

# COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 18<sup>th</sup> Apr 2022

## **Domestic market summary**

**Domestic Market Scenario:** Cotton prices continue to remain firm during the week under review. Indian government has given relief to spinners by withdrawing raw cotton import duty till new season. Despite of the removal of import duty overall, the Indian cotton market remained firm. Indian cotton Shanker-6 prices remained stable near Rs 90,200 to 90,500 per candy.

## **Weekly Price Outlook:**

The average price of Kapas in Andhra Pradesh is likely to hover around Rs.11,400-11,800/Qtl.

## **Major Market Highlights:**

• The Cotlook Index stood higher (149.40 cents/lbs) compared to the ICE Cotton Futures that stood at 135.29 cents/lbs.

#### Market Highlights:

- The 2021-22 cotton season has almost come to an end in Punjab. Cotton prices in Punjab have reached at Rs.8,200 per quintal, which is around 26 percent higher from the previous Kharif season. This is due to a dip of 47 percent in cotton production as compared to the last season.
- The Indian government on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2022 has removed the Agriculture Infrastructure and Development Cess (5 percent) and Basic Custom Duty (5 percent) on the imports of cotton. The government has allowed duty free imports of cotton until 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022 as prices in the local market has increased because of lower production in 2021-22 season. Further, duty free imports will help textile mills to import cotton from Australia, African countries and United States. However, considering the freight and other charges overall landing cost of USA Cotton in India is expected to be higher (appx. 94,000/ candy) while the prevailing Shanker-6 prices in India is Rs. 92,400 92,800 /candy, a disparity in imports of Rs. 1,500-1,800 / candy. Agriwatch expects prices to remain firm in the short term.
- Due to higher domestic prices of Cotton, we expect farmers are more inclined to take up cotton cultivation in upcoming Kharif season and if pre-monsoon showers and SW monsoon remains good (IMD predicting normal monsoon in their 1<sup>st</sup> forecast for SW Monsoon 2022) then it is very likely that sowing may start early in coming Kharif. Overall, there are expectation of 12-15% increase in sown area as of now from last year which may contain the soaring domestic prices.
- Cotton Association of India has reduced its March estimate of the cotton crop for the 2021-22 season by 8 lakh bales to 335.13 lakh bales from its previous estimate of 343.13 lakh bales. The Association has attributed the reduction in crop estimate to the drop in production in states including Gujarat, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh. Agriwatch has estimated cotton production during 2021-22 season at 335.60 lakh bales.


• The total cotton supply between October 2021 to March 2022 remained at 343.68 lakh bales, which consists of the arrivals of 262.68 lakh bales, imports of 6 lakh bales during the month of March 2022 and Opening Stock of 75 lakh bales equivalent to 79.69 lakh running bales at the beginning of the season on 1st October 2021. Further, the CAI has estimated cotton consumption for the months of October to March 2022 at 175 lakh bales while export shipment of cotton during the months of October to March 2022 is estimated at 35 lakh bales. Stock at the end of March 2022 is estimated at 133.68 lakh bales.

## Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario



For Amravati and Ahmedabad prices were at Rs. 11750/Qtl and Rs. 12750/Qtl respectively.

Average Kapas prices at Gondal market stood slightly higher at Rs. 12913/Qtl from the previous week of Rs. 12430/q.








## **Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario**

## **International Market Scenario**

- According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2022, U.S cotton planting stands at 7 percent which 1 percent lower from previous season. However, the U.S. cotton planting was same as past 5 years average of 7 percent.
- According to USDA WASDE Report, the 2021-22 cotton production is estimated 340,000 bales higher, with
  increases for Pakistan and Greece. A 500,000-bale decline in China's expected consumption resulted in a
  similar decline in the global estimate, which now stands at 124.1 million bales. World trade is projected about
  450,000 bales lower this month, with exports projected lower for India, Brazil, and Malaysia.
- According to International Cotton Advisory Committee Report, Global Consumption for the 2021-22 season is expected to be at 26.16 million tonne whereas production is expected to slightly fall to 26.43 million tonne. Global cotton supply is expected to be at 57.129 million tonne while the global demand is expected at 57.133 million tonne. The current price forecast of the average A Index for the 2021-22 ranges from 106 cents to 126 cents, with a midpoint at 113 cents per pound.


#### Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A Index was high this week. The Cotlook A Index was at 152.15 cents/lb higher as compared to the previous week (153.63 cents/lb), possibly led by the lowering of production in the US and World by USDA. All other markets also seem to have taken a cue from the same.




