

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 13th Sep 2021

# **Domestic market summary**

Domestic Market Scenario: Till 10th Sep 2021 cotton sowing across India has reached 119.45 lakh hectares compared to previous season sowing at 126.81 lakh hectares during the same time. New cotton arrivals have started coming in mandi. Sowing is almost over for cotton but good rains and good weather may offset the decrease in area by better yield.

#### Weekly Price Outlook:

The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 6900-7400/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh are likely to hover around Rs.5600-7500/q.

#### Major Market Highlights:

• The Cotlook index stood higher (103.12cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 94.02 cents/lbs.

#### Market Highlights:

- Cotton production is expected to increase up to 12 percent in Gujarat. The cotton production in Gujarat is expected to rise by 10-12 percent in the new cotton season beginning October. Despite the lower acreages around 22.51 lakh hectares under the cotton crop this kharif, the cotton output is expected to increase up 105 lakh bales in 2021-22 season due to the improved yield following recent spell of rains and favorable climatic conditions.
- Punjab Agriculture University has advised the farmers to monitor their cotton crop. As the Pink Bollworm infestation was detected in Bhatinda and Mansa, the Punjab Agriculture University has advised the cotton growers to monitor their cotton fields for pink bollworm infestation. The agricultural expert has also advised the farmers that if any incidence occurs on their crop they can contact to PAU.
- Cotton crop has been affected due to heavy rains in Khammam. The heavy rains during the past few days have affected the cotton and paddy crop in Khammam and Bhadradri -Kothagudem districts. According to the preliminary estimates of the Agriculture department around 1,887 acres of area has been damaged in Bhadradri -Kothagudem districts affecting over 1,393 farmers. In Khammam district, crops mainly paddy and cotton, were inundated by rainwater in around 1,720 acres.
- Cabinet has approved Production Linked Incentives scheme. The cabinet has approved the PLI scheme for textiles for MMF (man-made fibre) apparel, MMF fabrics and ten segments of technical textiles with a budgetary outlay of ₹10,683 crore that will be provided over 5 years.


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- Cotton sowing in Telangana is expected to decrease compared to previous season. Telangana plans to touch the 28.32 lakh hectares mark in cotton has fallen as the farmers have sown the cotton crop only on over 20.23 lakh hectares as on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Also, the sowing is coming to an end; it is highly unlikely that there will be any improvement in acreages.
- Pink Bollworm infestation in Bhatinda. As per the State Agriculture Department data, all the 14 blocks of Bhatinda and Mansa have reported the Pink Bollworm infestation in cotton. Around 3.25 lakh hectares is under cotton cultivation in Punjab, out of that nearly 5 percent of the area is under the Bathinda (96,000 hectares) and Mansa (65,000 hectares) is under pest attack. According to the agricultural officials, there is no serious threat to cotton production. The maiden picking of the three-picking cycle of cotton is expected to begin after September 15 whereas farmers have started harvesting in the early-sown fields.
- Tamil Nadu has removed 1 percent cotton cess on purchase of cotton and cotton waste. The Southern India Mills Association lauded the decision on the revoking of the tax as it would benefit 200k farmers and help increase cotton production from 500k bales to 2.5 million bales by 2030. Also, this would encourage farmers to switch over to cotton crop from other cash crops and may benefit 1 million farmers in the long run.




#### Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario

Arrivals were not available in Gondal Market. Average kapas price at Gondal market stood at Rs. 7875/q in the previous week.





# Lint price Outlook

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






# Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

# International Market Scenario

- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, For 2021-22 U.S. cotton production is forecasted at 18.5 million bales, up 1.2 million bales despite a 4 percent decline in harvested area, largely due to increased projected yields in Texas. With both world trade and U.S. supplies higher this month, U.S. exports are 500,000 bales higher and ending stocks are 700,000 bales higher.
- According to an International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, after a 7 percent decrease in 2020-21, cotton production is projected to increase by 3 percent in 2021-22 season to 25 million tonnes. Global Consumption has also recovered from 2019-20, to post a 12.4 percent increase to 25.5 million tonnes in 2020-21 and is projected to improve further to 25.8 million tonnes in 2021-22. Also, the concerns remain due to Covid 19 stubbornness with threats from factory closures and logistical issues looming in Bangladesh and Vietnam.
- According to the Food and Agriculture Outlook Report, India is expected to be the world's largest cotton producer till 2030. Despite the challenges including land constraints, water shortage, climate change and

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
crop's susceptibility to pest and disease attacks, India will continue to be the World's largest cotton producer till 2030. India's cotton production is expected to expand to 7.2 million tonnes (approximately 43 million bales of 170 kg each) compared with the current output of 6 MT equivalent to roughly 36 million bales. India will contribute to as much as 40 percent global increase in cotton production during the outlook period.
