Price versus MSP

Lint price Outlook






Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

The cotton seed oilcake prices are expected to rise to Rs. 800 - Rs. 1000 per quintal in the coming month of September 2021. The demand is expected to rise with the coming of the new season, currently there is no stock available in the country, although a small amount of stock is available with Maharashtra and Gujarat but it is expected to get finish by 18th August 2021. The cottonseed oilcake prices have slightly increased from the previous week. The average price of cottonseed oilcake in the Kadi market was Rs. 3088 per quintal from Rs. 3055 per quintal and in Akola was at Rs. 3113 per quintal from Rs. 3070 per quintal the previous week.

International Market Scenario

- Cotton picking has started in Pakistan. Cotton picking has commenced in Pakistan, as per the Agriculture Department, quality of cotton is good and no major pest attack was observed. The farmers are not only achieving good production but are also getting good price for their produce in the market.
- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, For 2021-22 U.S. Cotton projection, World cotton production is forecasted 546,000 bales lower (118.84 million) as reduced production in Brazil (12.50 million bales), United States (17.26 million bales) offset higher projection for Australia, Mali and Tanzania. Consumption is forecasted slightly higher up by 170,000 bales and ending stocks are projected at 87.2 million bales, about 500,000 bales lower than in July and 4.6 million lower than in 2020-21.
- Pakistan cotton prices increases amid low yield and delayed imports. The cotton prices are increasing in the local market amid a fall in the local production delay in cotton shipments from abroad and rising dollar

rupee disparity. The Karachi cotton Association quoted Rs. 13,580 per maund as the spot rate for white lint, while the seed cotton prices were between Rs. 5200 – Rs. 6200 per maund.

- Global production is expected to increase by 3 percent in 2021-22. According to the International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, production is projected to increase by 3 percent in 2021-22 season to 25 million tonnes. Global Consumption has also recovered from 2019-20, to post a 12.4 percent increase to 25.5 million tonnes in 2020-21 and is projected to improve further to 25.8 million tonnes in 2021-22. Also, the concerns remain due to Covid 19 stubbornness with threats from factory closings and logistical problems looming in Bangladesh and Vietnam.
- According to the Food and Agriculture Outlook Report, India is expected to be the world's largest cotton
 producer till 2030. Despite the challenges including land constraints, water shortage, climate change and
 crop's susceptibility to pest and disease attacks, India will continue to be the World's largest cotton
 producer till 2030. India's cotton production is expected to expand to 7.2 million tonnes (approximately 43
 million bales of 170 kg each) compared with the current output of 6 MT equivalent to roughly 36 million
 bales. India will contribute to as much as 40 percent global increase in cotton production during the
 outlook period.


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Cotlook A index was higher this week. The Cotlook A Index was at 99.80cents/lb higher as compared to the previous week (98.68cents/lb).



- > We expect cotton prices to remain rangeboundin the coming week.







