

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 06th Sep 2021

## **Domestic market summary**

 Domestic Market Scenario: Till 02 Sep 2021 cotton sowing across India has reached 118.13 lakh hectares compared to previous season sowing at 126.45 lakh hectares during the same time. New cotton arrivals have started coming in mandi.

#### **Weekly Price Outlook:**

The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 6900-7400/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh are likely to hover around Rs.5600-7500/q.

#### **Major Market Highlights:**

- The Cotlook index stood higher (103.65cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 94.23 cents/lbs.
- Much awaited rainfall in Gujarat was very beneficial to cotton crop.

#### **Market Highlights:**

- According the Agriwatch estimates, till 02nd September '2021, about 118.13 lakh hectares area was sown in India compared to normal of corresponding week 126.45 lakh hectares last year. Higher area was reported from the states of Maharashtra (39.37 lakh hectares), Telangana (20.51 lakh hectares), Karnataka (6.28 lakh hectares), Rajasthan (6.17 lakh hectares), Haryana (6.88 lakh hectares), Madhya Pradesh (6.15 lakh hectares), and Gujarat (22.51 lakh hecatres). Less area was reported from the states of Andhra Pradesh (4.81 lakh hectares), Tamil Nadu (0.10 lakh hectares), Punjab (3.03 lakh hectares) and Odisha (1.95 lakh hectares).
- Bathinda Cotton purchase for 2021-22 Kharif season is picking up in the markets. Mansa, Bathinda, Fazilka, and Muktsar with farmers being paid up to Rs. 6,711 per quintal, higher than this season's expected MSP (Minimum Support Price) of Rs. 5,925. According to the Punjab Mandi Board, 17,000 quintal cotton has been purchased over the past 10 days till 30<sup>th</sup> August'21, with private players buying the entire production.
- Cotton crop has been affected due to Pink Bollworm infestation. The area of Sirsa, Fatehabad, Hisar, Mahendargarh, and Jind of Haryana, along with Bhatinda and Mansa of Punjab has been affected by the pest infestation. According to the Central Institute of Cotton Research, pink bollworm was spotted in central and south India during the previous seasons but this time infestation has been reported in some



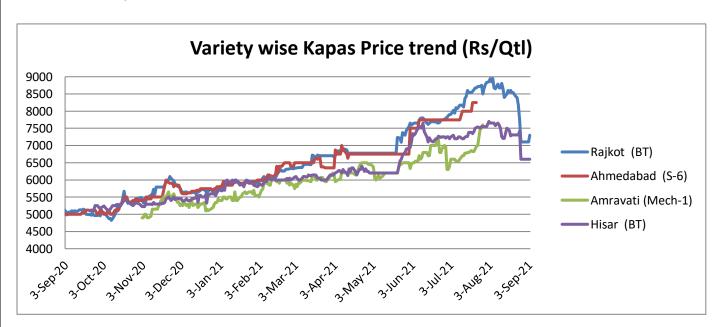
areas of Punjab and Haryana. Also, a meeting is scheduled between top cotton scientist from the Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2021 to decide the strategy to minimize the pest infestation.

- The purchase of new cotton has started at the abohar new grain market. Around 1,500 quintals of narma cotton was purchased from different farmers at the rate of Rs. 6,721. According to the local farmers, the areas under cotton is likely to give more produce this time if the rain does not affect plants in the coming days.
- New cotton arrivals have started in Bathinda Mandi. Around 19 quintals of raw cotton has arrived in Bathinda grain market on Monday. The cotton prices are higher and farmers are getting Rs.300-400 per quintal more than the MSP. Prices are fixed at Rs. 5,925 per quintal for 27.5-28.5 mm long staple, farmers are getting Rs. 6,200- Rs.6,400 per quintal. Cotton Corporation of India is expected to enter the market in October for the new season.

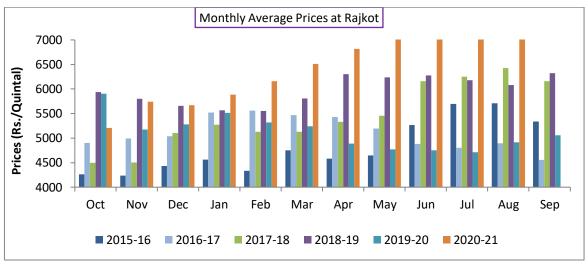

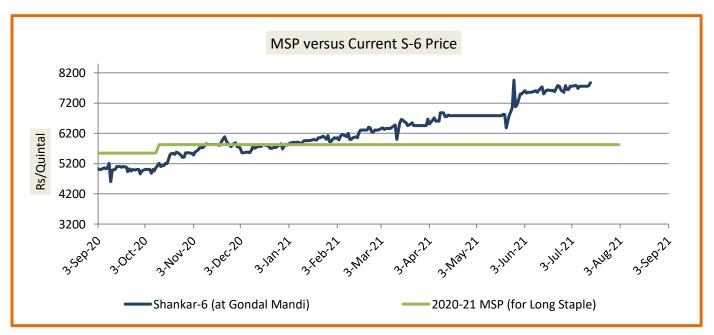
#### Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario

Arrivals were not available in Gondal Market. Average kapas price at Gondal market stood at Rs. 7875/q in the previous week.

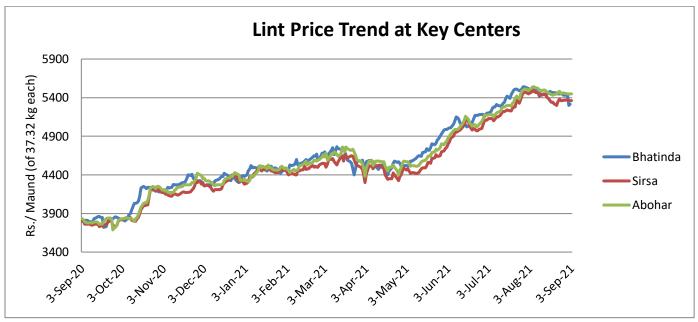

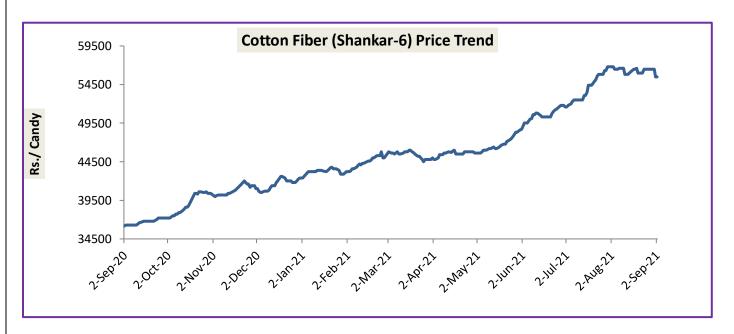

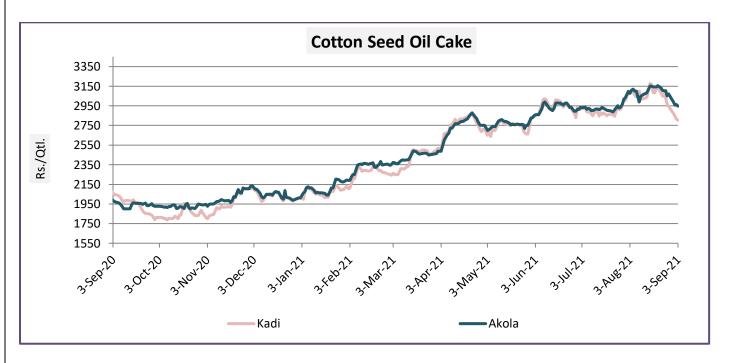


#### Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

## **International Market Scenario**

- According to an International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, cotton production is projected to increase by 3 percent in 2021-22 season to 25 million tonnes. Global Consumption has also recovered from 2019-20, to post a 12.4 percent increase to 25.5 million tonnes in 2020-21 and is projected to improve further to 25.8 million tonnes in 2021-22. Also, the concerns remain due to Covid 19 stubbornness with threats from factory closures and logistical issues looming in Bangladesh and Vietnam.
- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) August report, for the 2020-21 global ending stocks are higher despite lower production and higher consumption. Global trade is raised and led by higher imports for China and Bangladesh. The U.S. 2020-21 balance reflected only a drop in exports by 50,000 bales to 16.35 million. The 2021-22 cotton crop was lowered by 118,000 tons to 3.76 million with leaving the planted acres unchanged. Exports were decreased by 44,000 tons to 3.27 million and ending stock was depressed by 65,000 tons to 0.66 million tons, down year over year by 6.3 percent.



- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, For 2021-22 U.S. Cotton projection, World cotton production is forecasted 546,000 bales lower at 118.84 million as reduced production in Brazil (12.50 million bales) and United States (17.26 million bales) offset higher projection for Australia, Mali, and Tanzania. Consumption is forecasted slightly higher up by 170,000 bales and ending stocks are projected at 87.2 million bales, about 500,000 bales lower than in July and 4.6 million lower than in 2020-21. India's cotton production is forecasted at 29.0 million bales, unchanged from the last month and up by around 2 percent from the previous year (28.0 million bales).
- According to the Food and Agriculture Outlook Report, India is expected to be the world's largest cotton producer till 2030. Despite the challenges including land constraints, water shortage, climate change and crop's susceptibility to pest and disease attacks, India will continue to be the World's largest cotton producer till 2030. India's cotton production is expected to expand to 7.2 million tonnes (approximately 43 million bales of 170 kg each) compared with the current output of 6 MT equivalent to roughly 36 million bales. India will contribute to as much as 40 percent global increase in cotton production during the outlook period.
- According to the Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA), Bangladesh and India can reap more mutual trade benefits through better collaboration in apparel and textile industry as there are great opportunities for Bangladesh and India to complement each other in boosting apparel and textile business in both the countries.
- Cotton picking has started in Pakistan. Cotton picking has commenced in Pakistan, as per the Agriculture
  Department, quality of cotton is good and no major pest attack was observed. The farmers are not only
  achieving good production but are also getting good price for their produce in the market.

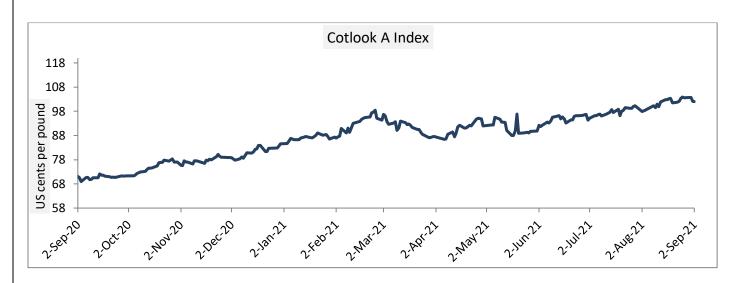
