

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 20th Sep 2021

## **Domestic market summary**

• **Domestic Market Scenario:** In India cotton arrivals have started in north and MP area. Rainfall has stopped in majority of cotton areas. Good sunshine will increase arrivals very fast in the next week. Till 10th Sep 2021 cotton sowing across India has reached 119.45 lakh hectares compared to previous season sowing at 126.81 lakh hectares during the same time. New cotton arrivals have started coming in mandi. Sowing is almost over for cotton but good rains and good weather may offset the decrease in area by better yield.

#### Weekly Price Outlook:

The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 6900-7400/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh are likely to hover around Rs.5600-7500/q.

#### **Major Market Highlights:**

The Cotlook index stood higher (103.15cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 92.81 cents/lbs.

#### Market Highlights:

- Pink Bollworm infestation spreads to Sangrur. After Bhatinda and Mansa, pink bollworm spread has now been reported in cotton crop in Sunam and Lehragaga subdivision of Sangrur in Punjab. The Punjab agriculture department on Wednesday directed all eight cotton-growing districts to immediately start a drive to check the spread of pink bollworm after an extensive infestation of the disease was reported in adjoining districts of Haryana and parts of Rajasthan. According to the Punjab Agriculture Department the next three weeks are crucial for the spread of the infestation. All cotton growing villages will be surveyed twice in the next three weeks. Experts have also asked the farmers to follow the guidelines issued by the department.
- Cotton crop has been destroyed due to heavy rains in old Adilabad. Unexpected rains during the past few days have affected to the cotton and soya crop in old Adilabad. The standing cotton crop is badly affected in the area and farmers who have suffered losses due to inundation of cotton plants are now planning to sow Bengal gram. The farmers are also demanding the state government to order a survey immediately to access the crop damage and pay compensation to them.
- Cotton production is expected to increase up to 12 percent in Gujarat. The cotton production in Gujarat is expected to rise by 10-12 percent in the new cotton season beginning October. Despite the lower acreages around 22.51 lakh hectares under the cotton crop this kharif, the cotton output is expected to increase up




- 105 lakh bales in 2021-22 season due to the improved yield following recent spell of rains and favorable climatic conditions.
- Punjab Agriculture University has advised the farmers to monitor their cotton crop. As the Pink Bollworm infestation was detected in Bhatinda and Mansa, the Punjab Agriculture University has advised the cotton growers to monitor their cotton fields for pink bollworm infestation. The agricultural expert has also advised the farmers that if any incidence occurs on their crop they can contact to PAU.


## Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario


#### Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario

Arrivals were not available in Gondal Market. Average kapas price at Gondal market stood at Rs. 7875/q in the previous week.








# Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

## <u>International Market Scenario</u>

- According to the Cotton Crop Assessment Committee meeting, Pakistan's Sindh province expects cotton
  production of over 3.5 million bales in the 2021-22 season. Due to less rainfall, overall cotton production in
  Punjab is expected to increase by 8.5 percent at 4.5 million bales. The overall cotton production is expected
  to reach 8.46 million bales.
- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, for the 2021-22 season, India's cotton area is projected at 12.7 million hectares lowest in past 3 years. The erratic monsoon has affected the cotton planting in the major growing regions. Although, the national yield is projected at 489 kg per hectares. As a result, cotton crop is projected at 28.5 million bales in 2021-22 which is slightly above the year before production. India is expected to account for 24 percent of the global cotton crop in 2021-22.
- Egyptian cotton production and exports may rise in 2021-22. The rising global demand and the recent rise in prices of cotton are increasing cotton production. As the area under cotton harvest has increased to 85,000 hectares from the previous year's 65,000 hectares. The cotton production is likely to increase by 30.23 percent from 215,000 lb bales in 2020-21 to 280,000 lb bales in 2021-22. Further, exports are likely to increase by 28 percent to reach 320,000 lb bales in 2021-22 compared to 250,000 lb bales in 2020-21.



- Imports are expected to decline by 12.70 percent to 550,000 lb bales in 2021-22 compared to the previous year's 630,000 lb bales in 2020-21.
- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) September report, world 2021-22 production is projected higher this month with an increase in cotton production for the United States at 18.51 million bales from the previous month's estimates of 17.26 million bales, and for Australia at 4.70 million bales from previous estimates of 4.40 million bales, offset a decline in India from 29.00 million bales to 28.50 million bales this month. World trade in 2021-22 is still projected down from the previous year's record 48.5 million bales but is projected 500,000 bales higher than in August at 46.8 million bales.
- According to USDA'S World Agriculture Supply and Demand Estimate (WASDE) report, for 2021-22 U.S.
   Cotton production is forecasted at 18.5 million bales, up by 1.2 million bales despite a 4 percent decline in harvested area, largely due to increased yield in Texas. Both world trade and U.S. supplies are estimated higher. U.S. exports are 500,000 bales higher and ending stock are 700,000 bales higher.


