

COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 09th May 2022

Domestic market summary

Domestic Market Scenario: Indian physical market prices remained firm but buying activity remained slow. Cotton sowing for the 2022-23 season is progressing well in Punjab, Haryana and some parts of Rajasthan. Cotton Fiber (Shanker-6) prices remained stable during the week.

Weekly Price Outlook:

The average price of Kapas in Andhra Pradesh is likely to hover around Rs.12,800-13,500/Qtl.

Major Market Highlights:

- The Cotlook Index stood higher (166.05 cents/lbs) compared to the ICE Cotton Futures that stood at 150.81 cents/lbs.
- Indian rupee consolidated from Rs. 77.33 per USD.


- Telangana government is targeting to increase the area under cotton by 55–65 percent to about 28–30 lakh
 hectares as compared to last year's 18 lakh hectares even as the cottonseed industry pegged the growth in
 cotton acreage at 15 per cent in the upcoming Kharif season. As per USDA report, the all-cotton planted area
 for India in the coming season 2022-23 is estimated at 12.2 million acres, higher 9 percent from last year.
- Cotton Association of India (CAI) and International Cotton Association (ICA) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) last week to increase the co-operation and address quality issues in cotton.
- The cotton yarn traders in south India are expecting demand to pick up in the coming weeks. Spinning mills are also reducing cotton yarn production which will support prices. Further, downstream manufacturers are likely to increase buying because of possible supply crunch in the market.

Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario


Weekly Price Review: Weekly Kapas average prices at Rajkot stood slightly lower at Rs. 12624Qtl compared to previous week's Rs. 12657/Qtl, whereas at Hisar prices stood slightly higher at Rs. 12250/Qtl compared to previous week price of Rs. 155830/Qtl. For Amravati and Ahmedabad prices were at Rs. 12266/Qtl and Rs. 12500/Qtl respectively.

Average Kapas prices at Gondal market have slightly improved at Rs. 12605/Qtl from the previous week of Rs. 12520/q.



Lint price Outlook






Cotton Seed Oil Cake weekly price Scenario

International Market Scenario

- As the 2021-22 cotton season is coming towards its closure, the production and consumption both are on higher side. Global cotton production is higher by 8.4 percent from 24.39 million tonnes to 26.43 million tonnes in 2021-22 season. While the global cotton production is on the higher side, India (3.7%) and china (3.1%) cotton production is on its lower side as compared to the previous season mainly because of the lesser sown area. Further, Global cotton consumption has increased by 1.9 percent to 26.16 million tonnes as compared to the previous season. Global cotton trade was down from the previous season. The drop is mainly due to logistical complications and supply chain disruptions over the course of the 2021-22 season.
- According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as on 01st May 2022, U.S cotton planting stands at 16 percent which is 1 percent higher as that of previous season of 15 percent. U.S. cotton planting was same as that of past 5 years average.


Cotlook A Index

Cotlook A Index was high this week. The Cotlook A Index was at 162.55 cents/lb higher as compared to the previous week (155.61 cents/lb), possibly led by the lowering of production in the US and World by USDA. All other markets also seem to have taken a cue from the same.






