

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 22nd Nov 2021

Domestic market summary

Domestic Market Scenario: Cotton prices have dropped by 8-10 percent in Telangana. The Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption has projected the cotton production for 2021-22 season at 362 lakh bales. Demand for cotton is excellent in the market. Indian cotton arrivals are near 1,50,000 to 1,70,000 bales. Prices are expected to remain stable in the coming week.

Weekly Price Outlook:

The average price of Kapas is likely to remain firm between Rs. 8800-9900/q in Rajkot while the prices in Andhra Pradesh are likely to hover around Rs.7800-8600/q.

Major Market Highlights:

• The Cotlook index stood higher (126.95 cents/lbs) compared to the ICE cotton future that stood at 117.62 cents/lbs.

Market Highlights:

- Rising price of cotton bales have posed a huge threat to Karur textile manufacturing and export industries,
 which are gearing up for the annual international textile fair, which is set to take place in Germany as majority
 of the trade depends on foreign orders received during the expo.
- Cotton prices have dropped by 8-10 percent in Telangana with the increase in arrivals in the market. Prices have dropped to Rs. 7,830 per quintal from a high of Rs. 8,710 in a few mandis. Prices in other parts of the country have also dropped by about three percent. Cotton prices in Adilabad have fallen from Rs.8,600 too Rs. 7,910.
- The Punjab Cabinet has approved the policy formulated for extending relief to the families of cotton-picking farm labourers affected by the damage caused to the crop by the pink bollworm disease. With this decision,
 10 per cent of total compensation is to be given to the farmers on this count would be provided to the families of cotton-picking farm labourers affected by the pest attack on cotton crop.
- The Committee on Cotton Production and Consumption has projected the cotton production for 2021-22 season at 362 lakh bales, opening stock is projected at 73.20 lakh bales and imports at 10.50 lakh bales, the total availability for this season is likely to be 445.88 lakh bales as against 485.66 bales the previous season. The demand from textile mills including small scale units is estimated at 322 lakh bales, and exports were pegged at 45 lakh bales.




• The cabinet committee on economic affairs (CCEA) has approved committed price support of Rs. 17,408.85 crore to Cotton Corporation of India for the cotton season from 2014-15 to 2020-21 (up to 30.09.2021). The CCEA has approved incurring expenditure for reimbursing losses under MSP operation for cotton during the cotton season 2014-15 to 2020-21. This price support operation will help in stabilizing the cotton prices and will also protect cotton farmers from distress sales during any adverse price situation. During the last 2 season CCI has procured around 1/3rd of the cotton production in the country i.e. about 200 lakh bales and disbursed more than Rs. 55,000 crore directly in the bank account of around 40 lakh farmers.



Arrivals have started from Amravati and Ahmedabad and prices were at Rs. 8350/qt and Rs. 8441/qt respectively.



Kapas Monthly M-o-M Price Scenario



Average kapas price at Gondal market stood slightly lower at Rs. 8580/qt from the previous week at Rs. 8642/q.





Cotton Seed Oil and Cotton Seed Oil Cake








Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

International Market Scenario

- According to USDA, as of 14th November 2021, US crop progress report, cotton harvest had advanced 10 percentage points to 65 percent complete as of 11/14. The average is to be 64 percent harvested. Most of the delta and southeast states were behind, while the rest of the states were generally ahead.
- The United States is now looking to enhance its stake in cotton exports to Bangladesh to strengthen the US
 foothold in Bangladesh's market, the US exporters and their representative put an emphasis on resolving



issues, such as obligation to fumigate US cotton after imports, not being able to send cotton laden ships directly to Bangladesh in the absence of a deep seaport, a hike in shipping costs and other logistic costs.


- According to the USDA'S WASDE November report, the U.S. production was projected slightly higher at 18.2 million bales while the domestic mill use and exports were unchanged. U.S. ending stock were projected higher at 3.4 million which is 250,000 above the previous year.
- The cotton harvest season in Xinjiang is expected to last until mid-November this year, with the output expected to reach 5.2 million tonnes. The region has contributed nearly 90 percent of china's cotton production capacity and about 20 percent of the global cotton production.
- The Chinese monetary and financial regulatory agencies have begun supporting various departments to control the prices of cotton, while farmers are looking to sell their cotton due to bad weather and poor financial conditions. The cotton demand may also reduce in the coming months. The monthly average of CCI was 15,690 RMB per metric ton in first quarter of 2021 and 15,830 RMB per metric ton in second quarter of 2021. During the third quarter the monthly average surged by 12.19 percent to 17,760 RMB per metric ton.

Cotlook A index was higher this week. The Cotlook A Index was at 127.00 cents/lb higher as compared to the previous week (126.13 cents/lb).



- We expect cotton prices to remain range bound in the coming week.






